Our Commencement Speaker

Everett Hantge is a funeral director from Hutchinson, Minnesota. He was invited to give the Charge to the Class of 1992 by request of the students.

Mr. Hantge's adult life has been dedicated to service. His military background demonstrates service to his country. After completing active duty, he served for thirteen years in the National Guard, where he earned the rank of Captain. Before his retirement from the Guard, he served three years as Commanding Officer of Company B, 682 Engineering Battalion. His extensive involvement in civic organizations demonstrates service to his community. His credits include being the former chairman of the United Way Program, and the Faith Lutheran Church.
