MINORITY ENROLLMENT REPORT FALL QUARTER 1996

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NOTES

1. All data in the report are based on the number of students registered as of the end of the second week of classes.
2. Ethnic background information of students comes either from application forms for admission or request for update of student ethnic data during fall registration. In both cases the supplying of ethnic data is optional.
3. The first year the University of Minnesota officially reported its fall minority enrollment was in 1972.
4. Data for the years other than 1996 are taken from the University of Minnesota Minority Enrollment Report, Fall Quarter 1987 and 1995.
5. The descriptions of the ethnic categories in the report are the latest version used by the United States Department of Education.
6. In the past, non-minority students were reported under "All Other Students". Beginning from this year, these students are reported separately under White, International and Unknown.
7. Data for College of Agriculture are reported under its new name - College of Agriculture, Food And Environmental Science .
8. Data for College of Education are reported under its new name - College of Education And Human Development .
9. No 1993, 1994, 1995 or 1996 data are reported for Waseca Campus because it was closed as of September 1992.
10. Effective Fall Quarter 1993 Crookston Campus has been changed from 2-year institution to 4-year institution.
11. Table 8 includes 1987 data for ten year comparison of minority enrollment.

DEFINITIONS

ETHNIC BACKGROUND OF STUDENTS

Black, Non-Hispanic - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa (except those of Hispanic origin).

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian Subcontinent, or Pacific Islands. This includes people from China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, American Samoa, India and Vietnam.

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

White, Non-Hispanic - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa or the Middle East (except those of Hispanic origin).

International Student (Foreign Student) - i.e., Non-Resident Alien: a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. Resident Aliens, who are not citizens or nationals of the United States and who have been lawfully admitted as legal immigrants for the purpose of obtaining permanent resident alien status (and who hold alien registration receipt cards Form 1-151) are included in the appropriate racial/ethnic categories along with United States citizens.

Unknown - Students without ethnic background information.

STUDENT LEVEL

Undergraduate Students - Those who have met all requirements for admissions to the University and who pursue programs which lead to either bachelor's or associate degrees.

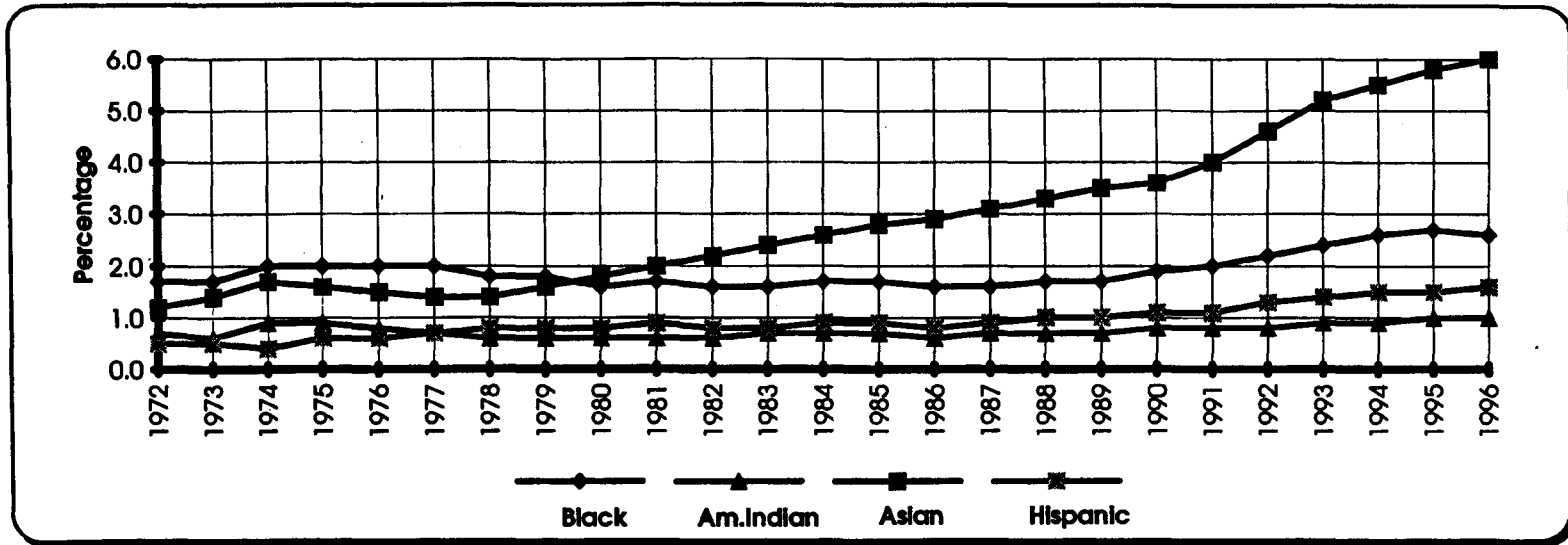
First Professional Students - Those who are enrolled in a professional school or program which requires at least 2 academic years of college work for entrance, and a total of at least 6 years for a degree.

Graduate Students - Those who hold the bachelor's or first-professional degree or equivalent, and are working toward a master's or doctor's degree.

Unclassified Students - Those who are not candidates for a degree or other formal award, and who are taking courses in regular classes with other students.

