## MINNESOTA WOMEN'S TENNIS OUTLOOK

**GOPHERS SET LOFTY GOALS** -- Last year was a season of transition for the Gopher tennis team with new coach David Creighton beginning his first year at Minnesota. The team responded well, finishing 6-6 in the Big Ten and 12-12 overall, and were represented on the all-conference team for the first time in two years, with three players named to the second team.

This year the team is shooting for the top, said Creighton. "We want to win the Big Ten title. It's exciting because the players set that goal for themselves. It wasn't a goal I set for them. We feel we can compete for it."

With a strong returning cast and three blue-chip recruits, the Gophers appear set to make such a bid. Creighton has lined up several nationally prominent teams on the Gopher schedule to prepare for the Big Ten season.

**TEAM OUTLOOK** -- The Gophers have experience on their side as they return four of the top five players in their singles lineup. Senior co-captain **Anne Gorde** was named second team All-Big Ten for her strong showing at No. 1 singles. She was 20-23 and got valuable experience playing in the Rolex National Indoor Championships. Gorde has played No. 1 singles and doubles the last two years and leads all returners with 55 career singles victories and 54 career doubles wins.

Junior **Anne Marie Ovnik** played No. 3 last year where she was 14-9 with an 8-4 Big Ten mark. She was 20-16 overall and brings leadership to the team with her motivation and attitude. Ovnik particularly excelled in doubles. She and departed doubles partner **Karin Eneberg** were named second team All-Big Ten and were 9-3 in the conference and 23-10 in all matches. Junior **Tonya Breitag** is another veteran who Creighton cites as a positive role model for younger players. Breitag played primarily at No. 4 singles last season and was 18-17 overall. She and Gorde teamed at No. 1 doubles and the duo was 3-0 at the Big Ten Championship tourney and also played in the Rolex tournament.

Sophomore **Libby Nelson** was the only rookie on last year's team and was a consistent player for the Gophers down the stretch when she won six of her last seven regular season matches. Playing primarily at No. 5, Nelson was 6-6 in Big Ten matches and 14-18 overall. Senior co-captain **Lisa Dick** was plagued by injuries last season and saw limited singles and doubles action. Dick is a solid doubles player and the Gophers hope she can perform as she did in 1986-87, when she was 14-5 in doubles and had a singles record of 8-2. Dick, a two-time Big Ten All-Academic selection, will be looked to for leadership on and off the court.

The newcomers' credentials are impressive. Freshman **Mindy Leach** of Laguna Beach, Calif. was ranked No. 20 in the 18 & under division of the Southern California Tennis Association and has held national junior rankings throughout her junior career. Freshman **Jenny Moe** was ranked No. 1 in the Northwestern Tennis Association and was the Minnesota State Class AA singles champion in 1988. Freshman **Sophie Olsson** of Asmundtorp, Sweden was a 1987 semi-finalist in the Swedish National Junior Singles Championships and won her third place playoff.

**THE SEASON** -- The Gophers will participate in three fall tournaments beginning with the Nebraska Flight Tournament on Oct. 7-8. After hosting the Minnesota Invitational from Oct. 28-30, the Gophers will conclude fall action at the ITCA Regional Tournament from Nov. 17-20.

In the winter, the Gophers will play host to the Gopher Doubles Invitational and for the second straight year Minnesota has been selected to host the prestigious Rolex National Indoor Collegiate Tennis Championships in February. Among other winter matches are quadrangular tournaments at Brigham Young and Clemson. Minnesota opens its Big Ten season on March 11 with the Big Ten Championships slated from April 28-30.

**DAVID CREIGHTON**  
Head Coach

David Creighton is beginning his second season as Gopher tennis coach and hasn't wasted any time in earning continued respect for a traditionally solid Minnesota tennis program. Creighton coached the Gophers to a 12-12 overall record (6-6 Big Ten) in 1987-88 and after a successful recruiting year, expects Minnesota to climb to greater heights in coming seasons.

Before coming to Minnesota, Creighton served as assistant coach for the nationally-ranked men's team at the University of Florida. In addition, he has been the head tennis professional at the Belle Haven Club of Greenwich, Conn., each summer since 1985. Creighton has also worked at numerous other Connecticut clubs as head and assistant tennis pro.

A graduate of Auburn University, Creighton played No. 1 singles and doubles for the Tigers and competed in the NCAA championships for two years. A former graduate assistant coach at Auburn, Creighton has also competed in several professional tournaments.

A native of South Africa, Creighton was among the top-ranked junior players in the country. He and current pro player Johan Kriek were the South African boys 18-and-under doubles champions in 1975. Creighton is now a naturalized American citizen.

His variety of experience as both a player and coach has taught Creighton the importance of getting exposure against nationally-ranked teams. Thus, he has scheduled several prominent non-conference opponents in 1987-88 to prepare the Gophers for the Big Ten season and get the team valuable experience playing against top level competition.
