> ACADEMIC COSTUME

Academic gowns date back to the 14th century, when they served two functions of nearly equal importance: to indicate the academic rank of the wearer and to keep the scholar warm in the drafty stone halls of academia.

The markings, cut, and colors of the modern-day academic costume—cap, gown, and sometimes hood—indicate the academic degree, the field of study, and the institution that granted the degree. At commencement ceremonies those who already have a doctoral degree wear hoods. Degree candidates wear the gowns appropriate for the degrees they are about to receive, and new doctorates are hooded on stage.

Bachelor's degree gowns are black and untrimmed. A tassel hanging from the mortar board worn on the head is color-coded by college at the University of Minnesota. The College of Liberal Arts tassel is white. Honors graduates wear a medallion adorned with a maroon and gold ribbon.

Master's degree gowns, black and untrimmed, have pointed sleeves. Doctoral gowns in the United States traditionally have been black with velvet front facings and crossbars on the sleeves but in recent years a number of universities have adopted gowns of distinctive school colors.

The Minnesota hood, which may be worn by anyone with a doctoral degree from the University of Minnesota, is black with maroon chevron on gold. Each institution has its own pattern of colors on the hood, worn around the neck and down the back of the gown. The length and shape of the hood identify the most advanced degree the wearer has earned, and the velvet edging shows the field: blue for doctor of philosophy, light blue for doctor of education, and pink for doctor of musical arts.

> THE MACE

The University of Minnesota mace was carried for the first time in 1961 by Regents Professor of Physics Alfred O.C. Nier at the inauguration of President O. Meredith Wilson. Art professor Philip Morton designed the mace: a crystal sphere four inches in diameter surmounted by the North Star, symbol of the state of Minnesota, on a solid aluminum handle set with the University regents seal.

THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA

The University of Minnesota, ranked among the nation's top public universities, reflects the state of Minnesota's strong and enduring commitment to education. It is nearly unique among universities in the United States in its three defining characteristics:

- It is an international research university.
- It is a public land-grant institution with a strong tradition of education and public service.
- Its largest campus—the Twin Cities campus—is located in a vibrant metropolitan area including not one, but two great cities: Minneapolis and St. Paul.

The University is the primary center in Minnesota (and much of the Upper Midwest) for education and research in the liberal arts and sciences, health sciences, law, education, engineering, agriculture, and natural resources. The Twin Cities campus comprises 19 colleges and offers a full range of academic and professional degrees. A comprehensive campus in Duluth offers undergraduate and graduate programs. The Morris campus offers a four-year liberal arts program. Crookston offers associate and baccalaureate degrees in technical, career-oriented programs. The Rochester campus provides graduate and undergraduate degrees, with a special focus on health sciences and biotechnology. Through the Minnesota Extension Service, the University is present in each of Minnesota's 87 counties.

When the University was founded as a preparatory school in 1851, Minnesota had been a territory for just two years, and

statehood was still seven years away. The school was built on little more than the pioneers' faith in education. In its early years, the University struggled financially; during the Civil War, it was forced to close. It reopened in 1867, thanks to the energetic leadership of Governor John S. Pillsbury, who came to be known as the "Father of the University." Mathematics professor William Watts Folwell became the University's first president in 1869. Eric Kaler is the University's 16th president.

Two students received bachelor of arts degrees at the first commencement in June 1873. Since then, the University has granted nearly 600,000 degrees.

University alumni include eight Nobel Prize winners, 15 of Minnesota's 40 governors, a former chief justice of the United States Supreme Court, two former U.S. vice presidents, the heads of Fortune 500 companies, pioneers in medicine, civil rights leaders, top journalists, distinguished teachers and scholars, performing artists, and countless other men and women who have achieved distinction in every field.

Alumni, their families, and friends are always welcome at the University. We invite you to visit campus regularly to enjoy the many educational, cultural, and entertainment opportunities that are open to the public—including performances by students in CLA's vibrant arts programs. We also invite you to continue your relationship with the University through the Minnesota Alumni Association and the CLA Alumni Society.

THE COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS



With some 17,000 undergraduate and graduate students, the College of Liberal Arts (CLA) prepares more students than any other college at the University of Minnesota—in fact, more than any other college in the state of Minnesota, public or private.