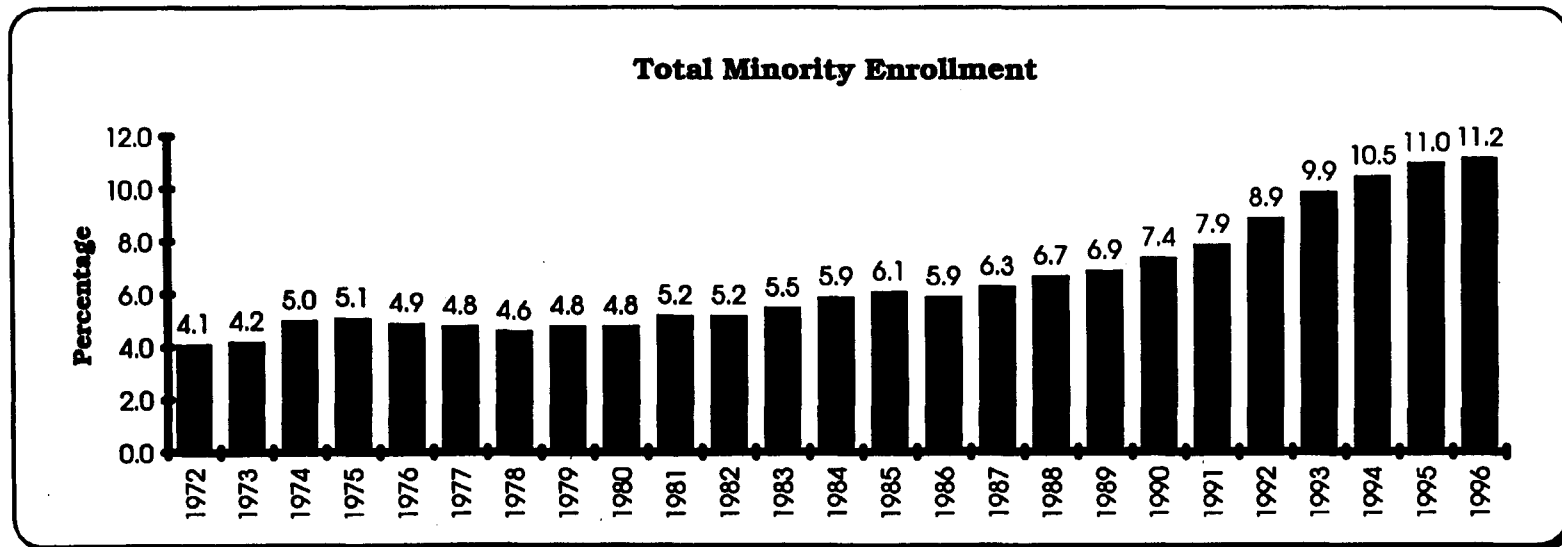

Fall Quarters 1992 Through 1996

