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NOTES

1. All data in the report are based on the number of students registered as of the end of the second week of classes.
2. Ethnic background information of students comes either from application forms for admission or request for update of student ethnic data during fall registration. In both cases the supplying of ethnic data is optional.
3. The first year the University of Minnesota officially reported its fall minority enrollment was in 1972.
4. Data for the years other than 1992 are taken from the University of Minnesota Minority Enrollment Report, Fall Quarter 1983 and 1991.
5. The descriptions of the ethnic categories in the report are the latest version used by the United States Department of Education.
6. Data of undergraduate students majoring in Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Environmental Design for fall 1989, 1990, 1991 and 1992 are reported under the College of Architecture and Landscape Architecture (Architecture/Land. Arch.), a new collegiate unit of the Twin Cities Campus created in July 1989. In 1988, these students were counted as students under either the Institute of Technology, College of Liberal Arts or College of Agriculture dependent upon the student's major and the unit students registered for classes.
7. Data for College of Forestry are reported under its new name - College of Natural Resources.
8. Data for College of Home Economics are reported under its new name - College of Human Ecology.
9. Table 5 includes 1983 data for ten year comparison of minority enrollment.
10. Two graphic charts (Figure 1.2 and Figure 1.3) have been added to the report. Figure 1.2 shows the percentage of minority enrollment in each campus for a period of five years (1988-1992). Figure 1.3 depicts minority share of enrollment for each college at Twin Cities Campus, Fall 1992.

DEFINITIONS

ETHNIC BACKGROUND OF STUDENTS

Black, Non-Hispanic—A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa (except those of Hispanic origin).

American Indian or Alaskan Native—A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Asian or Pacific Islander—A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands. This includes people from China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, Samoa, India and Vietnam.

Hispanic—A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

All other students—Includes the following two categories plus unknown:

White, Non-Hispanic—A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa or in the Middle East (except those of Hispanic origin).

International Student (Foreign Student)—i.e., Non-Resident Alien: a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. Resident Aliens, who are not citizens or nationals of the United States and who have been lawfully admitted for permanent residence (and who hold alien registration receipt cards—Form I-151) are included in the appropriate racial/ethnic categories along with United States citizens.

STUDENT LEVEL

Undergraduate Students—Those who have met all requirements for admission to the University and who pursue programs which lead to either bachelor's or associate's degrees.

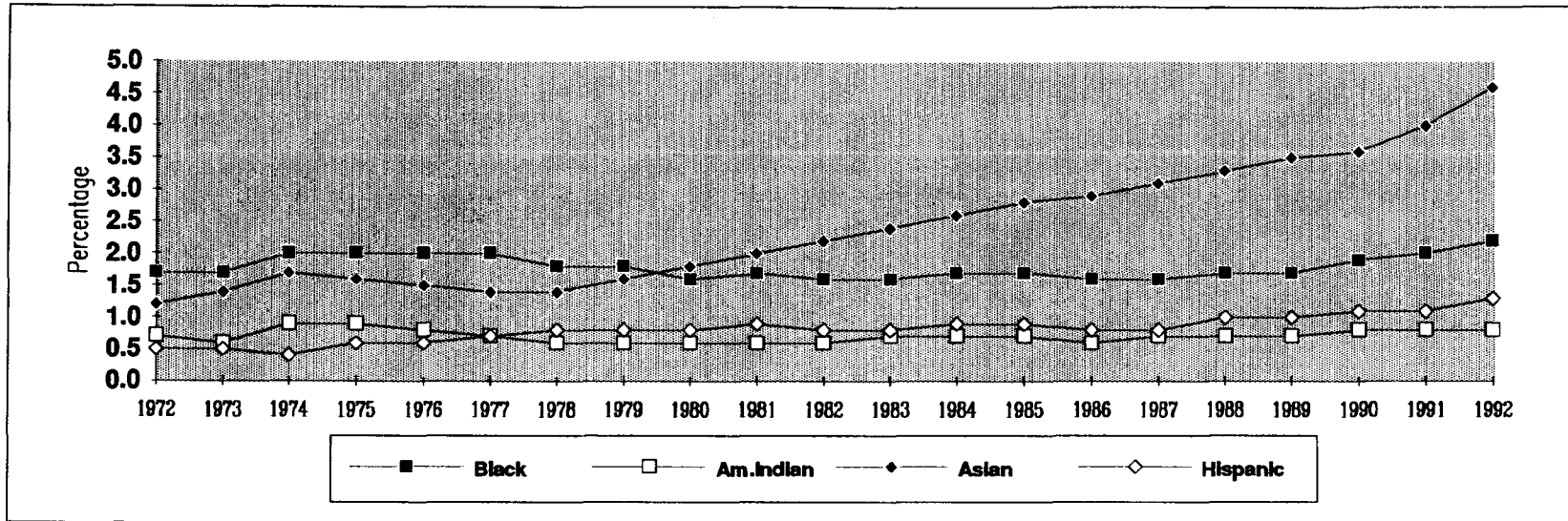
First Professional Students—Those who are enrolled in a professional school or program which requires at least 2 academic years of college work for entrance and a total of at least 6 years for a degree.

