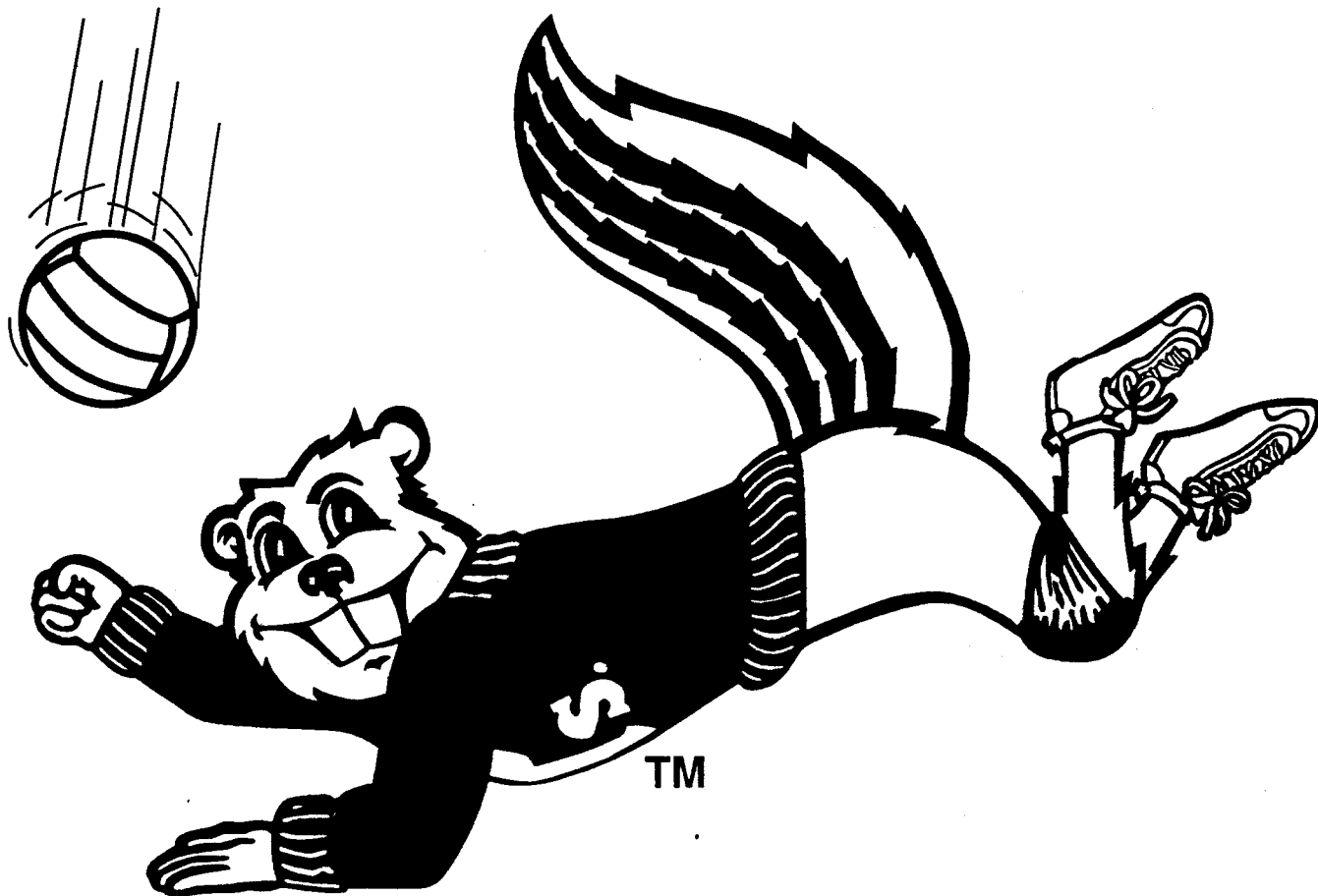

1992 VOLLEYBALL OUTLOOK

By reaching into a bag of old tricks with some future stars, the 1992 Gophers volleyball team hopes to make "Steph's world" a place other teams dread and one where fans can celebrate Minnesota's continuing climb to the top of the Big Ten standings.