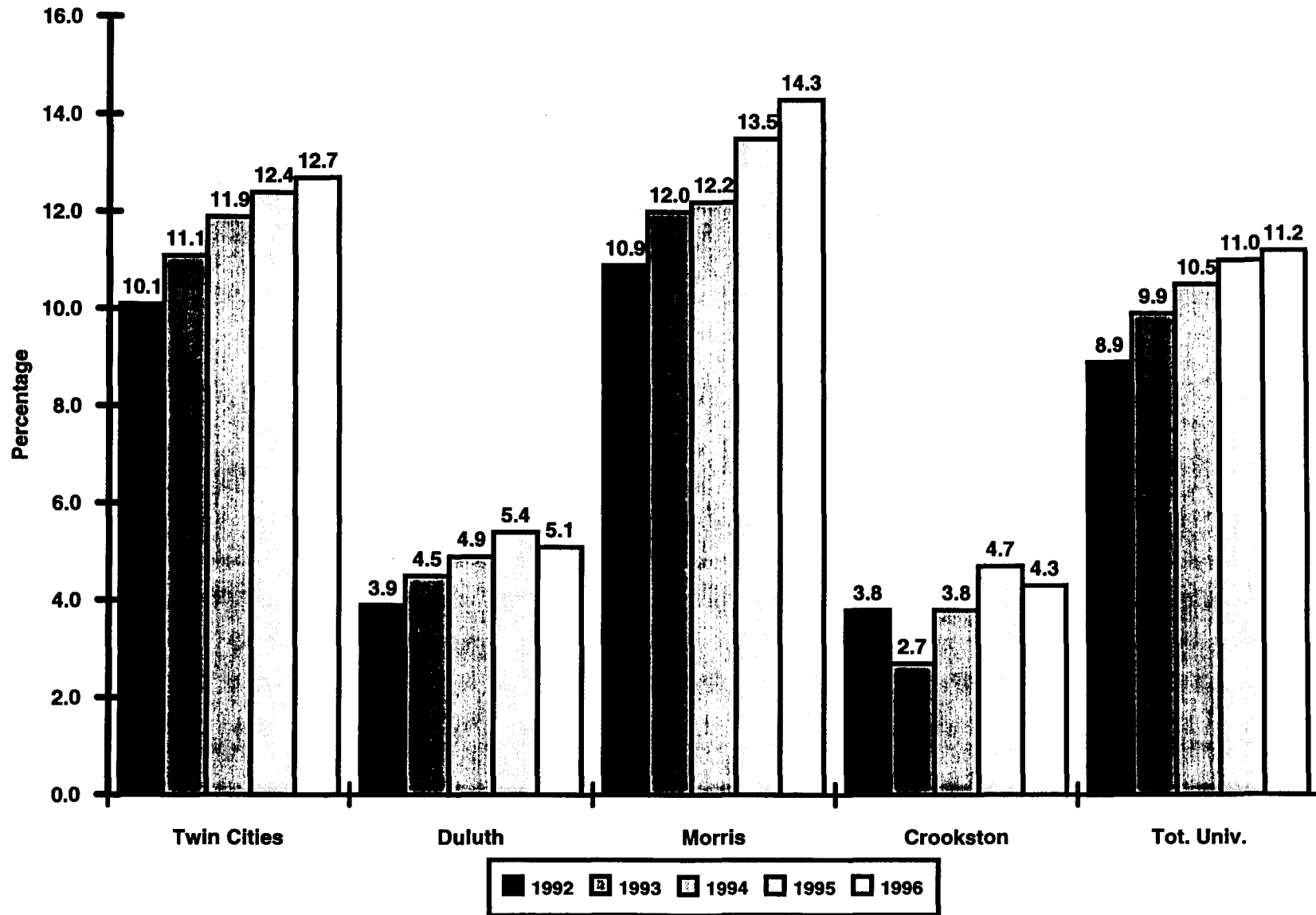

Fall Quarters, 1995 & 1996

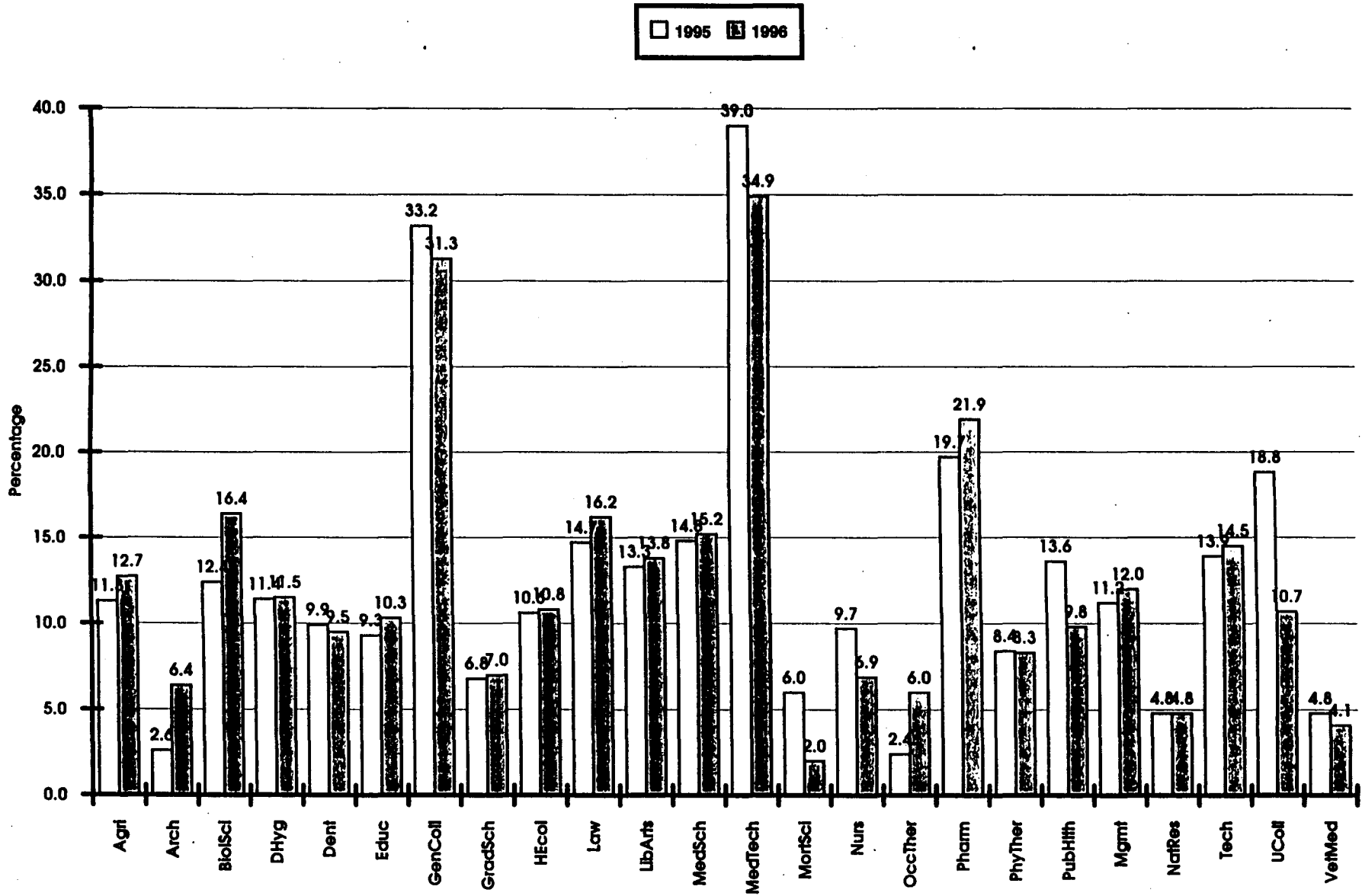