Graduate Students—Those who hold the bachelor's or first-professional degree or equivalent and are working toward a master's or doctor's degree.

Unclassified Students—Those who are not candidates for a degree or other formal award and who are taking courses in regular classes with other students.

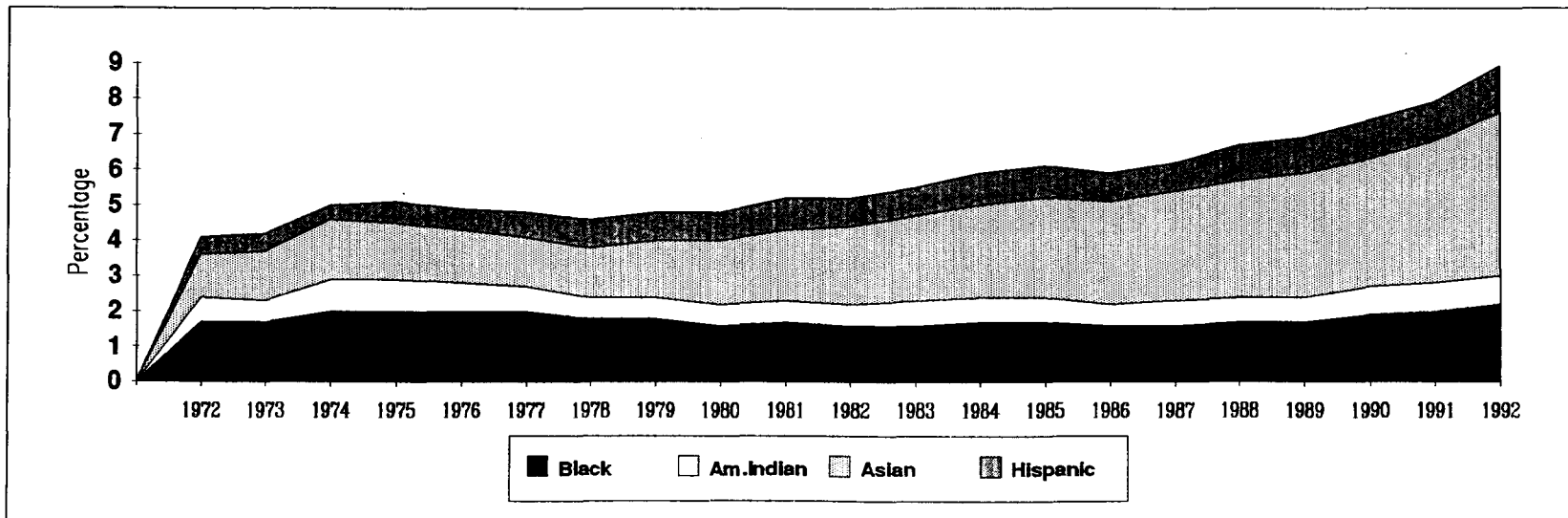

Fall Quarters 1988 Through 1992

