## ACADEMIC COSTUME INFORMATION

### Caps

*The cap at the University of Minnesota is the same for all academic degrees. The long point of the shell should be worn to the rear.*

### Tassels

*Tassels are fastened to the top of the cap and hang on either side "as the wind blows." Tassels for University College are old gold and white.*

### Honors Cord

*Undergraduate degree candidates who are graduating with honors (cum laude, magna cum laude & summa cum laude) should wear the honors cords on the right shoulder and the arm should be slopped through the insigna loop. Either color may come first.*

### Hoods

*The hood is the most outstanding feature of the American academic costume. The length and shape of the hood indicates the degree that is granted; the lining displays the official colors of the university, and the velvet trim indicates the field of study. The lining of the University of Minnesota hood is maroon and gold.*

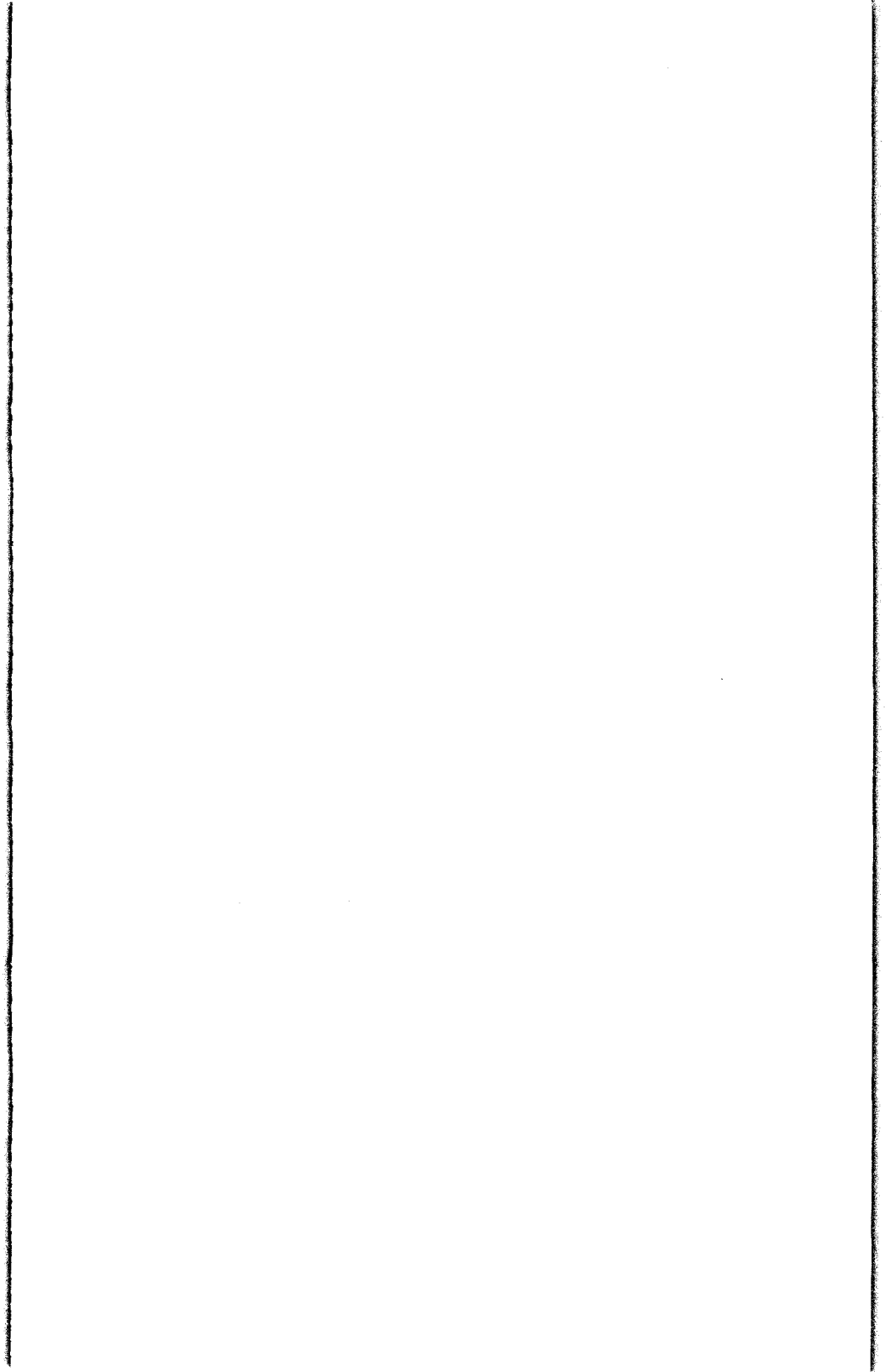
