

> ACADEMIC COSTUME

Academic gowns date back to the 14th century, when they served two functions of nearly equal importance: to indicate the academic rank of the wearer and to keep the scholar warm in the drafty stone halls of academia.

The markings, cut, and colors of the modern-day academic costume—cap, gown, and sometimes hood—indicate the academic degree, the field of study, and the institution that granted the degree. At commencement ceremonies those who already have a doctoral degree wear hoods. Degree candidates wear the gowns appropriate for the degrees they are about to receive, and new doctorates are hooded on stage.

Bachelor's degree gowns are black and untrimmed. A tassel hanging from the mortar board worn on the head is color-coded by college at the University of Minnesota. The College of Liberal Arts tassel is white. Honors graduates wear a medallion adorned with a maroon and gold ribbon.

Master's degree gowns, black and untrimmed, have pointed sleeves. Doctoral gowns in the United States traditionally have been black with velvet front facings and crossbars on the sleeves but in recent years a number of universities have adopted gowns of distinctive school colors.

The Minnesota hood, which may be worn by anyone with a doctoral degree from the University of Minnesota, is black with maroon chevron on gold. Each institution has its own pattern of colors on the hood, worn around the neck and down the back of the gown. The length and shape of the hood identify the most advanced degree the wearer has earned, and the velvet edging shows the field: blue for doctor of philosophy, light blue for doctor of education, and pink for doctor of musical arts.

> THE MACE

The University of Minnesota mace was carried for the first time in 1961 by Regents Professor of Physics Alfred O.C. Nier at the inauguration of President O. Meredith Wilson. Art professor Philip Morton designed the mace: a crystal sphere four inches in diameter surmounted by the North Star, symbol of the state of Minnesota, on a solid aluminum handle set with the University regents seal.

The University of Minnesota, ranked among the nation's top public universities, reflects the state of Minnesota's strong and enduring commitment to education. It is nearly unique among universities in the United States in its three defining characteristics:

- It is an international research university.
- It is a public land-grant institution with a strong tradition of education and public service.
- Its largest campus—the Twin Cities campus—is located in a vibrant metropolitan area including not one, but two great cities: Minneapolis and St. Paul.

The University is the primary center in Minnesota (and much of the Upper Midwest) for education and research in the liberal arts and sciences, health sciences, law, education, engineering, agriculture, and natural resources. The Twin Cities campus comprises 19 colleges and offers a full range of academic and professional degrees. A comprehensive campus in Duluth offers undergraduate and graduate programs. The Morris campus offers a four-year liberal arts program. Crookston offers associate and baccalaureate degrees in technical, career-oriented programs. The Rochester campus provides graduate and undergraduate degrees, with a special focus on health sciences and biotechnology. Through the Minnesota Extension Service, the University is present in each of Minnesota's 87 counties.

When the University was founded as a preparatory school in 1851, Minnesota had been a territory for just

two years, and statehood was still seven years away. The school was built on little more than the pioneers' faith in education. In its early years, the University struggled financially; during the Civil War, it was forced to close. It reopened in 1867, thanks to the energetic leadership of Governor John S. Pillsbury, who came to be known as the "Father of the University." Mathematics professor William Watts Folwell became the University's first president in 1869. Eric Kaler is the University's 16th president.

Two students received bachelor of arts degrees at the first commencement in June 1873. Since then, the University has granted nearly 600,000 degrees.

University alumni include eight Nobel Prize winners, 15 of Minnesota's 40 governors, a former chief justice of the United States Supreme Court, two former U.S. vice presidents, the heads of Fortune 500 companies, pioneers in medicine, civil rights leaders, top journalists, distinguished teachers and scholars, performing artists, and countless other men and women who have achieved distinction in every field.

Alumni, their families, and friends are always welcome at the University. We invite you to visit campus regularly to enjoy the many educational, cultural, and entertainment opportunities that are open to the public—including performances by students in CLA's vibrant arts programs. We also invite you to continue your relationship with the University through the Minnesota Alumni Association and the CLA Alumni Society.

With some 17,000 undergraduate and graduate students, the College of Liberal Arts (CLA) prepares more students than any other college at the University of Minnesota—in fact, more than any other college in the state of Minnesota, public or private.

Students are taught by approximately 550 permanent faculty members—teachers and researchers of international stature—and they choose from more than 60 majors or design their own cross-disciplinary program.

Most CLA students complete their undergraduate education in the college. Others complete their basic liberal arts coursework in CLA, then transfer to another unit of the University. The college offers strong pre-professional programs with close ties to the University's health sciences and other professional schools.

Since the University's earliest days, the liberal arts have been its essence and academic core.

This is because, as William Watts Folwell, first president of this land-grant University, put it, they "enrich and emancipate communities." They prepare thoughtful citizens by posing difficult questions about the nature and meaning of our lives, and by addressing some of the most important issues that confront our nation and the world.