Fall Quarter 1996

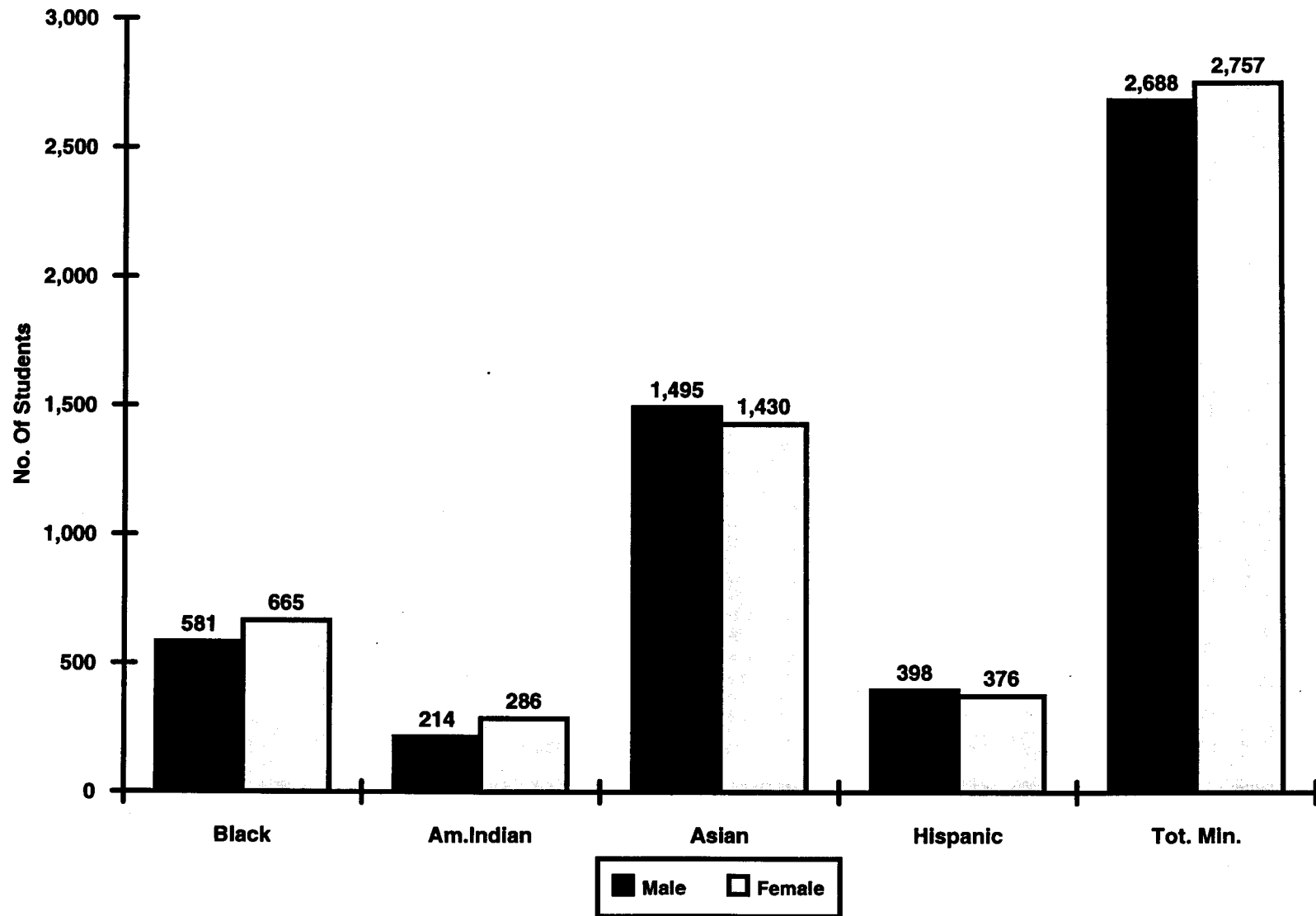

