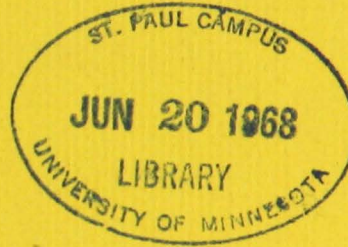

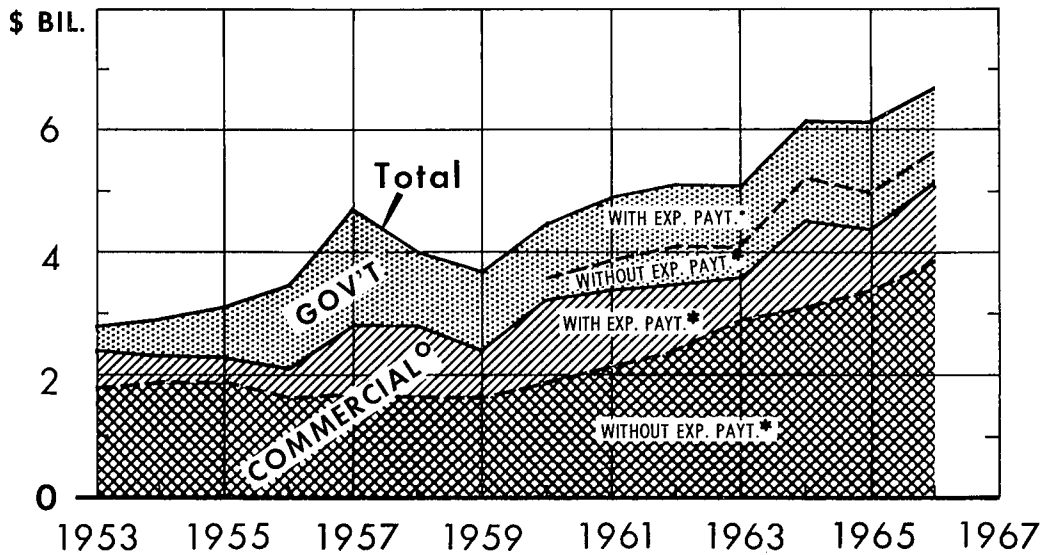

With and Without Export Payment Assistance



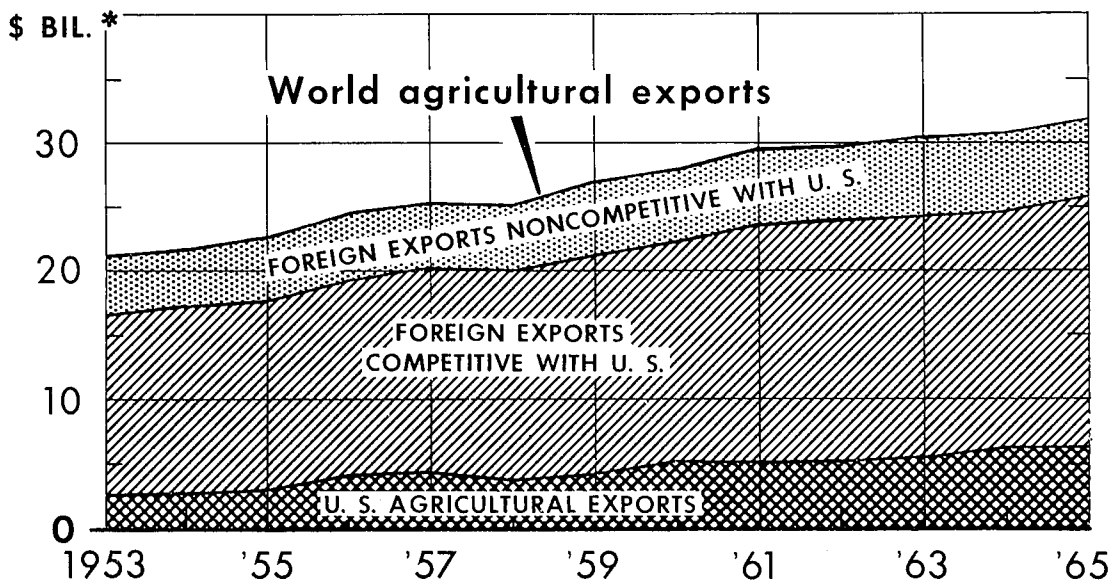

*QUANTITIES TRADED VALUED AT AVERAGE 1957-59 PRICES OF U. S. EXPORTS OR IMPORTS.