Examples are easy to find. We need to understand history, culture, religion, and language to appreciate and navigate the shifting ground of diplomacy and politics; leaders who lack that understanding affect war and peace around the world. We need to understand economics to survive in the current climate; economics without ethics

has led to a worldwide recession. Justice and equality, belief and truth, the beauty of the written word, a work of art, a musical passage—these equip us to create a meaningful life, a life worth living.

Liberal arts graduates can challenge accepted paradigms, create bold new ideas or artistic works, view issues from multiple perspectives. They can develop hypotheses and collect data, reason soundly about complex questions, and, above all, communicate clearly and ethically.

By choosing a liberal arts education they have prepared themselves for a life-long, self-motivated voyage of discovery. They know there are no pat answers to be found in the back of the book—but are prepared to create, critique, synthesize, and defend their own independent thinking. They can know themselves from the standpoint of other times, people, and cultures, which makes them less egocentric—and more able to live in a world where people must get along together.

Today's graduates are likely to lead nomadic lives of short-term jobs—some of which have not even been invented yet—and multiple careers. But the liberal arts have provided them solid grounding across disciplines, centuries, cultures, and geographic boundaries, and in research, ways of thinking and communication skills—the very best preparation for life in a rapidly changing world.

ERIC W. KALER

PRESIDENT, UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA



When Eric Kaler took office on July 1, 2011, he became only the second alumnus to rise to the position of University of Minnesota president.

In his first year on the job, President Kaler emphasized his commitment to academic excellence and rigor by investing in new faculty positions. He stressed the importance of the University's groundbreaking research enterprise. He led a campaign to contain costs and operate the U more efficiently and effectively, with the goal of freeing up resources for the University's core teaching, research, and public engagement and service mission.

He acted on a pledge to keep the University accessible to students of all economic backgrounds by increasing financial aid and limiting the University's 2012 tuition increase to the smallest this century.

Now, in his second academic year, President Kaler has proposed a zero tuition increase for Minnesota resident undergraduates as part of his first biennial budget request to the Minnesota Legislature. He has proposed a set of innovative tax and tuition relief initiatives to aid students, their families, and donors, and also proposed performance measures that the U must meet to gain some of its state support.

He has proposed an ambitious and directed research initiative called MnDRIVE, which is aligning the University's research and discovery strengths with the state's most pressing needs and key industries.

In 2012, Secretary of Homeland Security Janet Napolitano named President Kaler to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Academic Advisory Council.

In 2013, President Kaler was named a Charter Fellow of the National Academy of Inventors.

President Kaler received his Ph.D. in chemical engineering from the University in 1982. He went on to become one of the nation's foremost experts on "complex fluids," which have applications in drug delivery, food processing, pharmaceuticals, and manufacturing.

Before coming to the University of Minnesota, Kaler served from 2007 to 2011 as provost and senior vice president for academic affairs at Stony Brook University in Stony Brook, N.Y. Previously he was dean of the University of Delaware's College of Engineering. He also taught at the University of Washington. He received his undergraduate degree from the California Institute of Technology in 1978.

Eric Kaler and his wife, Karen, have two adult sons.

KAREN HANSON

SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS AND PROVOST



Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost Karen Hanson began her post at the University on February 1, 2012.

Provost Hanson's arrival at the University of Minnesota was a homecoming for her. She received her bachelor of arts, summa cum laude, in philosophy and mathematics here in 1970. She went on to earn both her master's and doctoral degrees in philosophy from Harvard University in 1980.

Prior to returning to Minnesota, Hanson served as provost at the Bloomington campus of Indiana University and executive vice president of that university from July 2007 to January 2012.

Provost Hanson's research interests are in the philosophy of mind, ethics and aesthetics, and American philosophy. She has published many articles and essays in these areas and is the author of the book *The Self Imagined: Philosophical Reflections on the Social Character of Psyche* and a co-editor

of the book *Romantic Revolutions: Criticism and Theory*.

She has twice been elected to the executive committee of the Central Division of the American Philosophical Association (APA) and to the APA National Board of Officers. She served as chair of the APA board from 2004 to 2005. From 1993 to 1997, she served as the APA delegate to the American Council of Learned Societies (ACLS) and as a member of the ACLS Executive Committee.

Hanson has been an associate editor of the *Journal of Social Philosophy*, a member of the editorial board of *American Philosophical Quarterly*, and a trustee for the American Society for Aesthetics. Her current editorial board memberships include *Notre Dame Philosophical Reviews* and *Cognitio*, and she is an officer of the board of the John Dewey Foundation and a member of the advisory board of the Peirce Edition Project.

LIBERAL ARTS DEGREES

The College of Liberal Arts offers five bachelor's degrees—bachelor of arts (B.A.), bachelor of individualized studies (B.I.S.), bachelor of fine arts (B.F.A.), bachelor of music (B.M.), and bachelor of science (B.S.). The bachelor's degrees have many requirements in common.

DEGREE CANDIDATES

College of Liberal Arts degree candidates may graduate with Latin Honors, Distinction, or both. These citations are provisional and do not become official until all requirements for the award are fulfilled.

