  - Doctor of Philosophy students receive hoods that have blue trim

# Hail! Minnesota

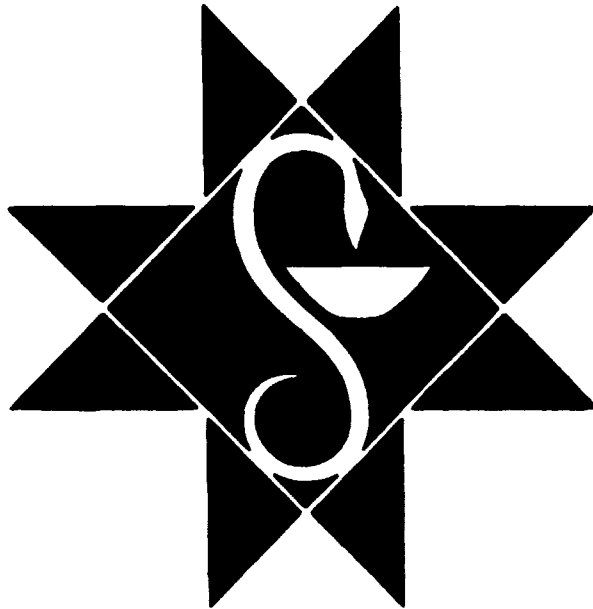