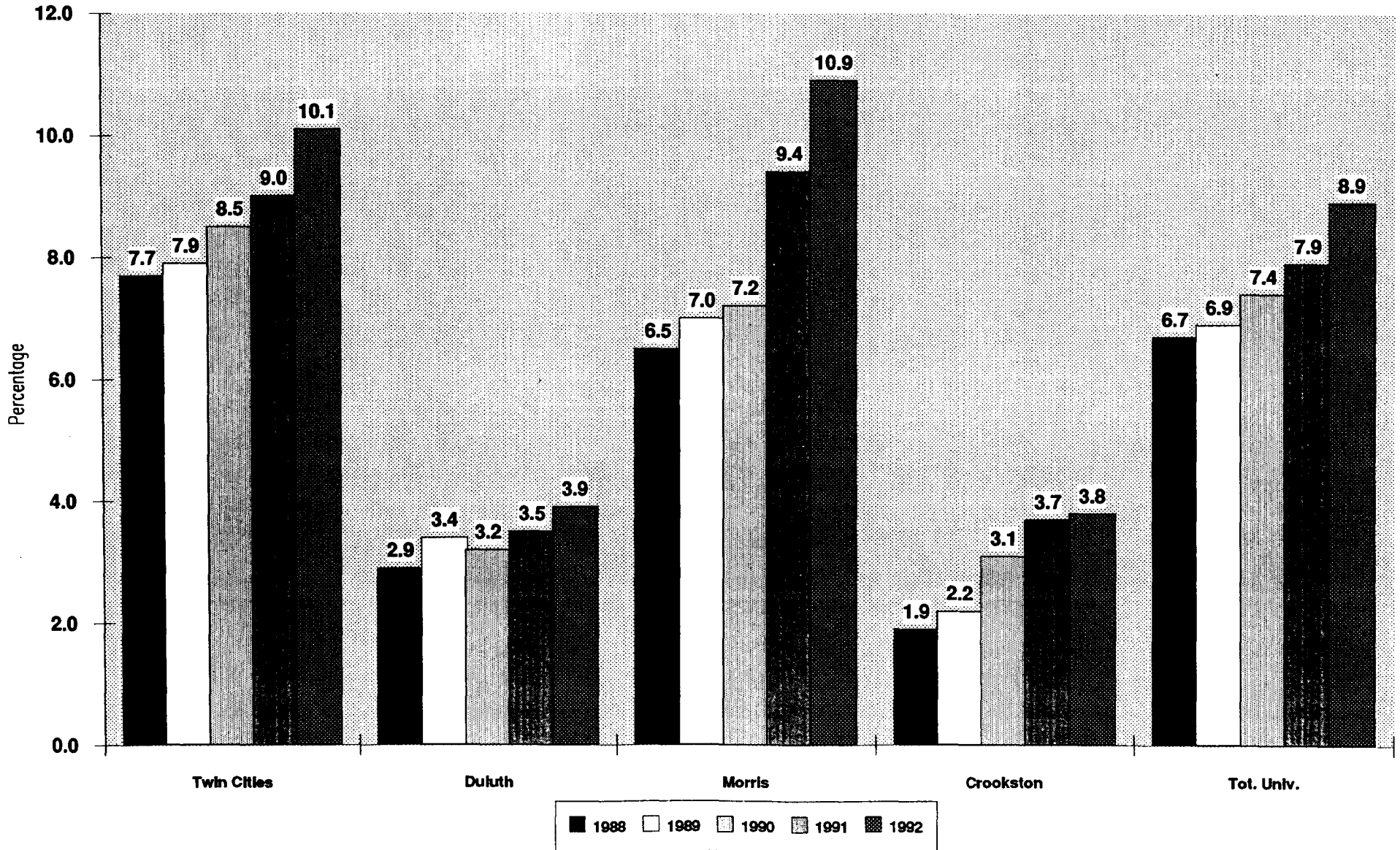

Fall Quarter 1992

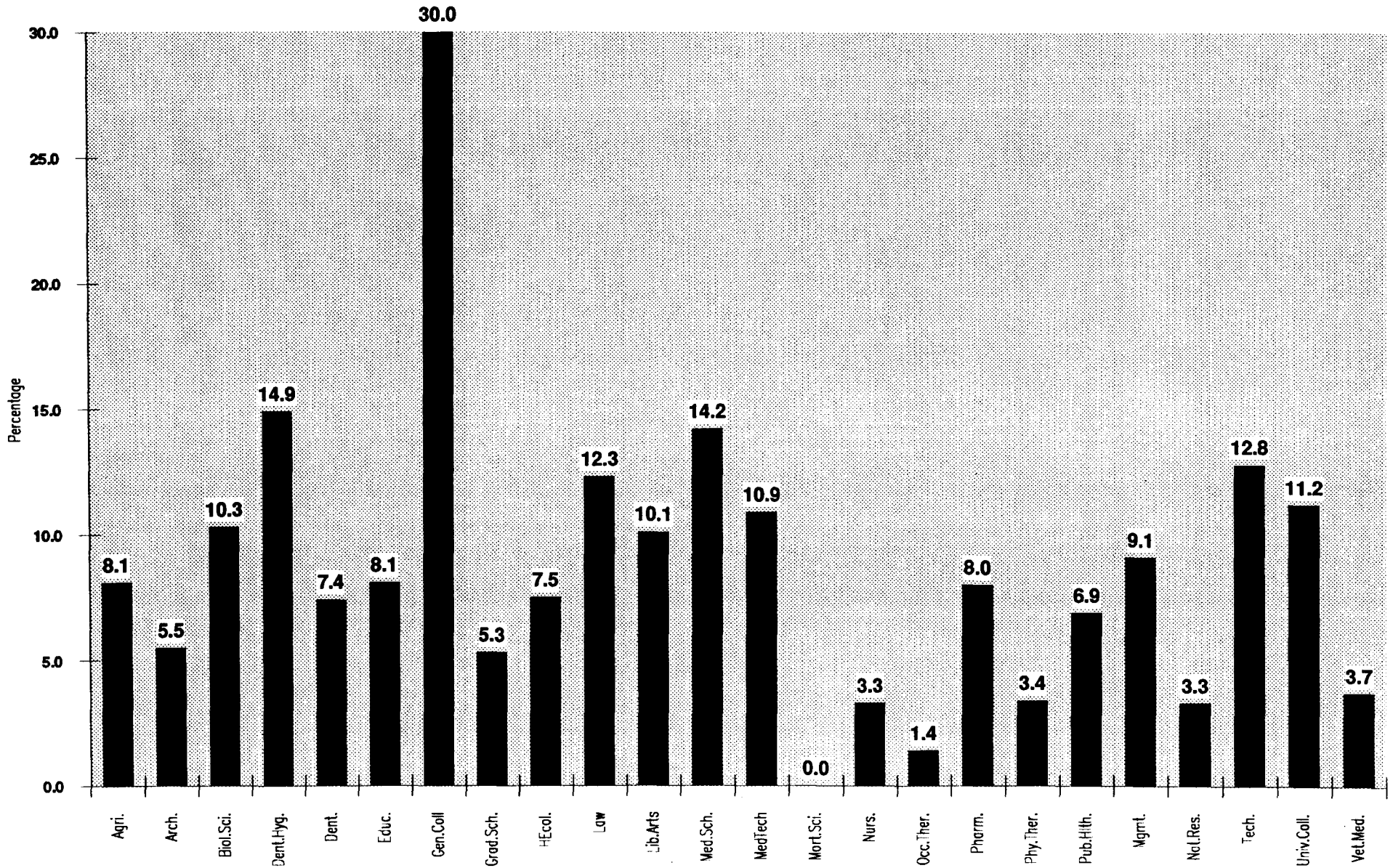

Fall Quarter 1992

