GOPHERS HOST MINNESOTA INVITATIONAL THIS WEEKEND -- The women's tennis team will host its only home tournament of the fall season--the Minnesota Invitational--Friday through Sunday at the 98th Street Racquet Club. Play begins at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, 4:30 p.m. on Saturday and 9:30 a.m. on Sunday.

ERSKINE FINISHES THIRD AT TCU INVITE -- Sophomore **AMY ERSKINE** (EDINA, MN/EDINA) placed third in the "C" singles flight of the TCU Invitational this past weekend in Fort Worth, Texas. **Erskine's** third-place finish was the team's best during the tournament. **Erskine** opened play by defeating Oklahoma's Tiffany George 6-7, 6-3, 6-3 on Friday to advance to the semifinals of her bracket, where she lost 1-6, 2-6 on Saturday to SMU's Carolyn Knobelspies. On Sunday, she won her third-place match 6-1, 6-2 over SMU's Margaret Sale.

Sophomore **SUSAN CULIK** (CHAPIN, SC/CHAPIN) finished fourth in the "A" singles flight, defeating Southern Methodist's Ann Brown 6-2, 6-4 in her opening match before falling to Oklahoma's Nicole Kenneally 2-6, 2-6 and TCU's Teri Ann Martin 3-6, 4-6. **Erskine** and freshman **KARIN ERLANDSSON** (MOLNDAL, SWEDEN/SIGRID RUDEBECKS) were 2-1 in doubles in the tournament.

Overall, the Gophers were 5-13 in singles and 4-5 in doubles.

MARQUES WINS TWO MATCHES IN LSU INVITE -- Junior **JENNY MARQUES** (LAGUNA HILLS, CA/LAGUNA HILLS) won her first two singles matches in the Gophers' season-opening tournament at the LSU Invitational. She defeated Mississippi's Rebecca Case 6-1, 6-0 and LSU's Carolyn Maurin 6-0, 6-3 before losing to Mississippi's Lizzie Barnes 6-4, 7-5 in the semifinals.

The Gophers won four singles matches and lost 12 in the tournament. In doubles, Minnesota won three matches and lost five. There was no team competition in the tournament.

NOTES -- Sophomore **SHANNA JOHNSON** (BLOOMINGTON, MN/JEFFERSON) did not play in the TCU tournament because of a stress fracture in her left foot. She was expected to be out of action for three weeks. Freshman **KATHY WAYNE** (TEMPE, AZ/CORONA DEL SOL) is rehabilitating a knee from a prior injury and will not play during the fall season.

GOPHERS FALL IN ROLEX REGIONALS -- The Gophers' fall tennis season came to a close on Thursday with losses in the first rounds of both the singles and doubles brackets of the Rolex Midwest regional championships this weekend in East Lansing, Mich.

Sophomore **SUSAN CULIK** (CHAPIN, SC/CHAPIN) lost 3-6, 3-6 to Indiana's Deb Edelman, who was the No. 3 seed, while freshman **KARIN ERLANDSSON** (MOLNDAL, SWEDEN/SIGRID RUDEBECK'S) and junior **JENNY MARQUES** (LAGUNA HILLS, CA/LAGUNA HILLS) lost 6-4, 0-6, 2-6 to Notre Dame's Eniko Bende and Sherri Vitale. Edelman went on to win the tournament.

The Gophers begin the winter competitive season with the Federated Insurance Court Classic from Jan. 29-31. Teams participating are Georgia, Notre Dame and UCLA.

CULIK BEATS ERLANDSSON IN MINNESOTA INVITATIONAL FINAL --

There was no way the Gophers could lose in the Minnesota Invitational (Oct. 23-25). When the first two rounds of play in the 16-singles draw tournament were complete, it was Minnesota vs. Minnesota in both semifinal matches.

One semifinal match pitted **Culik** and **AMY ERSKINE** (EDINA, MN/EDINA) against each other, while the other featured **Marques** against **Erlandsson**. In the upper half of the bracket, **Culik** downed **Erskine** 6-0, 6-1, while **Erlandsson** beat **Marques** 6-1, 6-4 in the lower half. **Culik** then bested **Erlandsson** 7-5, 1-0 default (illness) in the championship match.