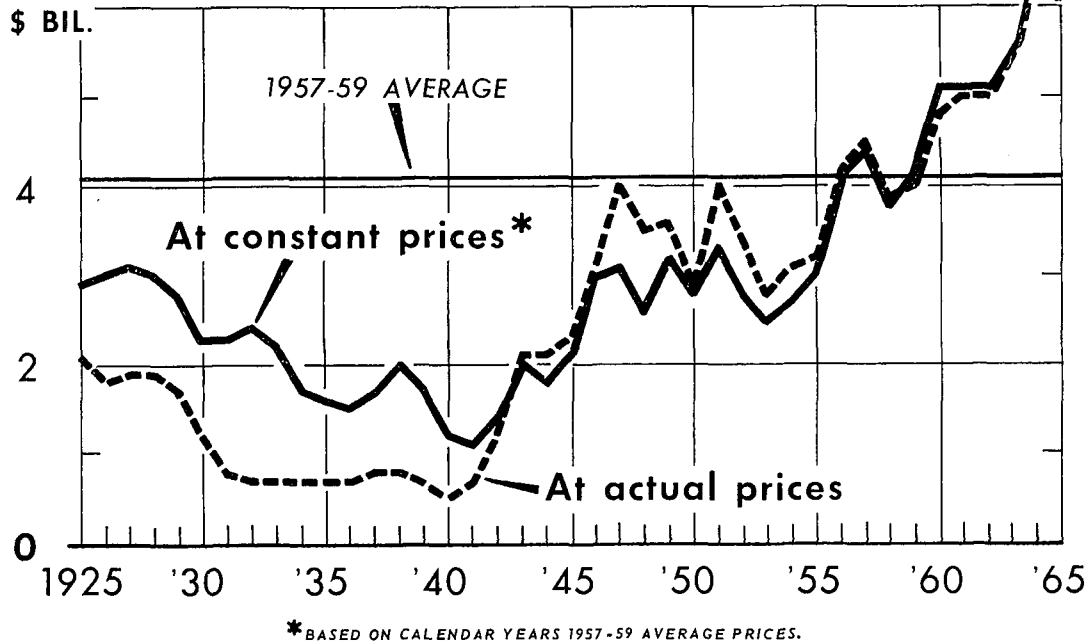

Value at Actual and Constant Prices



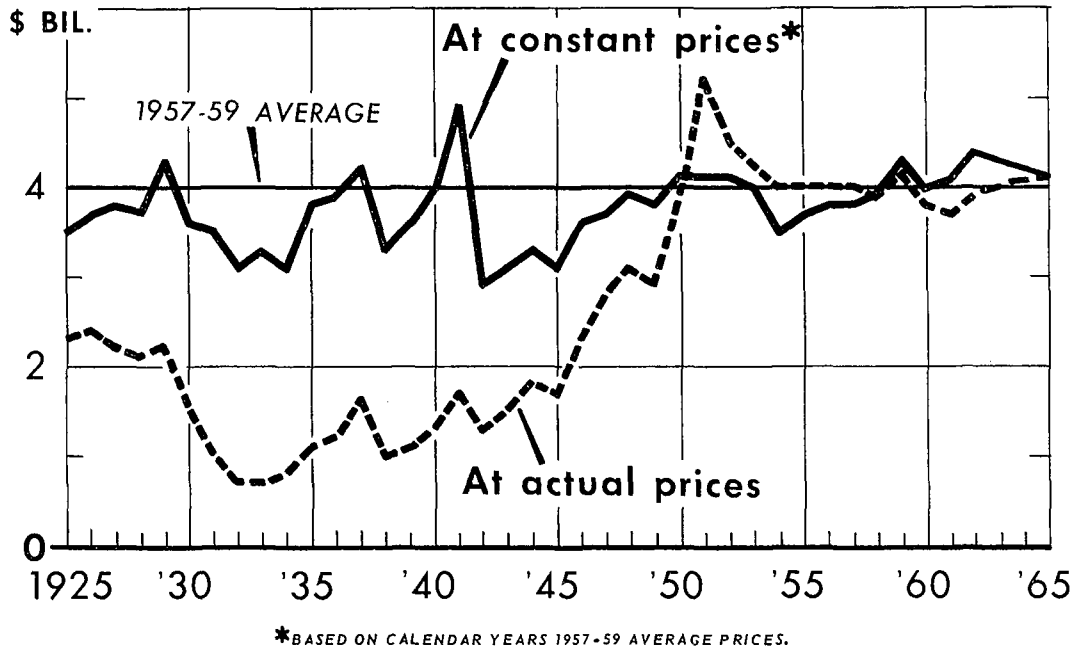