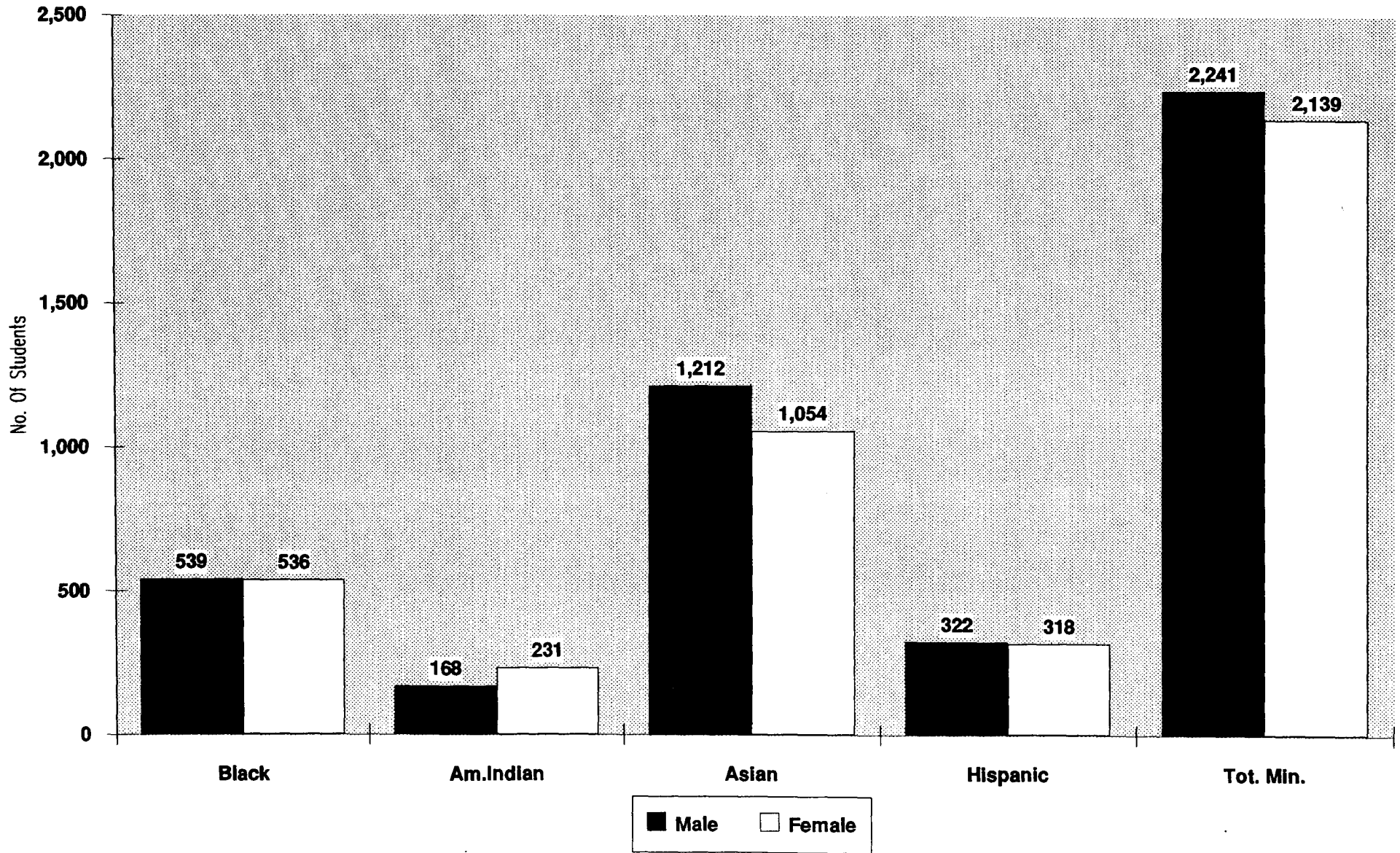

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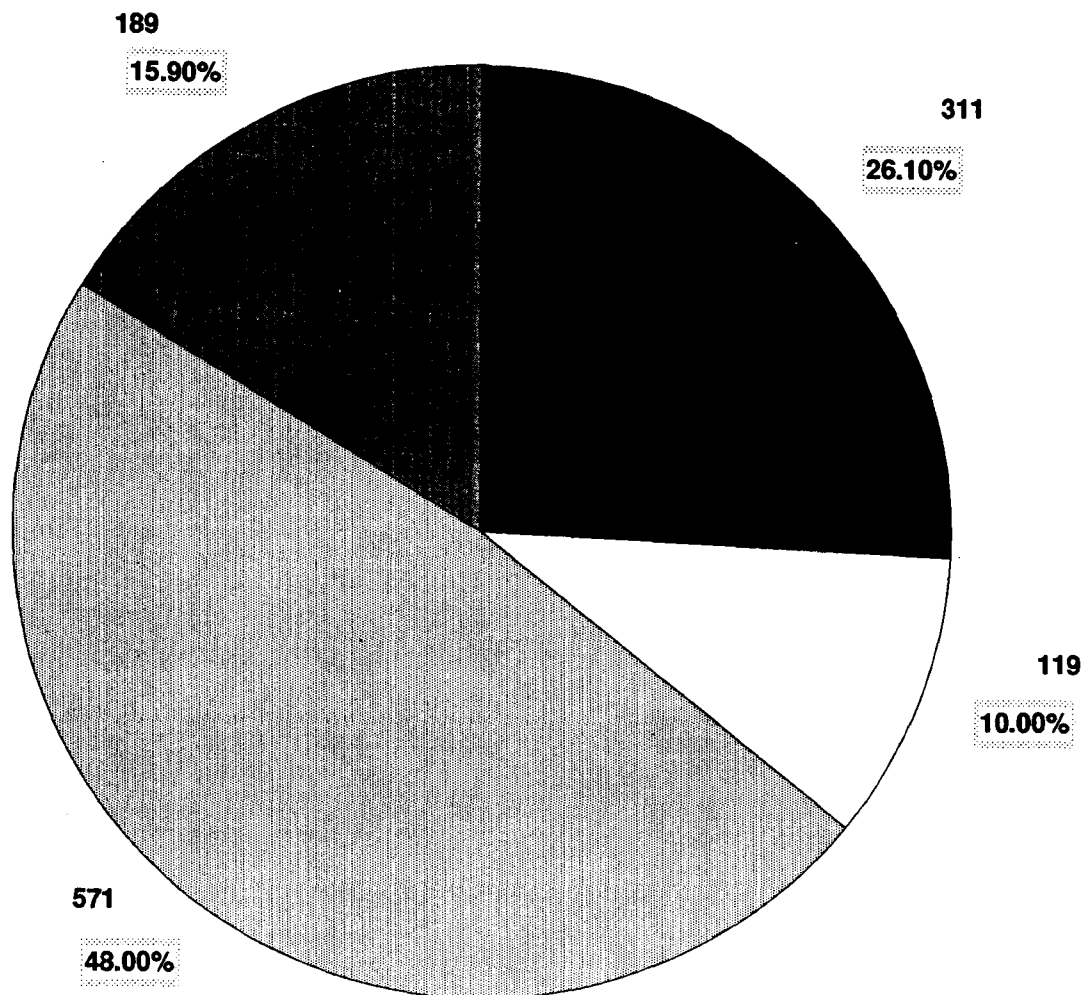

