MINNESOTA RACES TO 24TH NATIONALLY -- The Minnesota women's cross country team has used two fourth-place finishes at major meets to earn a national ranking for the first time since the end of the 1989 season. The Gophers were unranked in the first poll of the season, but were installed as the 24th-ranked team in the second NCAA coaches' poll, released Oct. 7. Minnesota maintained that ranking with its fourth-place finish at last weekend's Indiana Invitational.

INDIANA INVITATIONAL RECAP -- The Gophers took fourth place on the course that will decide the Region IV championship next month and the qualifiers for the NCAA meet. Georgetown, ranked sixth in the NCAA survey, took top honors with 49 points, followed by No. 10 Iowa (84), No. 17 Wisconsin (108) and No. 24 Minnesota (117). Minnesota coach **Gary Wilson** was pleased with his team's performance, but admits that there is room for improvement. "I'm happy that we are running as a team," said Wilson. "We are not far from the conference leaders, but we still have some ground to make up."

MINNESOTA HOSTS GBS/NIKE INVITATIONAL, FINISHES FOURTH -- The Gophers hosted the GBS/Nike Invitational, one of the largest and strongest races in the cross country regular season. Minnesota finished fourth at the Les Bolstad University of Minnesota Golf Course. The three teams that finished ahead of Minnesota (Virginia, Kansas and Nebraska) are all ahead of the Gophers in the NCAA poll.

ROWE REPEATS AS TOP RUNNER -- Senior **CHRIS ROWE** (SIOUX FALLS, SD/O'GORMAN) continues to run at the front of Minnesota's "pack attack". **Rowe** was Minnesota's top runner in six of her seven races last season and has been the top Gopher in her four races this season. In her best race of 1990, **Rowe** finished 10th at the Big Ten meet in a time of 17:51.0. This season, **Rowe** has bettered that time in all three of her 5,000-meter efforts. **Rowe's** time sheet for the 1991 season:

LANGFORD STARTS MINNESOTA CAREER STRONG -- Junior **JESSICA LANGFORD** (WINNEBAGO, IL/WINNEBAGO) transferred from Carthage College in Kenosha, Wisc. to make quite an impact on the Minnesota team. In Minnesota's three races at 5,000 meters, **Langford** had finished as the second Gopher in all three races. Her top time was at the GBS/Nike Invitational, finishing 12th in 18:08.

LOOKING AHEAD -- Minnesota will rest some of its top runners this week and take a squad of nine runners to the Jim Drews Invitational in LaCrosse, Wisc. The full squad will race for the final time Oct. 26 at the Minnesota Open, before coach **Gary Wilson** chooses his top seven for the Big Ten meet Nov. 2 at Purdue.

GOPHERS TRAVEL TO REGION IV MEET — The Minnesota women's cross country team will travel to the Region IV Cross Country Championship Saturday at 10:45 EST at the Indiana Cross Country Course in Bloomington, Ind. The top two teams will qualify for the NCAA Cross Country Championship Nov. 25 in Tucson, Ariz., with the other teams having a chance to qualify through an at-large bid. Minnesota will have to beat some of the Big Ten teams that beat them at the Big Ten meet to qualify for the NCAA meet.

MINNESOTA OPEN REVIEW — Minnesota took the top 13 places in the Minnesota Open last Saturday at the Les Bolstad University of Minnesota Golf Course. Senior **CHRIS ROWE** (SIOUX FALLS, SD/O'GORMAN) won her second consecutive Minnesota Open, running the 4,000-meter course in 14:30.

GOPHERS FINISH FIFTH AT BIG TEN — The Minnesota women's cross country team finished fifth at the 1991 Big Ten cross country meet Saturday at West Lafayette, Ind. Tenth-ranked Wisconsin won the meet with 49 points, with Badgers coach Peter Tegen earning Big Ten coach of the year honors. Michigan State sophomore Misty Allison won the race in a time of 17:58.7. The top Gopher finisher was junior Jessica Langford, finishing 14th in 18:38.4.

MINNESOTA FINISHES 17TH AT NCAA MEET — The Minnesota women's cross country team finished 17th last Monday at the 1991 NCAA Women's Cross Country Championship in Tucson, Ariz. This marked the first top 20 finish and the highest national finish for a Gopher team since their 10th-place finish at the 1983 meet.

ROWE LEAD "PACK ATTACK" — Senior **CHRIS ROWE** (SIOUX FALLS, SD) was the first Gopher across the line in Tucson, finishing 59th in 17:49.4. Only **Jody Eder** (1983-85) and **Sue Alm** (1983) have run faster times at the national championship meet. Sophomore **JESSICA LANGFORD** (WINNEBAGO, IL), Minnesota's No. 2 runner for most of the 1991 season, did not finish the race due to problems with her achilles. The rest of the Gophers picked up the slack with seniors **JENNY ALBY** (APPLETON, WI/EAST), **CHRISTINE ABBOTT** (WINONA, MN), **KARA PARKER** (OLIVIA, MN) and freshman **WENDI ZAK** (BAILEY'S HARBOR, WI/GIBRALTAR) finishing within 22 seconds of each other to secure the team's 17th-place finish.

WILSON PLEASED WITH EFFORT — "I couldn't be more proud of my team. We left everything we had on the course. Our goal was to finish 18th or 19th, so the 17th-place finish was beyond our wildest dreams. This team has fought through a lot of adversity just to get to the meet, and to perform like we did was just great."