LATIN HONORS DESIGNATIONS - Students graduating from the College of Liberal Arts through the University Honors Program have taken part in a rigorous course of study, research, scholarship, or other creative work in the major, culminating in an Honors thesis representing independent work done under the direction of a faculty supervisor or mentor. Students graduating *cum laude* (with honor) have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 for the last 60 graded credits at UMTC. *Magna cum laude* (with great honor) awards require a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.66 and *summa cum laude* (with highest honor) awards require a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.75 in the final 60 graded credits at UMTC.

DISTINCTION DESIGNATIONS - Students earn graduation “with Distinction” or “with High Distinction” based on cumulative grade point average at the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities with at least 60 graded credits completed at UMTC. Students graduating “with Distinction” must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher in UMTC coursework at the time of graduation; students graduating “with High Distinction” must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher in UMTC coursework at the time of graduation.

OTHER AWARDS - Students graduating with the Community Engagement Scholar distinction have completed at least nine credits of service-learning course work, at least 400 hours of community service, and a series of reflective pieces. They also have completed an integrative community project that results in the creation of a sustainable project for a community organization.

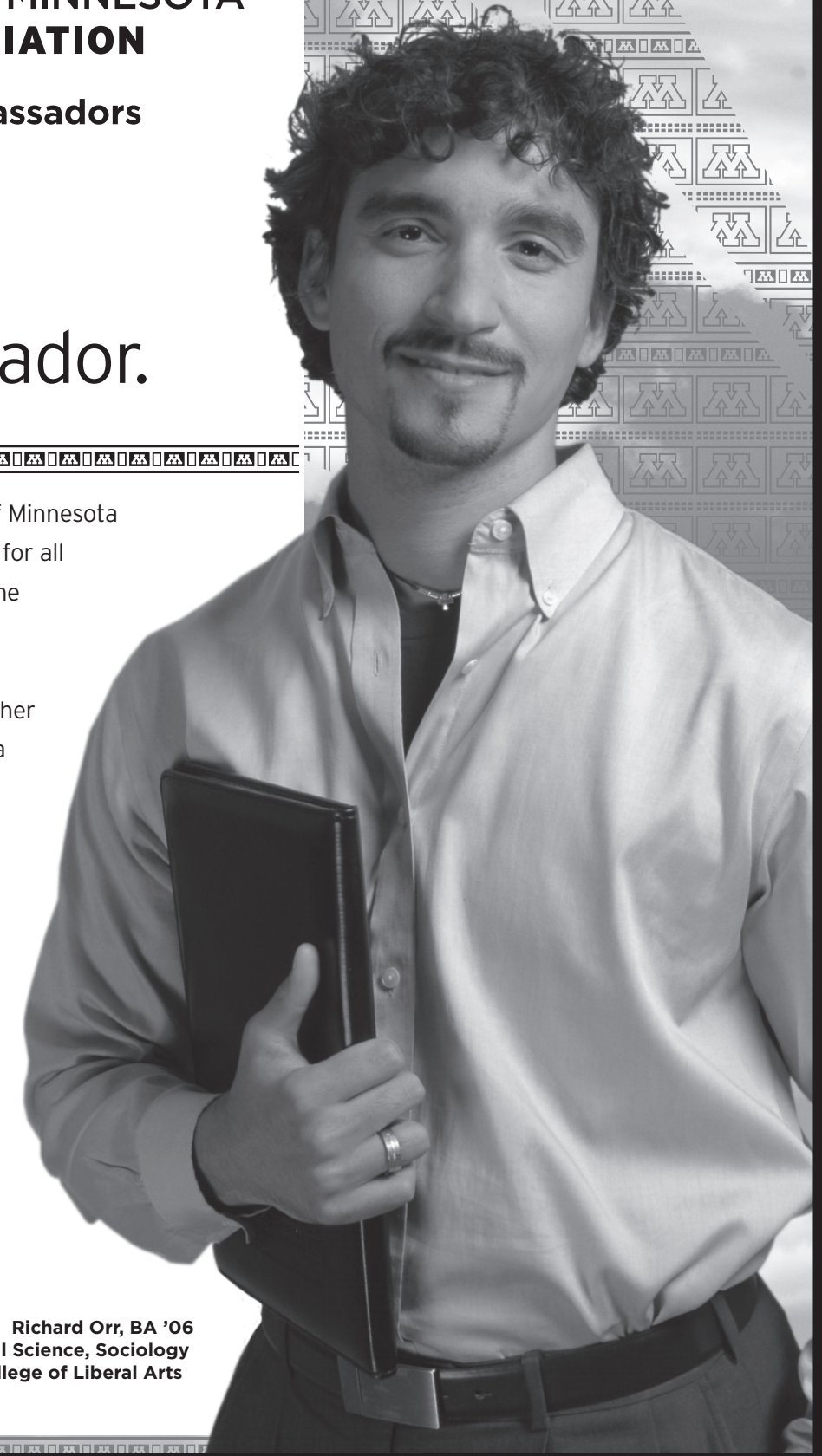
