### LAST WEEKEND

#### The Golden Gophers

split a two-game series at Colorado College, winning 2-1 on Saturday night after being blanked (3-0) on Friday evening. Senior captain **Nate Miller (Anoka, Minn.)** provided all of Minnesota's offense on the weekend with a pair of goals in Saturday's victory.

**The Badgers** swept a two-game series at Denver (3-2, 5-3) to seize early control of the WCHA race. Wisconsin leads the conference with 10 points entering this weekend's series in Madison, Wis.

**Series Notes:** Minnesota leads the all-time series 127-66-14 • the Golden Gophers have won or split the season series with the Badgers in each of the last 21 seasons - the last time Wisconsin won a season series from Minnesota was the 1977-78 campaign • Minnesota has won 18 of the last 25 meetings between the two teams • the Golden Gophers have been swept by the Badgers only one time (Feb. 23-24, 1996 in Madison) in the last 13 seasons • Wisconsin has scored on just two of its last 34 power play attempts against Minnesota • the Golden Gophers own a 25-9-4 advantage in the '90s (more series notes on page two)

**Last Season:** Minnesota earned two wins in Madison last season, claiming a pair of 3-2 games at the Badgers' new Kohl Center • by winning a 6-4 game on March 5, Wisconsin won for the first time in Minneapolis since a 3-2 win on Nov. 14, 1992 • the Badgers scored first in three of four games • eight of the 10 goals scored in the two games in Madison last season were netted in the second period • Minnesota was 5-for-20 (.250) on the power play in the four games • Minnesota outshot Wisconsin in three of the four games

## News & Notes

**The Coaches:** Minnesota Head Coach **Don Lucia** is in his first season with the Golden Gophers. Lucia, who has compiled a record of 281-160-29 (.629) in 13 seasons overall as a head coach, led Colorado College to the NCAA Tournament in each of the last four seasons. Lucia was 166-68-18 (.694) in six seasons with the Tigers, and is 120-51-17 (.684) in WCHA games. Lucia is 13-16-0 in 29 games against Wisconsin, and is 1-1-0 in games at Kohl Center (5-4 L, 3-0 W last season). Wisconsin Head Coach **Jeff Sauer** is in his 18th season at the helm of the Badger program, with a record of 427-264-37 (.612) at UW and an overall mark of 593-490-48 (.546) in 28 seasons at Wisconsin and Colorado College. Lucia and Sauer share the Colorado College all-time coaching win record with 166.

**Coach Lucia On The Air:** Coach Lucia's regular weekly media appearances are as follows: KSTP-AM (1500) - Thursday mornings (7:45) with Barbara Carlson, Saturday mornings (11:50) with Joe Soucheray, and the pre-game and post-game shows before and following games; WCCO-AM (830) - Friday mornings with Dave Lee, and Friday evenings (6:40) with Mike Max; MSC - The Don Lucia Show which generally airs one hour before each MSC telecast

**Miscellaneous Series Notes vs. Wisconsin:** Minnesota owns an edge in the all-time series at Madison (52-41-9) and in Minneapolis (72-19-5) • in postseason play, each team claims 12 wins (12-12-0) • there have been 31 shutouts in the series, with Minnesota owning 26

**Close Shaves:** Minnesota's first eight games this season have been decided by a total of 12 goals, with two of the tallies being empty-net goals (Oct. 16 at Maine, Oct. 30 vs. Boston College). Also, Minnesota has been in the lead of tied for 69 percent of game time this season (336:30 of a total 488:13 of game time)

**Tall Order:** Minnesota's first 10 games this season are against teams currently ranked in the top 10 in the nation - their first four opponents (Maine, North Dakota, Boston College, Colorado College) were all participants in the NCAA final eight a year ago and had a combined record of 111-35-11 (.742)

**Turning The Second Period Fortunes:** Heading into Saturday night's game at Colorado College, the Golden Gophers had been outscored 15-6 in the second period of the first seven games this season. In Minnesota's five losses, the team had been damaged by opponents outscoring them 10-4 in the middle frame - and opponents had scored two or more goals in the second period in six of the first seven games. Minnesota was able to reverse that trend, however, and notch a win on Saturday with a goal of its own and by holding the Tigers scoreless in the second period.

**Quick Starts:** Minnesota has scored first in five of eight games this season, owning a 7-2 edge in first-period scoring. The Golden Gophers have yet to allow a goal this season before the 12:53 mark of the opening frame.

**Counting On The Captain:** Senior captain **Nate Miller (Anoka, Minn.)** has been the provider of some big goals recently. Miller, who has scored three of the team's last four goals, scored both Golden Gopher markers in their 2-1 win at Colorado College Saturday night, and fired home the game-winning goal in the team's 6-5 overtime win against top-ranked Boston College on Oct. 29

**On The Defensive:** Through the season's first four WCHA games, Minnesota has allowed only nine goals - the team has surrendered just 28 total in eight overall games.

**Penalty Kill Progress:** Last weekend at Colorado College, the Golden Gopher penalty-unit was successful on nine of 10 Tiger power-play opportunities. Friday night's loss also marked the first game this season that Minnesota was able to not allow an opponent power-play goal.

**Did You Know:** Minnesota is 5-4-0 on Nov. 12 (0-2-0 vs. UW) and 2-4-3 on Nov. 13 2-4-3 (1-0-1 vs. UW) in school history • the Golden Gophers' leading scorer this season, Erik Westrum, has just 0-2-2 in the team's last 12 goals after 4-1-5 in the team's first eight goals of the season • Westrum (9) and defenseman Matt DeMarchi (10) have combined for 19 of the Golden Gophers' 65 penalties this season - no other player has been whistled for more than four infractions • Minnesota has collected four bench minors this season, one in each of the last four games - all for too many men on the ice • Minnesota has not won in its last 34 games they have trailed after two periods (0-29-5) • the only WCHA team that Wisconsin head coach Jeff Sauer has a losing record against is Minnesota (26-55-5 at UW, 43-83-8 overall) • a total of 12 players have scored Minnesota's 20 goals, with 15 players notching assists • statistics for all conference teams can be found by logging on to the league's new stat program site, [www.collegehockeystats.com](http://www.collegehockeystats.com)