Students are taught by approximately 550 permanent faculty members—teachers and researchers of international stature—and they choose from more than 60 majors or design their own cross-disciplinary program.

Most CLA students complete their undergraduate education in the college. Others complete their basic liberal arts coursework in CLA, then transfer to another unit of the University. The college offers strong pre-professional programs with close ties to the University's health sciences and other professional schools.

Since the University's earliest days, the liberal arts have been its essence and academic core.

This is because, as William Watts Folwell, first president of this land-grant University, put it, they “enrich and emancipate communities.” They prepare thoughtful citizens by posing difficult questions about the nature and meaning of our lives, and by addressing some of the most important issues that confront our nation and the world.

Examples are easy to find. We need to understand history, culture, religion, and language to appreciate and navigate the shifting ground of diplomacy and politics; leaders who lack that understanding affect war and peace around the world. We need to understand economics to survive in the current climate;

economics without ethics has led to a worldwide recession. Justice and equality, belief and truth, the beauty of the written word, a work of art, a musical passage—these equip us to create a meaningful life, a life worth living.

Liberal arts graduates can challenge accepted paradigms, create bold new ideas or artistic works, view issues from multiple perspectives. They can develop hypotheses and collect data, reason soundly about complex questions, and, above all, communicate clearly and ethically.

By choosing a liberal arts education they have prepared themselves for a life-long, self-motivated voyage of discovery. They know there are no pat answers to be found in the back of the book—but are prepared to create, critique, synthesize, and defend their own independent thinking. They can know themselves from the standpoint of other times, people, and cultures, which makes them less egocentric—and more able to live in a world where people must get along together.

Today's graduates are likely to lead nomadic lives of short-term jobs—some of which have not even been invented yet—and multiple careers. But the liberal arts have provided them solid grounding across disciplines, centuries, cultures, and geographic boundaries, and in research, ways of thinking and communication skills—the very best preparation for life in a rapidly changing world.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, GENERATION NEXT
FORMER MAYOR, CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS

R.T. Rybak began serving as the executive director of Generation Next in early January. He served as mayor of Minneapolis from 2002 - 2013. During his tenure as mayor, R.T. led efforts to make Minneapolis a national leader in innovative, cradle-to-career approaches to youth development, and worked to highlight the crisis of our region's achievement gap and advance effective strategies for ending it.

As mayor, R.T. founded the Minneapolis Promise, an innovative cluster of coordinated efforts to get students college- and career-ready and put them on the path to success. The Minneapolis Promise says to young people that if they stay in school and focus on their education, Minneapolis will support them with high-quality summer jobs and work-readiness training through the STEP-UP program, counseling



to help them plan a vision for their future at privately-funded college and career centers in every Minneapolis public high school, and financial assistance to attend college through The Power of YOU, a collaboration between Saint Paul College, Minneapolis Community and Technical College, and the Saint Paul and Minneapolis Public Schools.

A Minneapolis native, R.T. Rybak spent almost 30 years working in journalism, the commercial real estate business, publishing and the Internet before being elected mayor in his first run for public office.

He and his wife, Megan O'Hara, a communications consultant and local-food advocate, have two grown children.

ANDREA MOKROS

SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO PRESIDENT OBAMA AND
DIRECTOR OF STRATEGIC PLANNING FOR THE FIRST LADY

Andrea Mokros serves in the White House as special assistant to the President and director of strategic planning for the First Lady. In this role, she oversees the strategic planning process for all aspects of First Lady Michelle Obama's schedule, managing an active scheduling and advance team that takes every event from inception to completion. During her tenure, Andrea has led the First Lady's travel to China, Africa, the 2012 London Olympics, as well as countless other domestic and international trips; created programming for the spouses of world leaders at US-hosted summits, including NATO and the UN General Assembly; and produced major national tours on behalf of the First Lady's *Let's Move!*, *Joining Forces*, and education initiatives.

Prior to joining the White House, Andrea served in Minnesota Governor Mark Dayton's office as deputy chief of staff, where she directed communications and outreach efforts. She served as spokesperson, crafted and executed communications strategies in support of the governor's initiatives, and led major events from the State of the State address to bill signings.

