Golf Hometown Review #1

GOLFERS HAVE BEST FALL SEASON SINCE 1991-92

The University of Minnesota women's golf team had its best fall season since the 1991-92 school year and it was the third best fall season since 1982-83. This year, the Gophers had a 53-14-1 (win/loss/tie) fall season as compared with their record of 59-11, set in 1991-92. The No. 2 win/loss mark in the past 12 years of 55-9 was set in the fall of 1982.

Minnesota finished among the top five teams in four of its five tournaments, including one victory. In their first outing of the year, the Gophers tied for second with Penn State at the Minnesota Golf Invitational (Sept. 3-4) with rounds of 325, 325 and 313 for 963 strokes. Iowa State won the 12-team tournament with 950 strokes.

At the Iowa Invitational (Iowa City, Iowa - Sept. 17-18), Minnesota placed sixth in the field of 10 teams with 938 strokes after scores of 314, 308 and 316. Indiana was first at the Iowa Invitational with 896 strokes, and was followed by Southern California (910), Iowa State (926), Washington (930) and Iowa (934).

After finishing behind Iowa State in its first two tournaments, Minnesota traveled to Iowa State for its next challenge, the Cyclone Classic (Ames, Iowa - Sept. 24-25). The Gophers won the 12-team tournament with 631 strokes after rounds of 319 and 312, finishing four strokes ahead of second place Iowa State (635).

The University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Mich., hosted this year's Lady Northern Intercollegiate tournament (Sept. 30 - Oct. 2), which is held in the fall on the same golf course that will host the Big Ten women's golf championship in the spring. Minnesota was fifth of 19 teams in the field, shooting rounds of 319, 326 and 324 for 969 strokes. Indiana was first with 930 strokes, and was followed by Ohio State (954), Iowa State (959) and Illinois (961). In the final match of the fall season, Minnesota finished the Lady Kat Invitational (University of Kentucky, Lexington - Oct. 7-9) in fifth place with its low team score of the autumn with 932 strokes after rounds of 315, 308 and 309. Wake Forest won the tournament with 900 strokes, and was followed by North Carolina (915), Kentucky (922) and Oklahoma State (928).

SCHMIESING WINS AT HOME – Senior AMY SCHMIESING (SPICER, MN/NEW LONDON-SPICER) had a successful fall season, winning one tournament, shooting one round under par, making par on two others and finishing in the top 10 three times. She ended the fall with a 77.57 stroke average.

Schmiesing won the Minnesota Golf Invitational this fall for her second collegiate career victory. She shot rounds of 81, 78 and 73 for 232 strokes, with her third round being one-under par and her career low 18-hole score. At the Iowa Invitational, Schmiesing tied for fourth with her collegiate career low 54-hole mark of 224 strokes after rounds of 77, a par 73 and 74.

Schmiesing had rounds of 83 and 79 for 162 strokes at the Iowa State Cyclone Classic, where she tied for 14th-place. At the Lady Northern Intercollegiate, she tied for seventh with 236 strokes after rounds of 78 and a pair of 79's. At the Lady Kat Invitational, Schmiesing tied for 11th, shooting par in the second round with a 74 after opening with a 77 and closing with an 81 for 232 strokes.

REGAN NUMBER TWO – Sophomore MAUREEN REGAN (OMAHA, NE/MARIAN) finished the fall as the number two golfer on the team with a 79.21 fall stroke average. Regan had two top 10 finishes and made par once during the fall. Her best finish of the fall was at the Minnesota Golf Invitational, where she placed third with 236 strokes after rounds of 82, 80 and a par 74. Regan tied for 23rd at the Iowa Invitational with scores of 77, 80 and 81 for 238 strokes and tied for fifth at the Iowa State Cyclone Classic with 159 strokes after rounds of 81 and 78. In the last two tournaments of the fall, Regan has a pair of top 20 finishes. She tied for 18th at the Lady Northern Intercollegiate with marks of 81, 83 and 79 for 243 strokes and tied for 16th with 233 strokes at the Lady Kat Invitational with 233 strokes.

Regan had four collegiate career highlights this fall. At the Minnesota tournament, she recorded her low 18-hole score of 74 and her best-ever finish with third place. At the Lady Kat Invitational, she had her low 54-hole match score of 233 and at the Iowa State meet, her low 36-hole score with 159.

DAHLE PLAYS IN FOUR TOURNEYS – Frosh AMY DAHLE (RED LAKE FALLS, MN/LAFAYETTE) played in four of the team's five tournaments this fall, finishing with the team's third best fall average of 80.55 strokes per round. She had one top 10 and three top 20 finishes during the fall.

