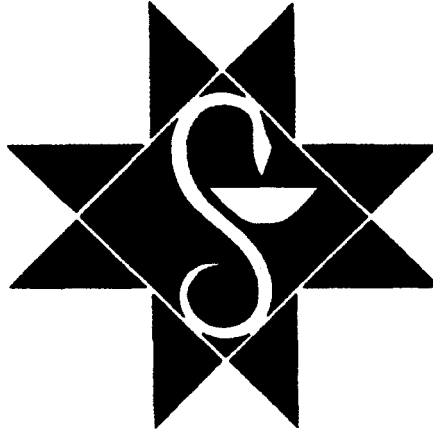

Pharm.D. candidates wear the black doctoral gown. It has long, full sleeves with velvet crossbars of black or a color matching the hood trim. Mortarboards are worn with black tassels.

The hood is the most recognizable feature of the American academic costume. Its length and shape indicate the degree that is granted; the lining displays the official colors of the university: maroon and gold for University of Minnesota graduates; and the velvet trim indicates field of study. Pharmacy students will be receiving hoods that have an olive green trim, the traditional color of pharmacy.
