A DEDICATED worker in alumni affairs, he negotiated, in the early 1960's, a guaranteed student loan program, which has since provided many hundreds of thousands of dollars in loans to law students; as President of the Law Alumni Association from 1965 to 1969, he greatly increased interest in the Law School by its alumni, and developed the Minnesota Law Fund; he has recruited a large number of Pillsbury Fellows, bringing the total to 30 who are Law School graduates.

A LOYAL supporter of the University, he is active on the Board of Directors of the Law Alumni Association, and is the Chairman of its Minnesota Law School Fund Grants Committee; he has also been a member of the Board of Directors of the University of Minnesota Foundation since 1970.