Fall Quarter 1992

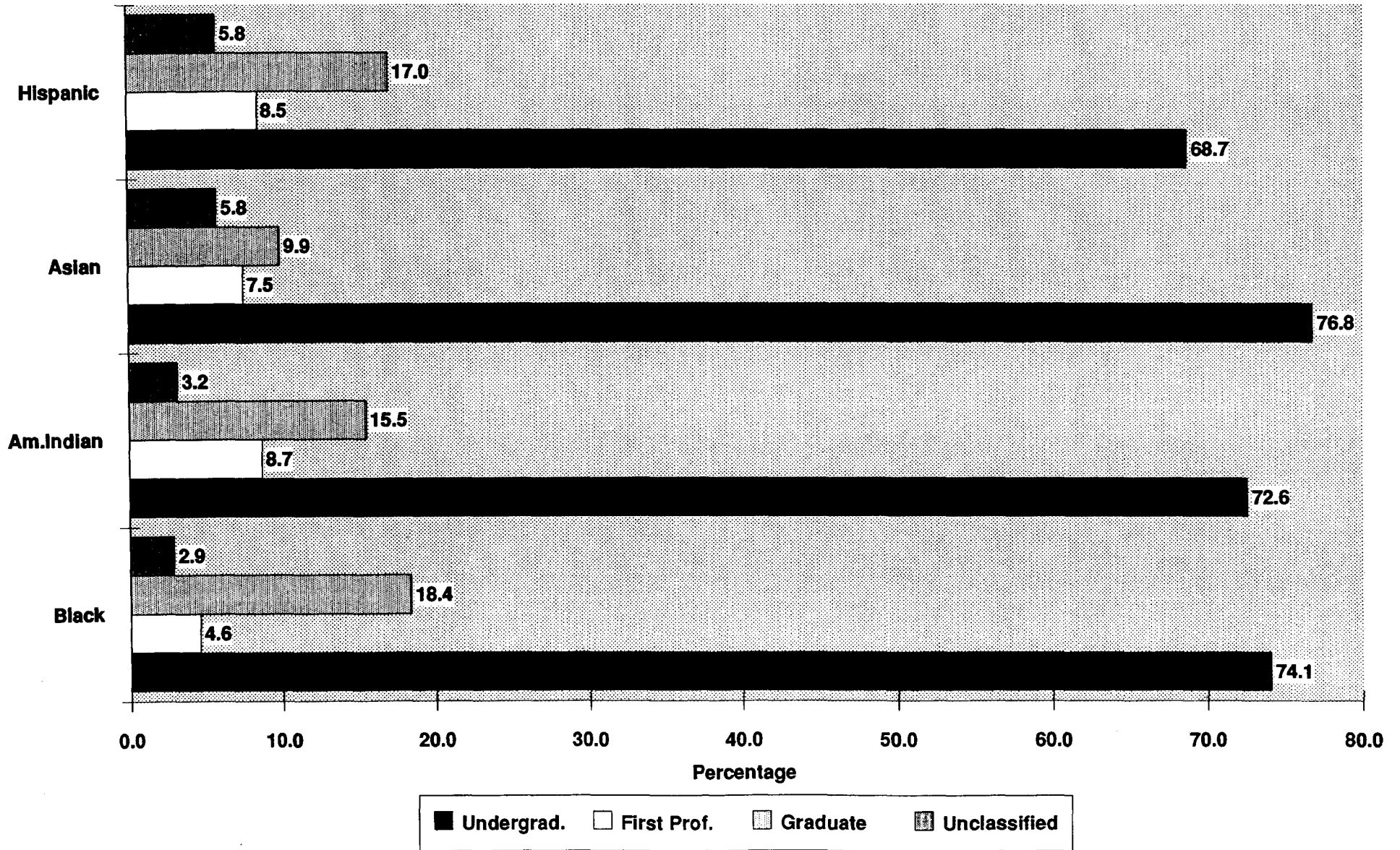

1983 vs 1992, 