All six Gophers entered in the tournament won their opening-round matches. **Culik** beat St. Olaf's Lynne Craven 6-0, 6-3; freshman **DANA PETERSON** (APPLE VALLEY, MN/APPLE VALLEY) defeated Carleton College's Alison Valenta 6-4, 6-3; **Erskine** downed Southwest State's Sheri Mathieu 6-1, 6-1; senior **VICKY KOLARIC** (WILLOUGHBY HILLS, OH/NOTRE DAME ACADEMY) topped Carleton's Chris Wesley 6-2, 6-0; **Erlandsson** beat St. Olaf's Krista Miller 6-1, 6-0; and **Marques** shut out Gustavus Adolphus's Annie Robertson 6-0, 6-0.

In the quarterfinals, **Culik** beat Gustavus Adolphus's Tracy Erickson 6-3, 6-0; **Erskine** defeated **Peterson** 6-2, 6-1; **Erlandsson** beat **Kolaric** 6-1, 6-2 and **Marques** downed Carleton's Amanda Holly 6-0, 6-1.

TEAM ROAD SCHEDULE BEGINS THIS WEEKEND -- The Minnesota women's tennis team (1-4, 1-1) will play the first of six consecutive non-conference matches this weekend when it takes on Drake at 1 p.m. Saturday in Des Moines, Iowa. The Gophers have the distinction of being Drake's first women's tennis opponent in the brand new \$3.5 million Drake Tennis Center, which opened last fall.

Minnesota will then travel to Ames, Iowa, where the Gophers will face Iowa State at 10:30 a.m. on Sunday. The matches are Minnesota's first road duals of the season.

GOPHERS OPEN BIG TEN SEASON WITH WIN OVER OHIO STATE --

Minnesota won four of six singles matches and swept all three doubles matches in a 7-2 win over Ohio State on Friday at the Burnsville Racquet Club in the Big Ten season opener for both teams. Gophers freshmen **KARIN ERLANDSSON** (MOLNDAL, SWEDEN) and **DANA PETERSON** (APPLE VALLEY, MN) won at No. 3 doubles to clinch the victory for Minnesota. **Erlandsson** and **Peterson** defeated Ohio State's Allison Kinsey and Louise Johnson 6-0, 6-3.

On Sunday at the 98th Street Racquet Club, the Gophers lost 7-2 to 10th-ranked Indiana. It was Minnesota's fourth loss of the season, all of which have come against ranked opponents. The Gophers' wins came at Nos. 2 and 3 doubles.

CULIK BEATS ANOTHER RANKED OPPONENT -- Gopher sophomore **SUSAN CULIK** (CHAPIN, SC) lost two of three singles matches at the Rolex national indoor championships (Feb. 4-7), but her win came against the 18th-ranked player in the nation, Katrin Guenther of William & Mary.

After losing to 15th-ranked Antonia Homolya of Campbell College (2-6, 3-6) in her opening-round singles match, **Culik** downed Guenther 6-4, 6-2 in the opening round of consolation play. **Culik** then lost to 43rd-ranked Jody Yin (1-6, 6-7) of Indiana in the consolation quarterfinals.

The win over Guenther, though, was **Culik's** second over a ranked opponent in less than a week. She beat ninth-ranked Cammie Foley of UCLA in a team dual on Jan. 30. The next rankings will be released March 9.

In doubles competition at the Rolex, **Culik** and sophomore **SHANNA JOHNSON** (BLOOMINGTON, MN/JEFFERSON) lost both their matches. In the first round, they were defeated 6-3, 6-2 by Laura Richards and Julie McKeon of San Diego (ranked fourth in the nation), and in the second round, **Culik** and **Johnson** lost to Auburn's Anna Funderburk and Nadia Smirnova (7-5, 5-7, 3-6). Funderburk and Smirnova are ranked 10th in the nation.

CULIK, ERLANDSSON KNOCK OFF RANKED OPPONENTS -- Minnesota faced three nationally ranked opponents in the Federated Insurance Court Classic from Jan. 29-31 and lost to all three, but two Gophers came up with big individual wins.

Culik posted a 6-4, 7-5 upset win at No. 1 singles over UCLA senior Cammie Foley in a 7-2 Gophers loss to the fifth-ranked Bruins on Jan. 30. Foley is currently tied for ninth nationally in the ITA singles rankings. It was **Culik's** first collegiate win over a ranked player.