Fall Quarters, 1992 Through 1996

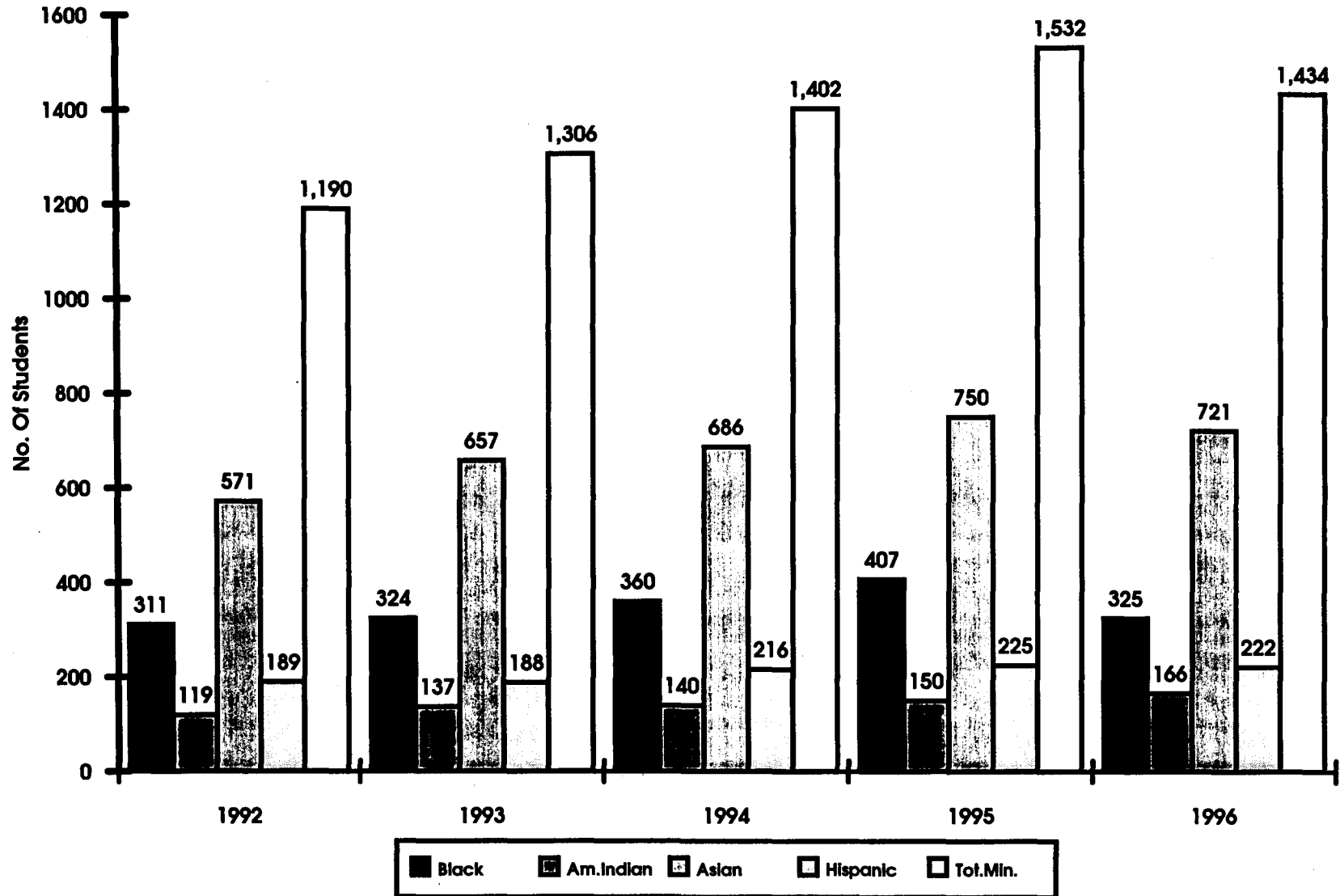

Fall Quarter 1996