1988 vs 1992 & 1991 vs 1992

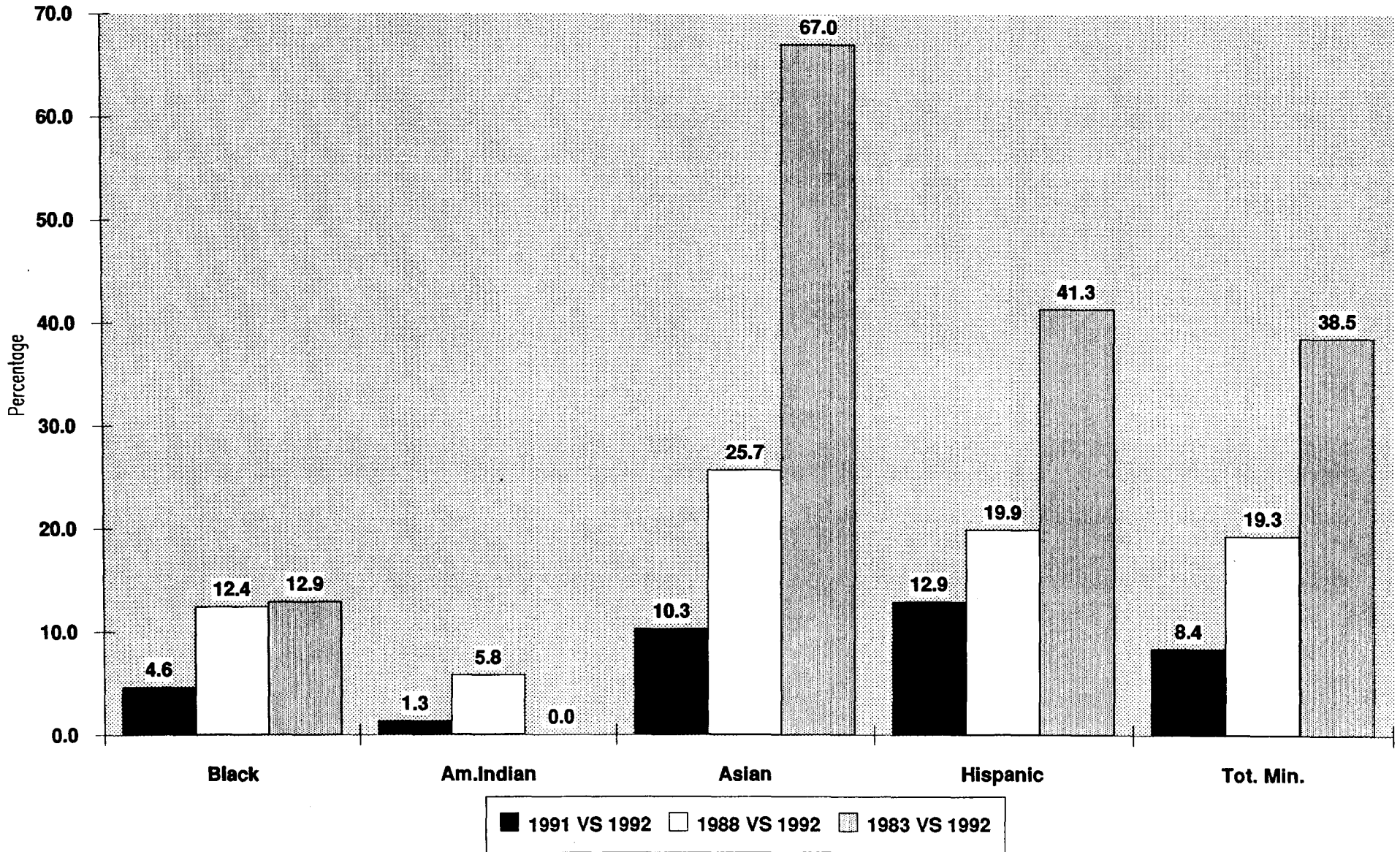
