## **David S. Kidwell**

Dr. David S. Kidwell is the Dean of the Curtis L. Carlson School of Management at the University of Minnesota. He holds an undergraduate degree in mechanical engineering from California State University at San Diego, an MBA from California State University at San Francisco, and a Ph.D. in finance from the University of Oregon.

Dr. Kidwell's previous Dean position was at the School of Business Administration at the University of Connecticut. Prior to joining the University of Connecticut, he held the Keehn Berry Chair of Banking at Tulane University, held the Blount National Bank Chair of Finance at the University of Tennessee, held the Briscoe Chair of Bank Management at Texas Tech University, and was on the faculty at the Krannert Graduate School of Management, Purdue University. While at Purdue University, he was twice voted the outstanding teacher of the year award for the School of Business.

In addition, Dean Kidwell has been a management consultant for Coopers and Lybrand in their San Francisco office and a sales engineer for Bethlehem Steel Corporation. He is the author of over eighty articles dealing with the U.S. financial system and capital markets, and is the author of *Financial Institutions, Markets, and Money* (The Dryden Press, Fourth Edition, 1990), the leading college level textbook on the U.S. financial system. Dean Kidwell has participated in a number of research grants funded by the National Science Foundation to study the efficiency of the U.S. capital markets, and to study the impact of government regulations upon the delivery of consumer financial services. Recently, one of his papers was the winner of the 1991 Financial Management Association's Competitive Paper Award in the area of fixed income research. Finally, he has conducted seminars around the country and overseas on the U.S. financial system, commercial banking, and money and capital markets. His consulting clients include several major New York City banks, Wall Street firms, and major universities.
