Media Shows

BRINGING HOME THE BACON, an 11 minute slide/tape presentation focusing on working women and the need for realistic preparation by women planning career options. Rental fee: \$10.00 plus expenses. Equipment needed: Movie screen, slide projector, tape cassette player.

THE CONSCIOUSNESS OF SERVITUDE, a 45 minute sound-slide presentation designed for high school students dealing with the history of feminism, comparing and contrasting the suffrage movement of the 19th and early 20th century, and modern feminism, dating from 1960. Cost: postage and insurance. Equipment needed: 2 movie screens, 1 stereotape recorder with adapter, 2 slide projectors.

WHERE AM I NOW WHEN I NEED ME?, a 40 minute live multi-media presentation with slides, singing and audience participation, designed to show the different expectations our society has of women and men. Rental fee: \$50.00. Equipment needed: a table for the projector, and 2 regular or 1 long extension cord with 2 plug-ins. Two women make the presentation, bringing most of the equipment.