ACRES OF CROPS HARVESTED FOR U.S. EXPORTS

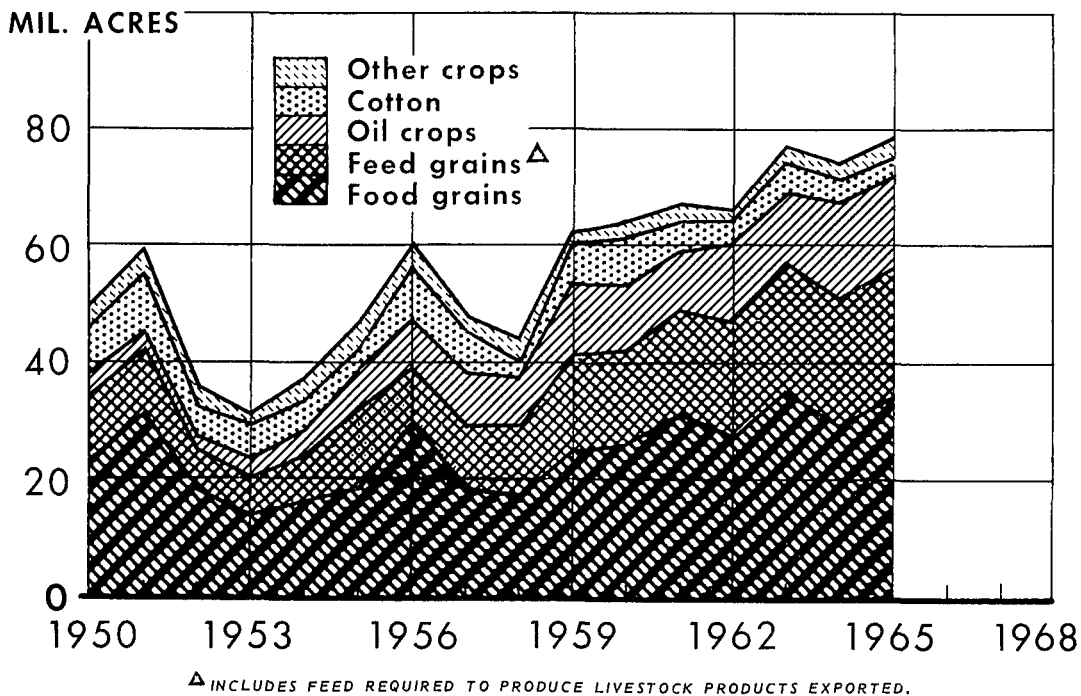
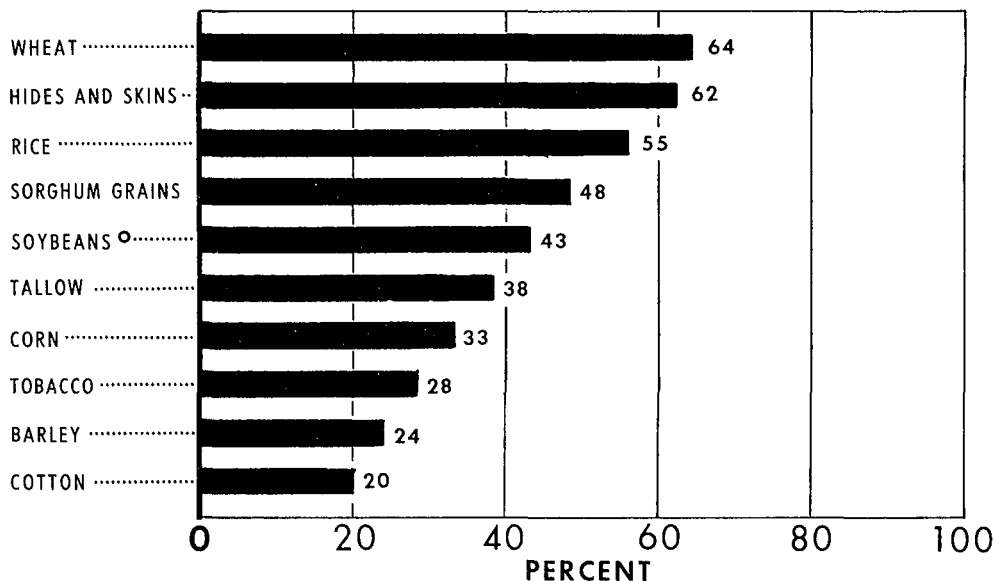