Dahle tied for 29th at the Minnesota Invitational with 240 strokes after rounds of 79, 84 and 87. At the Iowa State Cyclone Classic, she tied for third place with rounds of 78 and 80 for 158 strokes. Tying for 20th-place in her last two meets of the year, Dahle had 244 strokes at the Lady Northern Intercollegiate with rounds of 80, 81 and 83, and 234 strokes at the Lady Kat Invitational after shooting 78, 79 and 77.

AUSE WINS AT IOWA STATE – Senior ANGIE AUSE (RED WING, MN/CENTRAL) won her first ever collegiate tournament this fall, winning the Iowa State Cyclone Classic with 155 strokes after rounds of 80 and 75. Ause's 155 score is her collegiate low 36-hole total. She carries an 80.71 fall stroke average after competing in all five of the teams' tournaments.

At the Minnesota Invitational, Ause tied for eighth place with 240 strokes after rounds of 80, 77 and 83. She tied for 34th at the Iowa Invitational with three matching rounds of 81 strokes each for 243 strokes. Ause had marks of 80, 85 and 88 for 253 strokes and tied for 50th-place at the Lady Northern Intercollegiate. She shot her low 54-hole total of the fall at the Lady Kat Invitational, where she tied for 33rd with rounds of 85, 78 and 76 for 239 strokes.

KAISER PLAYS IN FOUR TOURNEYS – Senior JENNY KAISER (RICHFIELD, MN/RICHFIELD) competed in four of the team's five tournaments this fall, having one top 10 finish. She tied for eighth at the Iowa State Cyclone Classic with a pair of 80's for 160 strokes. At the Minnesota Invitational, Kaiser tied for 12th with 242 strokes after rounds of 85, 78 and 79. She tied for 57th at the Lady Northern Intercollegiate with rounds of 83, 83 and 89 for 255 strokes.

KLECKER IN ALL BUT ONE – Junior CAROLYN KLECKER (RIVER FALLS, WI/RIVER FALLS) competed in all but one of Minnesota's five fall tournaments. At the Minnesota Invitational, Klecker tied for 26th with rounds of 80, 88 and 81 for 249 strokes. She had 249 strokes at the Iowa Invitational, tying for 39th place after rounds of 83, 78 and 83. At the Lady Northern Intercollegiate, Klecker had marks of 86, 90 and 83 for 259 strokes and a tie for 72nd. In the final tournament of the year, the Lady Kat Invitational, Klecker tied for 48th-place with 242 strokes after rounds of 83, 82 and 77. Her final round 77 and three-round total of 242 are her collegiate career low scores.

ELLEFSON SETS CAREER MARKS – Junior JENNY ELLEFSON (MINNESOTA CITY, MN/WINONA) set two personal collegiate low scores this fall in the 18- and 54-hole categories at the Minnesota Invitational. She shot a 78 in the final round for her low 18-hole score and had low 54-hole total of 243. Her first and second round scores at the Minnesota Invitational were 79 and 86. In Ellefson's only other outing of the fall season, she had rounds of 85 and 88 for 179 strokes for a 29th-place tie at the Iowa State Cyclone Classic.

LINDBLAD IN TWO TOURNEYS – Junior CATHY LINDBLAD (WILLMAR, MN/WILLMAR) competed in two tournaments this fall for the Gophers. She tied for 29th at the Minnesota Invitational with scores of 84, 87 and 79 for 250 strokes. She improved four strokes on her 54-hole total at the Iowa Invitational, where she tied for 42nd-place with 246 strokes after rounds of 79, 87 and 80.

SAVAGE IN FIRST TOURNAMENT – Sophomore MARCY SAVAGE (HIBBING, MN/HIBBING), who redshirted her frosh year, competed in her first collegiate tournament this fall. She tied for 36th-place after rounds of 84, 89 and 79 for 252 strokes.

SAWVELL IN MINNESOTA INVITE – Frosh KERI SAWVELL (PRAIRIE DU CHIEN, WI/PRAIRIE) joined the women's golf team this fall and played in one tournament. She had rounds of 88, 84 and 86 for 258 strokes at the Minnesota Invitational, tying for 49th.

SCHWEGMAN TIES FOR 26TH – Frosh KATIE SCHWEGMAN (ST. PETER, MN/ST. PETER) tied for 26th place in her only competition of the year, the Minnesota Invitational. She had a 54-hole total of 249 strokes after scores of 84, 83 and 82.

TRENDA PLAYS IN HOME TOURNEY – Sophomore JENNY TREND (OWATONNA, MN/OWATONNA) played in only the Minnesota Invitational this fall. She tied for 46th with rounds of 88, 86 and 81 for 255 strokes.
