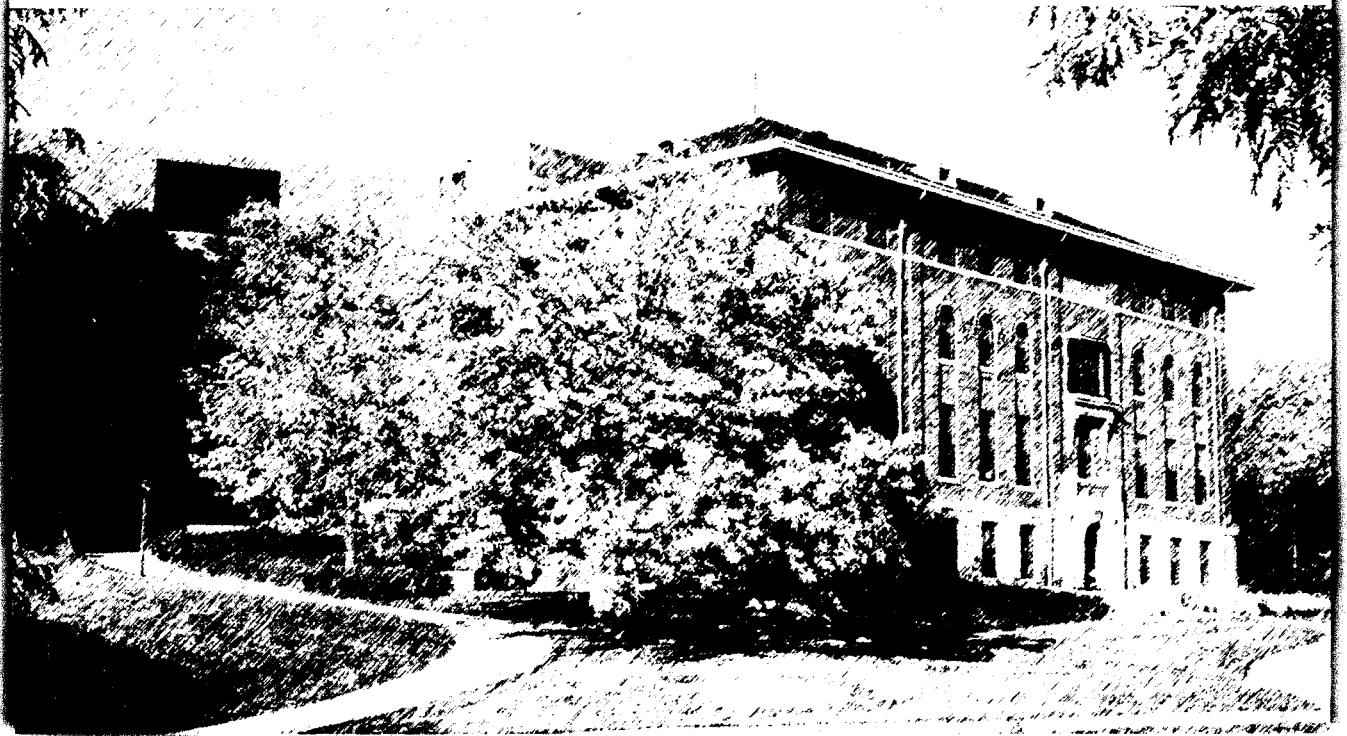

Dudley Riggs is the founder of the Instant Theatre Company in New York and The Brave New Workshop Theater in Minneapolis. The Brave New Workshop, America's oldest continuing satirical revue theater, has presented comedy and satire based on current events on PBS television and for NPR's "All Things Considered."

The Brave New Workshop touring companies have brought stage production to over five hundred colleges coast to coast, always under the banner of "Positive Neutrality and Promiscuous Skepticism." In over two hundred stage productions, no issue has been too controversial. Nothing is sacred in this theater that continues to offer entertainment year-round in Minneapolis.

Mr. Riggs, who is the theater's Artistic Director Emeritus, is presently writing a history of improvisational theater. He is the recipient of the National Comedy Award ("Charlie") and the Urban Gorilla Award.

Candidates for Degrees

This program contains the names of College of Human Ecology students who have applied to graduate from fall semester 2002 through summer 2003. This is not an official University of Minnesota graduation list.

To graduate with *distinction*, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher at graduation. To graduate with *high distinction*, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher. Graduation with designated Latin honors (*cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *summa cum laude*) is limited to students who participate in the College of Human Ecology Upper Division Honors Program. Students must complete at least two academic honors options, a capstone project, and in their last 60 University of Minnesota credits maintain a 3.50 GPA for *cum laude*, a 3.66 GPA for *magna cum laude*, and a 3.75 GPA for *summa cum laude* honors. Candidates for academic honors are noted in this program.

Φ Phi Upsilon Omicron is a national honor society recognizing and encouraging achieved excellence in scholarship, leadership, and service in the fields of family and consumer sciences. It was founded on February 10, 1909 here at the University of Minnesota (the alpha chapter) and is represented today by more than 60 collegiate chapters and 40 alumni chapters with 80,000 members. Phi Upsilon Omicron members are denoted in the program with Φ after their name.