10 Major Agricultural Export Products, 1966*



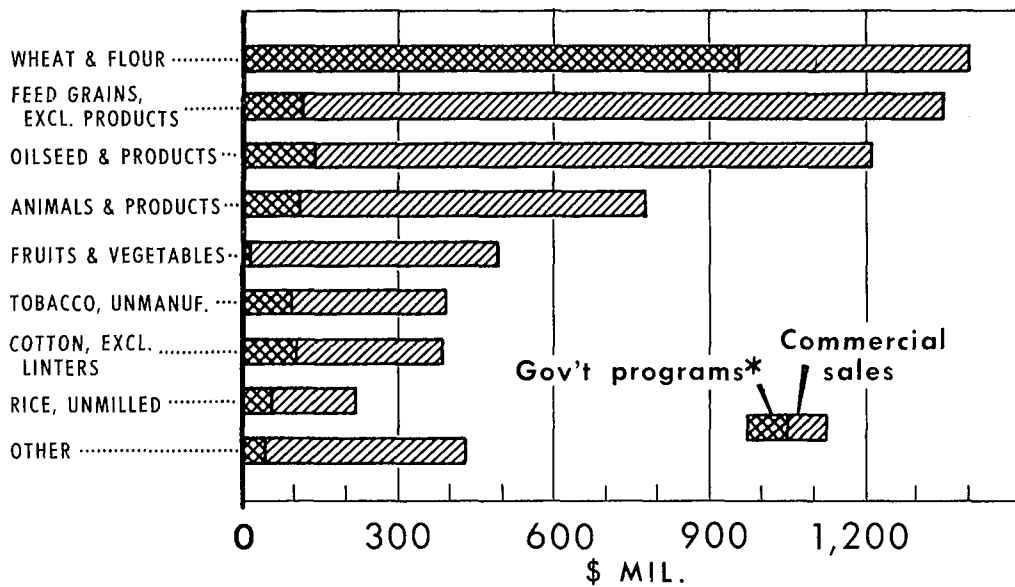

YEAR ENDING JUNE 30.