As founder and principal of Mokros Strategies, LLC, Andrea worked with local, state, and national clients to develop speeches, op-eds, and events-based communications strategies that used the



power of pictures to communicate a message. She regularly served on advance teams for the White House and the presidential campaigns of Barack Obama, Hillary Clinton, and John Kerry. She traveled the country and the world to execute principal participation in events from the G20 Summit in Toronto, to the presidential debates, to the 2004 Democratic Convention in Boston.

Andrea began her career in Minnesota politics as scheduler to Attorney General Hubert H. Humphrey, III in his campaign for governor. She went on to serve as scheduler and later as director of the Executive Office to former White House Chief of Staff Mack McLarty in his international consulting firm, Kissinger McLarty Associates. As communications director in the Minnesota State Senate, Andrea worked with senators to communicate legislative priorities and make them relevant to constituents. As deputy chief of staff to US Senator Amy Klobuchar (D-MN), Andrea spearheaded strategic planning and managed the senator's communications operation, executing countless press conferences, tours, speeches, and interviews.

Andrea is a native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin and a proud graduate of the University of Minnesota's College of Liberal Arts, Class of 1999. She currently resides in Arlington, Virginia.

LIBERAL ARTS DEGREES

The College of Liberal Arts offers five bachelor's degrees—bachelor of arts (B.A.), bachelor of individualized studies (B.I.S.), bachelor of fine arts (B.F.A.), bachelor of music (B.M.), and bachelor of science (B.S.). The bachelor's degrees have many requirements in common.

DEGREE CANDIDATES

College of Liberal Arts degree candidates may graduate with Latin Honors, Distinction, or both. These citations are provisional and do not become official until all requirements for the award are fulfilled.

LATIN HONORS DESIGNATIONS - Students graduating from the College of Liberal Arts through the University Honors Program have taken part in a rigorous course of study, research, scholarship, or other creative work in the major, culminating in an Honors thesis representing independent work done under the direction of a faculty supervisor or mentor. Students graduating *cum laude* (with honor) have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 for the last 60 graded credits at UMTC. *Magna cum laude* (with great honor) awards require a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.66 and *summa cum laude* (with highest honor) awards require a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.75 in the final 60 graded credits at UMTC.

DISTINCTION DESIGNATIONS - Students earn graduation “with Distinction” or “with High Distinction” based on cumulative grade point average at the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities with at least 60 graded credits completed at UMTC. Students graduating “with Distinction” must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher in UMTC coursework at the time of graduation; students graduating “with High Distinction” must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher in UMTC coursework at the time of graduation.

OTHER AWARDS - Students graduating with the Community Engagement Scholar distinction have completed at least nine credits of service-learning course work, at least 400 hours of community service, and a series of reflective pieces. They also have completed an integrative community project that results in the creation of a sustainable project for a community organization.

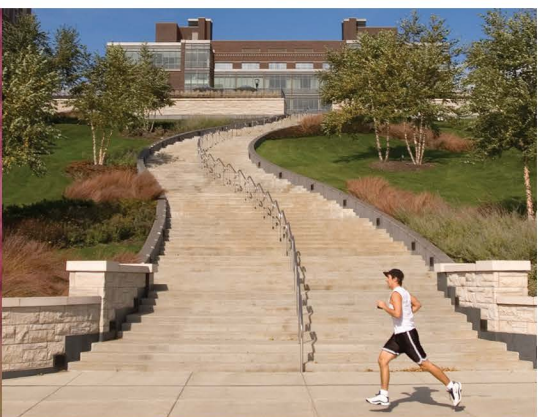
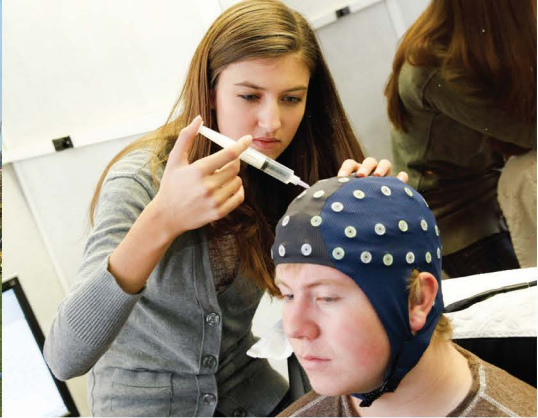
