VI. Requests by Dean Ford for Recommendations on Policy Concerning Those Interested in Vocational Education

The committee recommends that for institutions like Stout Institute training teachers of manual arts the minimum amount of work in this special field accepted in undergraduate credentials be the same as the minimum accepted in the corresponding curriculum in our College of Education, which is forty-five quarter hours. Recommended also that such students offer in addition to such a major an acceptable minor in some academic field. The attitude of the committee is that this second requirement be regarded as tentative and that observation be made of the individuals admitted under this policy to note whether or not the right type of graduate student is selected and whether promising graduate students are thereby discouraged from registering at the University.
