**RESOLUTION TO CONDUCT NON-PUBLIC MEETING

WHEREAS, based on advice of the General Counsel, the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee has balanced the purposes served by the Open Meeting Law and by the attorney-client privilege, and determined that there is a need for absolute confidentiality to discuss litigation strategy in particular matters involving the University of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with Minnesota State Statute Section 13D.01, Subd. 3; and 13D.05, Subd. 3(b), a non-public meeting of the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee will be held on Thursday, November 10, 2005 at 8:30 a.m. in the William R. Peterson Conference Room, 600 McNamara Alumni Center, for the purpose of discussing attorney-client privileged matters including the following:

- I. *Haugdahl v. Regents of the University of Minnesota*
- II. Potential Antitrust Claims

The committee voted unanimously to approve the resolution.
