James H. Rothenberger is a native of Minneapolis and completed both his undergraduate and graduate studies at the University of Minnesota. He is a member of the faculty of the School of Public Health at the University and is an adjunct faculty member of the College of St. Thomas in St. Paul.

Jim has primary responsibility for undergraduate personal and community health courses and is faculty adviser for undergraduates taking health courses through the University College. He also teaches courses on Social Policy and Health Education. He is a team teacher, with Professor Burger, for the course, Dying and Death in Contemporary Society, jointly offered by the School of Public Health and the Program of Mortuary Science.

Jim has served as a consultant in areas of chemical dependency for many state and federal government agencies and institutions of higher learning. He serves on community boards in corrections, organ transplantation and adolescent chemical dependency treatment. Presently, he is the coordinator of a grant for training health professionals in AIDS, and serves on several state AIDS committees.