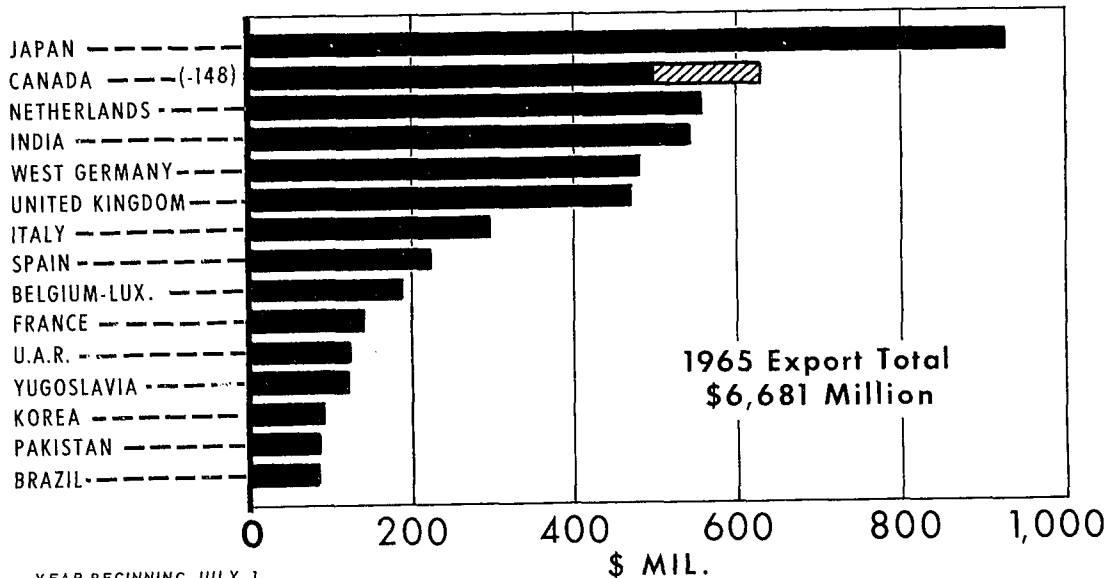

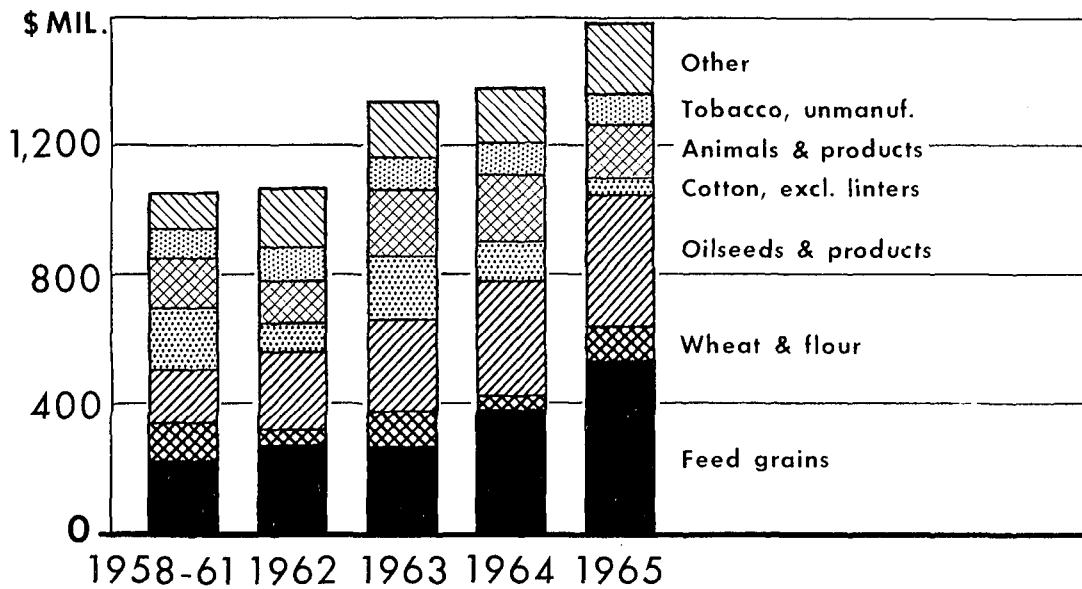

U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO EEC* BY MAJOR COMMODITY GROUPS



