With a 9-1-2 record, Minnesota is off to its best start since 1984-85, when the Golden Gophers began the year 10-1-1. That team finished the year 31-13-3 and advanced to the NCAA Playoffs. Last season, Minnesota did not get its ninth win until Jan. 14 against Denver.

News & Notes

Minnesota Moves Into Sole Possession of First Place: Minnesota moved into sole possession of first place in the WCHA with a sweep of St. Cloud State. On Friday in St. Cloud, Adam Hauser stopped all 25 shots he faced as the Golden Gophers shutout the Huskies 2-0. In the rematch on Saturday at Mariucci Arena, senior Erik Westrum led the Golden Gophers to a 4-3 victory with a goal and two assists.

Minnesota Climbs in National Poll: With a sweep of St. Cloud State this past weekend, Minnesota climbed from No. 3 to No. 2 in this week's USCHO.com poll. The Golden Gophers narrowly missed out on the top ranking as Michigan State garnered 20 first-place votes, as opposed to, Minnesota's 18 votes. In the *USA Today*/American Hockey Magazine rankings, Minnesota climbed from No. 6 to No. 1. The Spartans claim the No. 2 spot.

Head Coach Don Lucia: Golden Gopher Head Coach Don Lucia has a career coaching record of 308-175-32 (.629) in 13-plus seasons behind the bench. At Minnesota, he owns a 29-20-4 mark (.585). His teams have won 20 or more games in all but three of the past 13 seasons, including a streak of eight straight years with 20-plus wins. Lucia is just 1-4-0 (.200) against Michigan State and 2-2-0 (.500) against Michigan in his career.

Hauser Nets Sixth Career Shutout: Junior Adam Hauser recorded his sixth career shutout on Friday night. He needs just one more to tie the school's career record of seven held by Steve Debus (1995-98), Jim Mattson (1951-54) and John Blue (1984-87). Hauser held the Huskies scoreless for the first 109:39 of the two-game series. For his efforts this past weekend, he was honored as this week's WCHA Defensive Player of the Week, the second time in the past three weeks.

More on the Netminder: Hauser stopped all 25 shots he faced in shutting out St. Cloud State on Friday. In his six career shutouts, the most saves he has made in a game is 31 in a 4-0 victory against Minnesota-Duluth on Nov. 20, 1999.

Hauser and the Friendly Confines: Hauser has taken advantage of a schedule that has featured seven home games. He is 6-0-1 in those contests with a 1.69 goals-against-average and a .936 save percentage. In four away games, he is 2-1-1 with a 3.67 gaa and .868 save percentage.

Turning the Tables: Last year, Minnesota went a combined 1-11-2 against Wisconsin, North Dakota and St. Cloud State. This season after facing each opponent in a series, the Golden Gophers are 4-1-1.

Pohl Steps Up: After being shutout in the season opener, John Pohl has tallied a point in 11 consecutive games. Pohl scored a goal in each of the victories against St. Cloud State and is 7-7--14 in his last 11 games. He has been stellar on Minnesota's league-leading power-play with five of his goals coming with a man advantage.

Get Shorty: Senior captain Erik Westrum tallied his eighth career short-handed goal last Saturday against St. Cloud State. He needs just two more to tie the school's all-time record of 10, held by Paul Broten (1984-88). Teammate Aaron Miskovich also has eight short-handed goals in his career. In seven home games this season, the Golden Gophers have allowed three power-play goals in 38 opportunities (.921), while scoring three short-handed goals (Westrum 2, Riddle 1).

College Hockey Showcase: The College Hockey Showcase began in 1993 and features Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan and Michigan State. The first four years of the Showcase, the games were held at one arena, alternating from a WCHA site to a CCHA site. In 1997, the format was changed and the games are held in home arenas. This year, Minnesota and Wisconsin are hosting.

Minnesota is 8-6-0 in the College Hockey Showcase after defeating Michigan 6-1 last year and losing at Michigan State 6-2. Against the Wolverines, the Golden Gophers are 3-4 and against the Spartans, are 5-2. Minnesota has swept the pair on two occasions, in 1994 and in 1995.

Hauser vs. the Spartans: For his career, junior goaltender Adam Hauser has a 1-1-0 record against Michigan State. In his first meeting with the Spartans, he stopped 27-of-28 shots in a 2-1 victory.