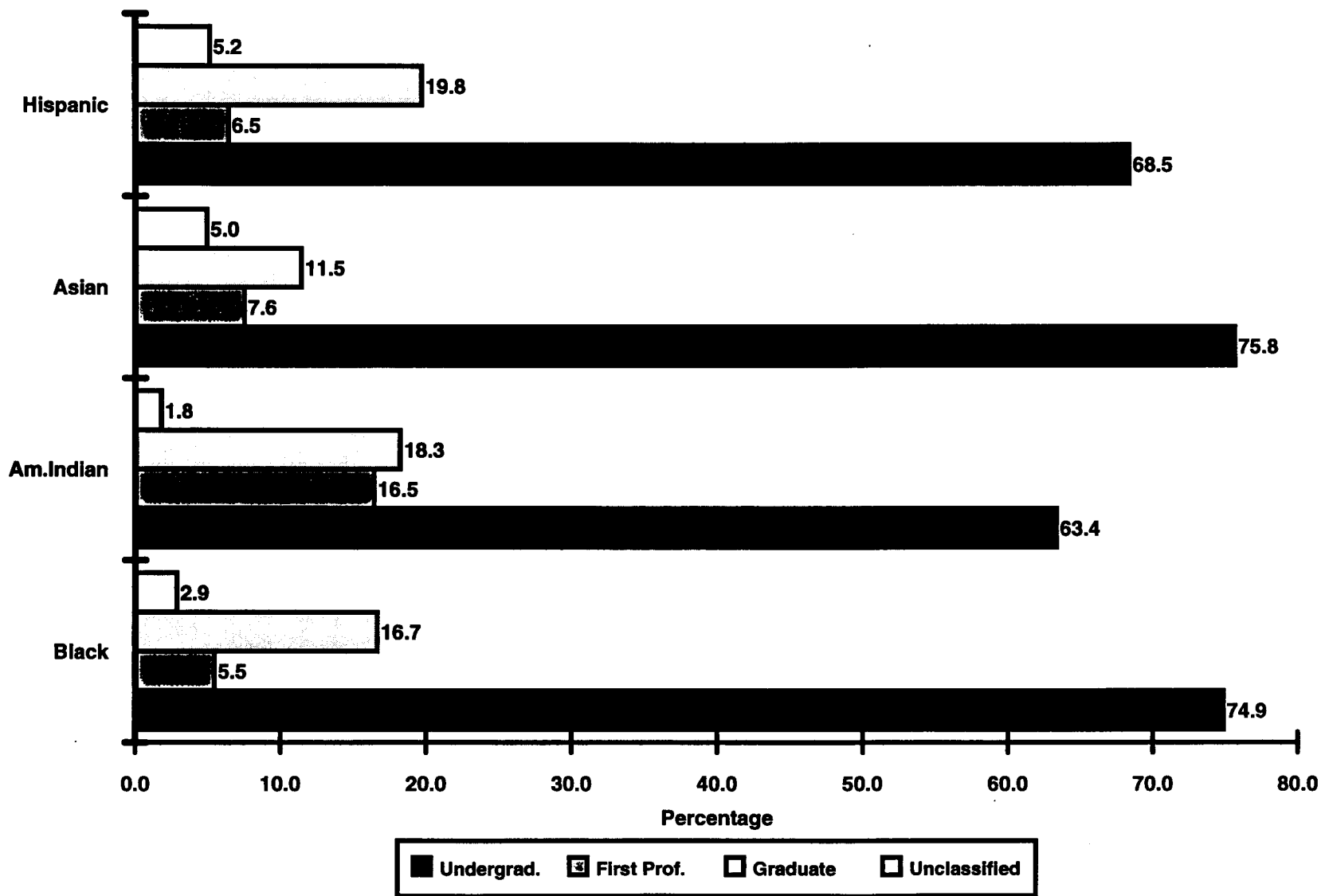

Fall Quarter 1996

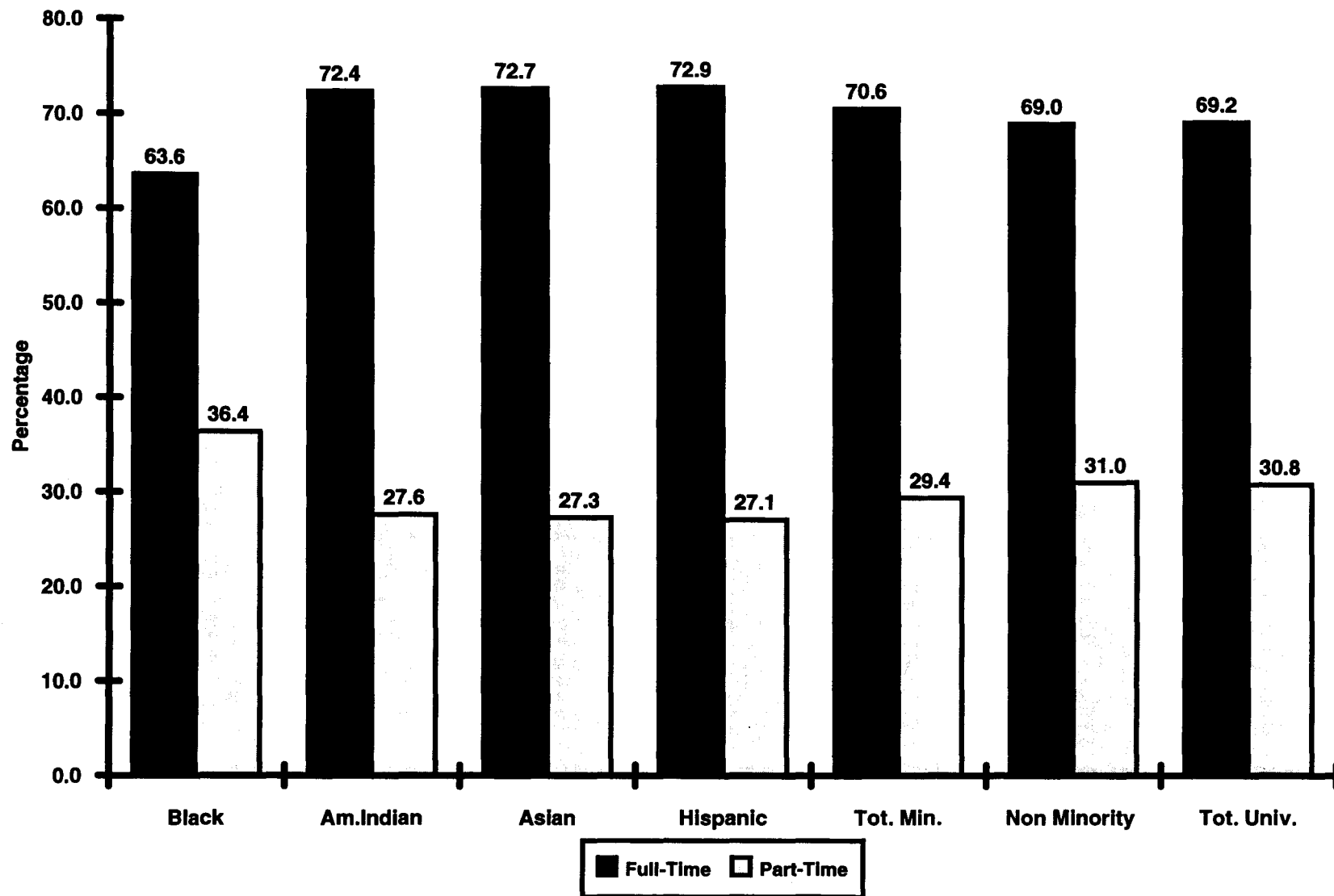

