THE OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This evening, at the Law School Recognition Exercises, the University of Minnesota has the distinct pleasure of presenting the University's Outstanding Achievement Award to three of its distinguished graduates, nationally known leaders in government, public service, and business. They have, in the diverse paths they have trod since their graduation, fulfilled the hopes of their Alma Mater and reflected true honor upon her. They possess in every respect, the attributes of leadership, honor and service which the award symbolizes.

The Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota authorized the establishment of the Outstanding Achievement Award in 1947. This award includes an engraved gold medal and an individually prepared certificate citing the distinguished individuals for their signal accomplishments and achievements.

Nominations for Outstanding Achievement Awards are made by faculty members, departments, and colleges of the University to the University Senate Honors Committee. The Honors Committee makes its nominations from this list to the Administrative Committee of the University Senate and, upon approval of this committee, to the Board of Regents.
