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NOTES

1. All data in the report are based on the number of students registered as of the end of the second week of classes.
2. Ethnic background information on students comes from application forms for fall admission, 1977 and from ethnic background survey cards collected during fall registration, 1977. The supplying of ethnic data is optional.
3. Data for the years other than 1977 are taken from the Annual Fall Quarter Minority Enrollment Report prepared by the Office of Admissions and Records.
4. The campus/college order of Table 1, Table 2 and Table 4 in this report has been changed to the same order as that of the revised Official Registration Statistics Report for the University of Minnesota.
5. The descriptions of the ethnic categories in the report are the latest version proposed and used by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

DEFINITION

ETHNIC BACKGROUND OF STUDENTS

Black (Afro-American, non-Hispanic origin)--A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa (excluding persons of Spanish, Portuguese, Latin American, or other Hispanic origin).

American Indian or Alaskan Native--A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintains a cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Asian American or Pacific Islander--A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands. The area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, and Samoa.

Hispanic (Spanish Surname American)--A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish or Portuguese culture or origin, regardless of race.

All Other Students--Includes the following two categories:

Caucasian/White, non-Hispanic--A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East (excluding persons of Spanish or Portuguese origin).

International Student (Foreign Student)--i.e., Non-Resident Alien: a person who is not a citizen of the United States and who is in this country on a temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. PLEASE NOTE! Resident Aliens, non-citizens who have been lawfully admitted for permanent residence (who hold a green card, Form I 151) are included in the appropriate Race/Ethnic categories along with United States citizens.

STUDENT LEVEL

Undergraduate Students--Those who have met all requirements for admission to the University and who pursue programs which lead to either bachelor's or associate degrees.

First Professional Students--Those who are enrolled in a professional school or program which requires at least 2 academic years of college work for entrance and a total of at least 6 years for a degree.

Graduate Students--Those who hold the bachelor's or first-professional degree or equivalent and are working toward a master's or doctor's degree.

Unclassified Students--Those who are not candidates for a degree or other formal award and who are taking courses in regular classes with other students.

Fall 1972 - Fall 1977

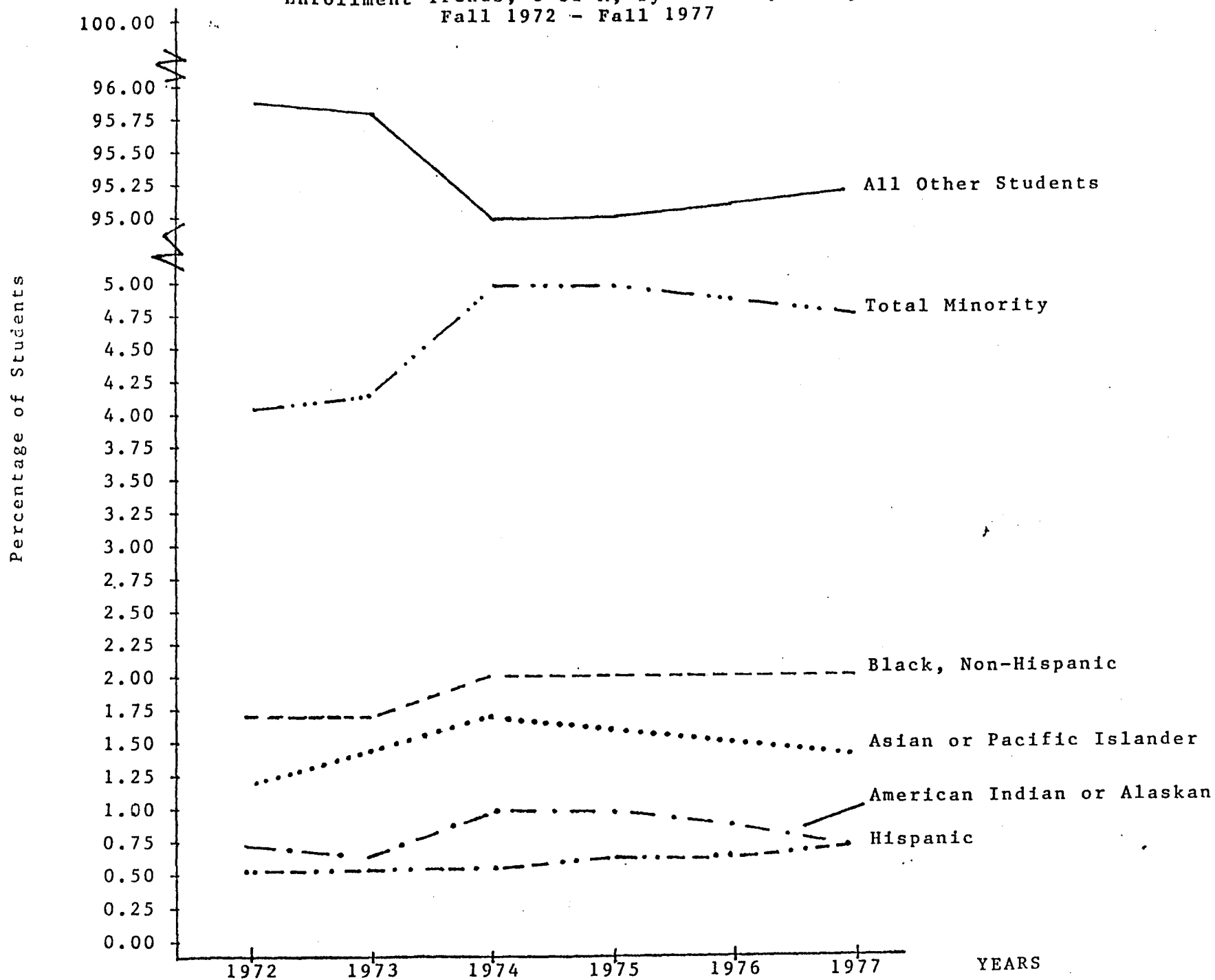