Last year's team finished 11-8 and in fifth place in the 11-team conference, winning nine more conference matches than it had the previous year. It was the Big Ten's biggest turnaround.

Keying the resurgence was an offense that improved its hitting by more than 30 percentage points. This season, with four of its top five hitters returning, Minnesota will be looking to build on last year's achievement.

"We have a lot more potential for scoring this year," said head coach Stephanie Schleuder. "We have some new young talent that should help us immediately and we're going to get contributions from more people this year. I think we should realistically be able to take a step or two up in the Big Ten standings."

Mixed in to Schleuder's recipe for success is a change of venue. The Gophers will play at Bierman Gym for at least the first seven matches of the season while Williams Arena is under renovation. Bierman Gym, the site of Minnesota's home matches until Schleuder arrived in 1982, still serves as the team's practice facility.

Schleuder figures that the team's return to its old home court will prove to be beneficial for the Gophers.

"It should be a rowdy atmosphere and should give us a more intimate environment," Schleuder said. "I'm looking forward to seeing how other teams react to it."

The temporary arrangement at Bierman will provide bleacher seating for approximately 2,200 fans. And although the Gophers will close the home schedule back at Williams Arena, the team's matches at Bierman will prepare it for the following season, when Minnesota returns to Bierman during another stage of the Williams Arena renovation.

The Players

Schleuder said she plans to open up the Gophers' offensive attack by shifting back to the swing offense that Minnesota ran with great success in the late 1980s, when all-American hitter Andrea Gonzalez and Chris Schaefer started on the Gophers' left side.

Running the 1992 version of that offense will be junior setter **Sue Jackson**, an honorable mention all-conference selection whose 11.72 assist average was fourth in the Big Ten last season. Jackson's sets to the left side will be targeted primarily for senior **Krista Nevelle** and sophomore **Jean Schintz**, both of whom were moved to that position during spring practice. Last season Nevelle totaled 286 kills from the right side, second-best on the team. Schintz, expected to be the next in a line of outstanding Gophers jump servers, finished third in the Big Ten in aces last year (0.45/game) while playing primarily in the back row.

On the right side, senior **Emily Ahlquist** will receive her share of back sets while serving as a primary passer. The Gophers will begin fall practice with fifth-year senior **Heather Benning Sauer** at one middle blocker spot and sophomore **Gretchen Dahl** at the other. Sauer is coming off a season that saw her hit .315 in Big Ten matches (fourth-best in the league) and .294 overall. Dahl averaged 1.87 kills and 2.06 digs as a redshirt freshman while playing primarily on the left side.

Senior outside hitter **Angie Hanna** and juniors **Barb Walfoort** and **Megan Huston** are expected to lend experience in both the front and back rows, as is the sophomore trio of **Jenny Boll**, **Vicki Joyce** and **Kari Skundberg**.

Freshman hitter **Heidi Olhausen**, an Apple Valley, Minn. resident and Lakeville High School graduate, will be pressing for immediate playing time, along with freshman setter **Kate Callahan**, also a graduate of Lakeville High School, and freshman middle blocker **Heidi Foesch** (Buffalo Lake, Minn.).

The Schedule

The Gophers will open the season Sept. 4 against Alabama-Birmingham in Tuscaloosa, Ala., followed by matches against Memphis State, Central Florida and Alabama in the Crimson Tide Classic (Sept. 4-5). The road trip will continue with a match at South Florida on Sept. 9 and conclude with three contests in a tournament at Florida State on Sept. 11-12.

The home season opens on Sept. 14 against Kentucky and continues on Sept. 18-19 with the Minnesota Classic, which will feature SW Missouri State, Houston and North Carolina as opponents in the round-robin tournament. The Gophers will play host to Iowa on Sept. 23 in the Big Ten opener.
