## **Our Commencement Speaker**

Verlyn O. Smith was born in Viborg, South Dakota. He has served as the Metropolitan Pastor for Lutheran Campus Ministry, and is currently the Pastor of Grace University Lutheran Church located within the medical complex of the University Hospital. He earned his BA degree (Magna Cum Laude), with majors in English and Philosophy, from Augustana College in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. He received his Bachelor of Theology Degree with Honors from Luther Theological Seminary in St. Paul. The University of Chicago conferred on him the Master of Arts degree, with his area of concentration in Christianity Since the Reformation.

Mr. Smith has served widely in parish and administrative positions. He has combined with his professional responsibilities a continuing interest in History, Lay Theology, and various Social Issue Causes.

For the past eight years, he has served as a resource lecturer in the Program of Mortuary Science in the field of suicide, with a special emphasis on the grief of the survivors of suicide. In 1978, he was the co-founder of Suicide Grief Support Groups in the Twin Cities metropolitan area.

His invitation to give the Charge to the Class of 1990 was by request of the student commencement planning committee.
