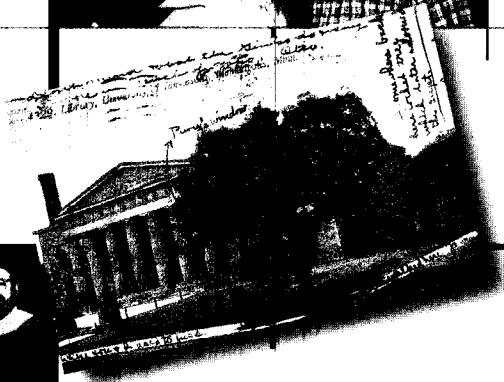

Graduation with Distinction

Undergraduates graduating with distinction are wearing gold medallions at the ceremony. Graduation with high distinction is granted to students who have maintained a minimum 3.90 GPA. To qualify for either honor, students must have completed 60 or more credits at the University of Minnesota. Only University coursework is considered in determining GPA for distinction.