Fall Quarter 1996

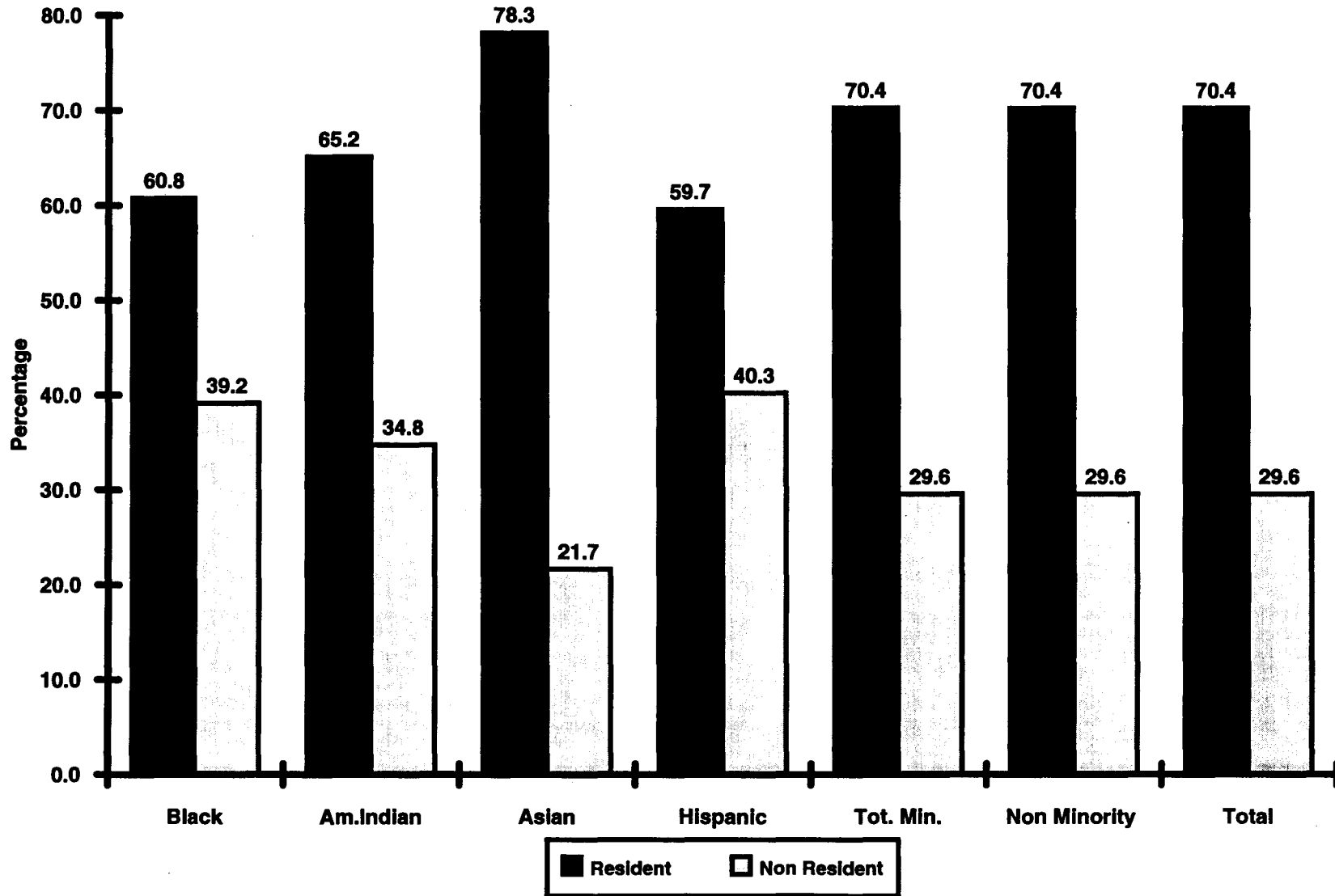

Fall Quarter 1996