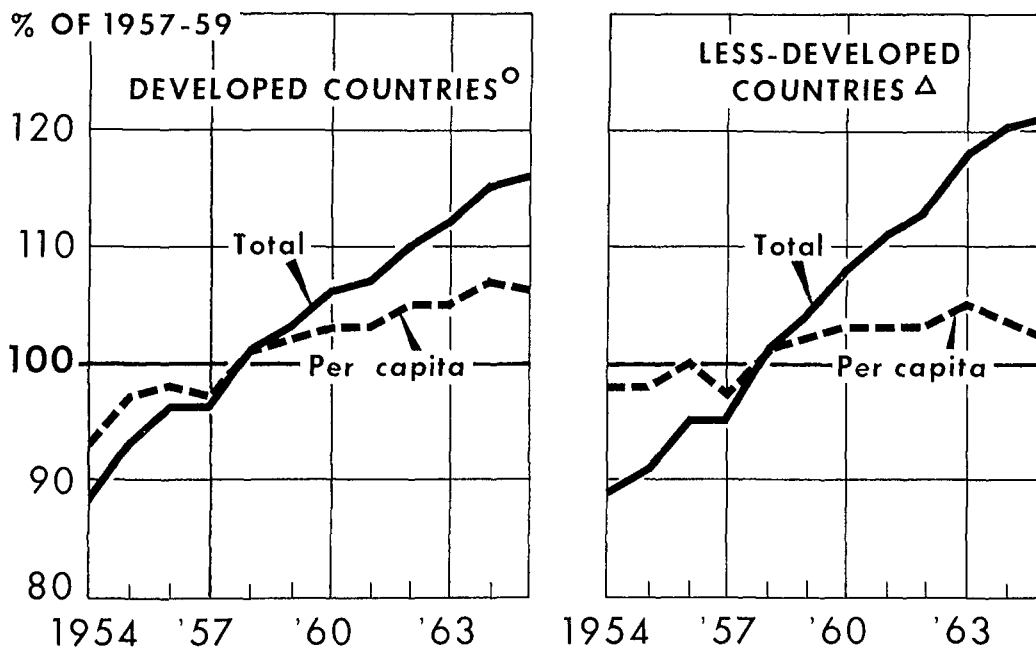

WORLD AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION



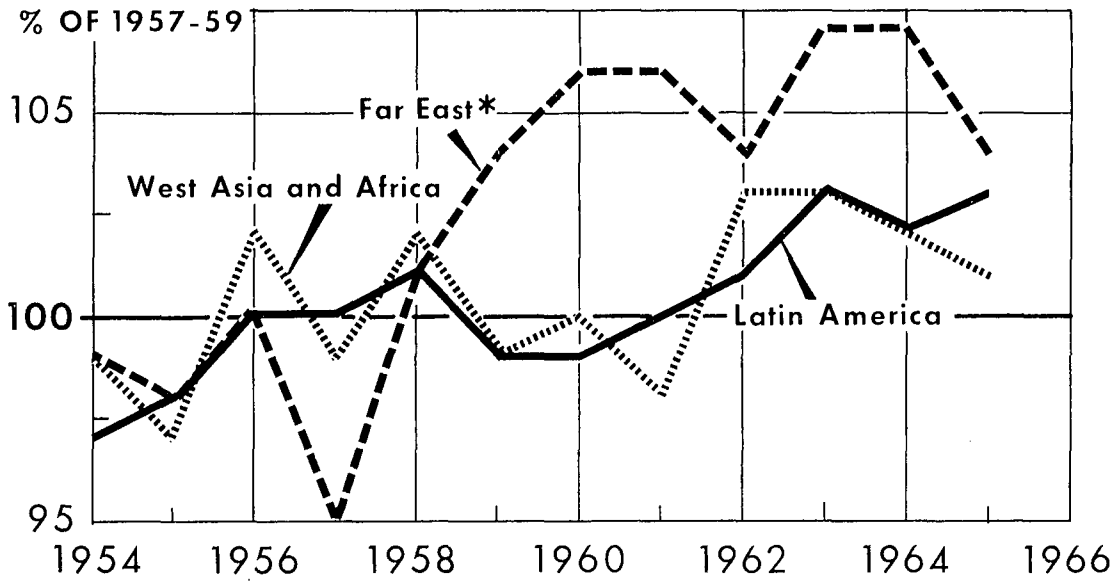

FOOD PRODUCTION PER PERSON IN THE LESS-DEVELOPED REGIONS OF THE WORLD



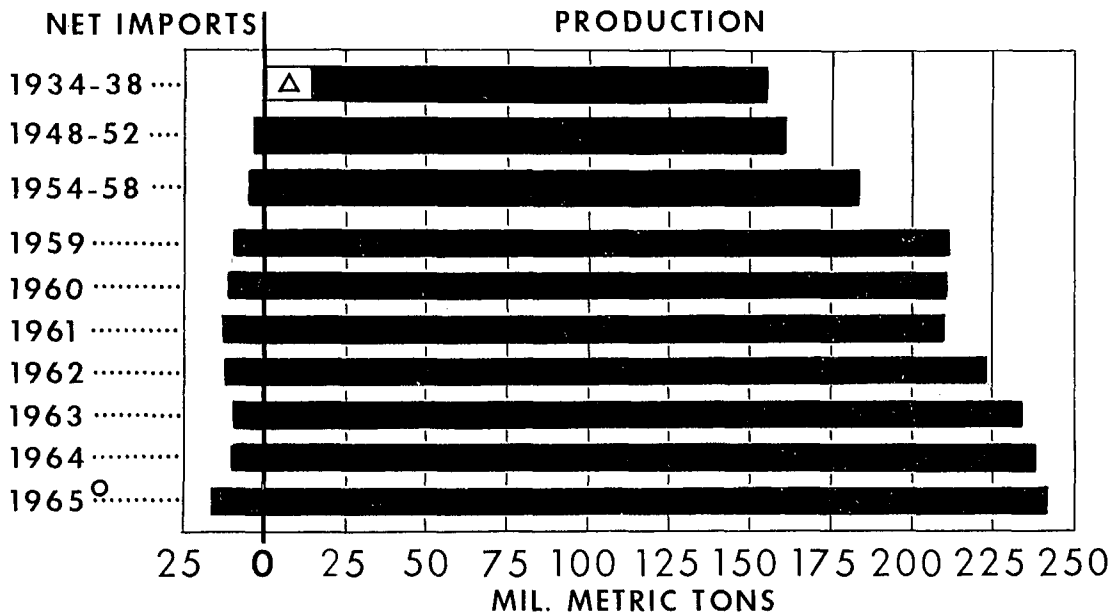

PRODUCTION AND NET TRADE IN GRAIN, LESS-DEVELOPED COUNTRIES*



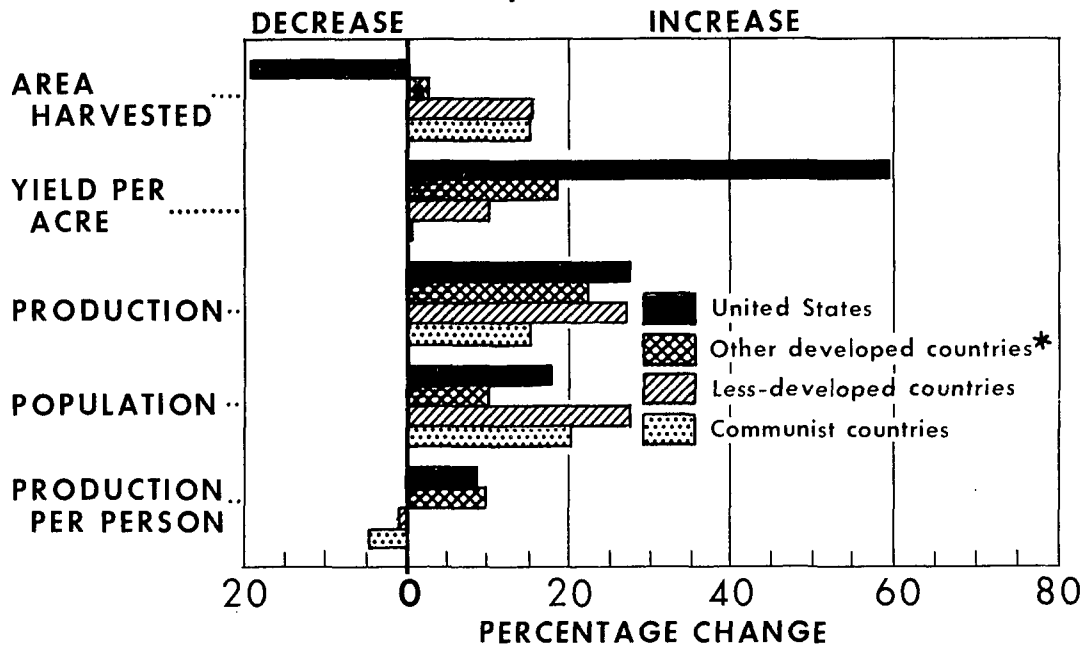