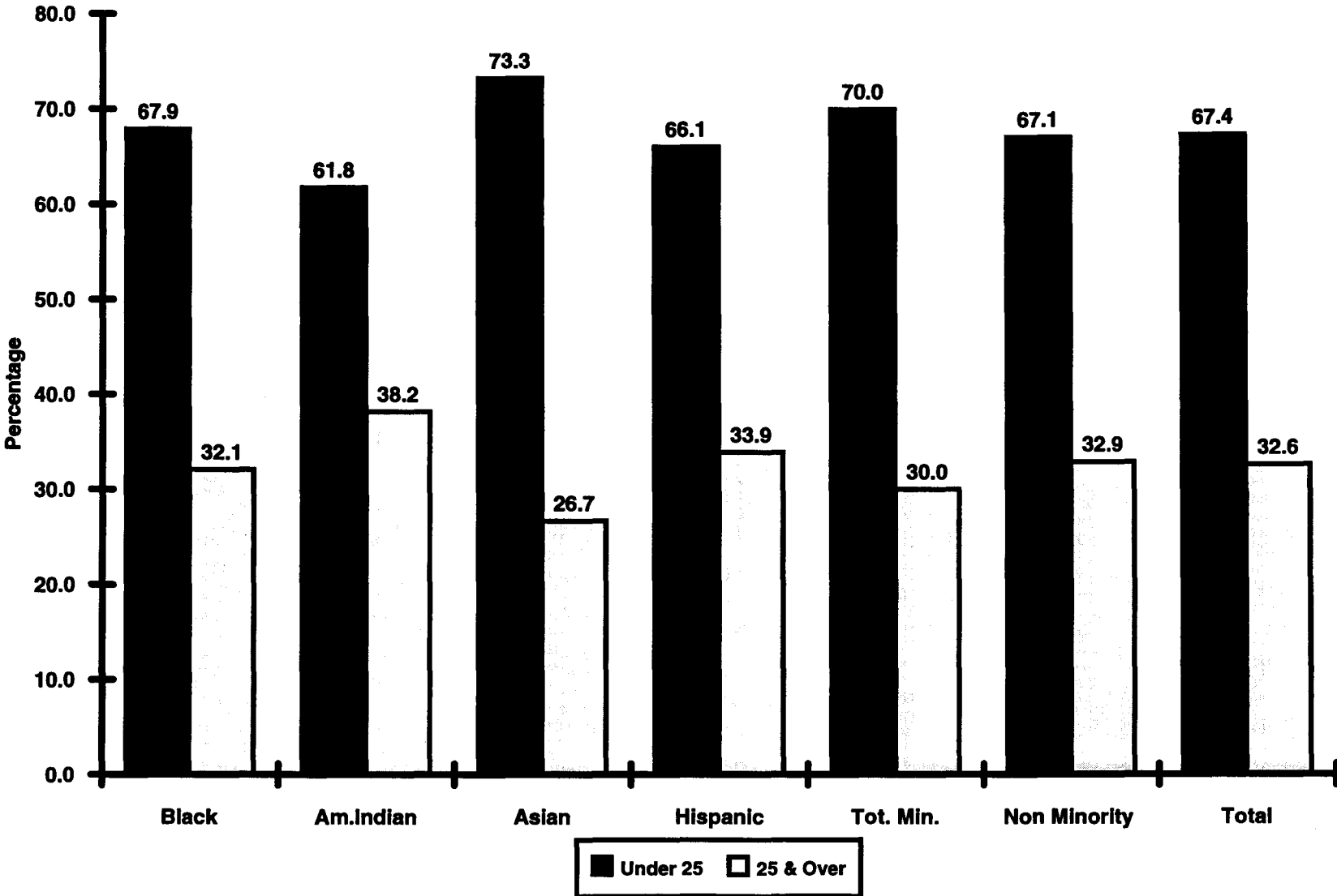

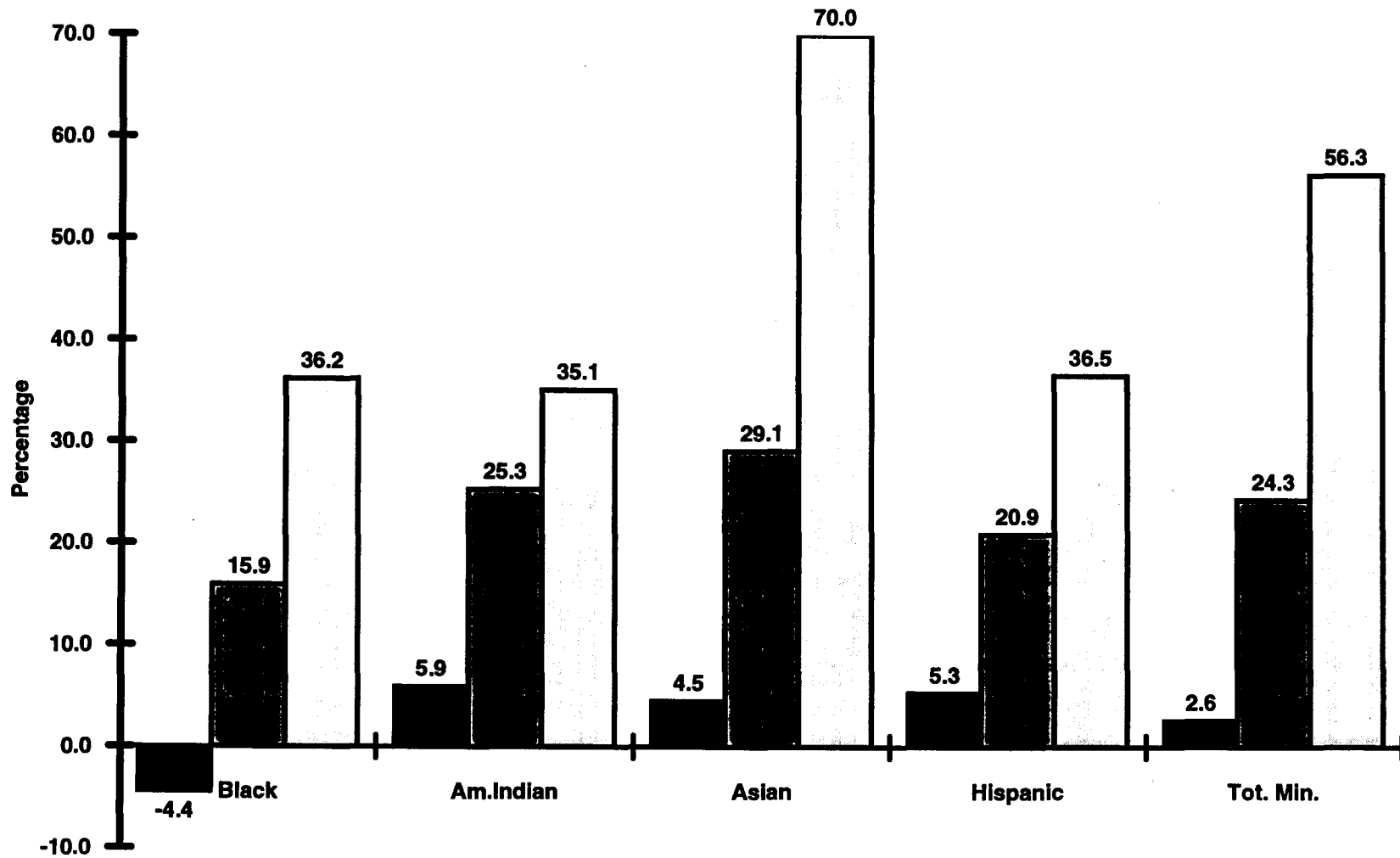