Erlandsson also knocked off a ranked opponent in the tournament. **Erlandsson** beat Notre Dame junior Lisa Tholen 6-2, 6-1 on Jan. 31 in a 7-2 Gophers loss to the 22nd-ranked Fighting Irish. On Jan. 29, fifth-ranked Georgia beat the Gophers 9-0. Georgia went 3-0 to win the tournament, UCLA was 2-1 and Notre Dame was 1-2.

GOPHERS TAKE TO ROAD WITH FOUR-MATCH WINNING STREAK -- The women's tennis team's four-match winning streak will be on the line when it heads west for outdoor matches at California-Irvine on Saturday and Cal State Fullerton on Sunday. The Gophers (5-4, 1-1) will play at noon on both Saturday and Sunday.

GOPHERS DOWN WESTERN MICHIGAN, NEBRASKA -- Prior to Friday's match with Western Michigan, head coach Martin Novak said he would not be surprised if that evening's contest was a close match. The players had other ideas, however, as they eliminated all suspense during singles play by winning five of six matches. The Gophers went on to win 8-1. On Saturday, Minnesota did even better, shutting out Nebraska 9-0.

The three Gopher freshmen sparked the wins, going 6-0 in singles and 3-0 in the doubles matches they were involved in. Freshman **KATHY WAYNE** (TEMPE, AZ/CORONA DEL SOL) has been on a roll since being inserted in both the singles and doubles lineups, winning all four of her singles matches and seven of nine doubles contests. **Wayne** defeated Western Michigan's Shannon Dean 6-4, 6-2 at No. 6 singles on Friday and then defeated Nebraska's Heidi Junius 6-1, 6-0 at No. 5 singles on Saturday.

In doubles, **Wayne** and junior **JENNY MARQUES** (LAGUNA HILLS, CA) extended their winning streak to six with wins at No. 2 doubles over Western Michigan's Audrey Smith and Bridget Loughrin (7-6, 6-4) on Friday and Nebraska's Ann Flannery and Tina Coutretsis (6-0, 6-2) on Saturday.

Freshman **DANA PETERSON** (APPLE VALLEY, MN) won all three of her matches, beating Loughrin 6-2, 6-2 and Coutretsis 6-3, 5-7, 7-5 at No. 4 singles and teaming with freshman **KARIN ERLANDSSON** (MOLNDAL, SWEDEN) for a 6-0, 6-2 doubles win over Western Michigan's Jen Fales and Laura Worzniak. **Erlandsson** also was 2-0 in singles, beating Western Michigan's Yacqui Peete 6-0, 6-4 and Nebraska's Ann Flannery 6-2, 7-5 at No. 2 singles.

GOPHERS WIN 17 OF 18 IN WINS OVER DRAKE, IOWA STATE -- The Feb. 20-21 weekend was a successful one for the netters, as they downed Drake 8-1 on Feb. 20 in Des Moines and Iowa State 9-0 on Feb. 21 in Ames, Iowa.

Wayne played her first two singles matches of the season and won both, beating Drake's Nicole Gianci 6-1, 6-2 on Feb. 20 and Iowa State's Kristin Dahlberg 7-5, 6-1 on Feb. 21.

GOPHERS FINISH SEVENTH AT BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS -- Minnesota split four matches at the Big Ten championships last weekend in Bloomington, Ind. and finished seventh in the conference for the second year in a row.

The Gophers (12-13, 5-9), seeded eighth going into the tournament, beat ninth-seeded Ohio State 5-2 in the first round and then lost to top-seeded Indiana 5-0 in the quarterfinals.

Minnesota then lost to fifth-seeded Michigan 5-2 in the semifinals of the back draw before beating seventh-seeded Michigan State 5-2 in the seventh-place match.

Indiana won the conference title, beating Wisconsin 5-0 in the championship match. Illinois defeated Northwestern 5-4 for third place; Iowa beat Michigan 5-4 for fifth place; and Penn State beat Ohio State 5-4 for ninth place. Purdue finished in 11th place.

JOHNSON PACES TEAM WITH 3-0 MARK AT BIG TENS -- Sophomore **SHANNA JOHNSON** (BLOOMINGTON, MN/JEFFERSON) had the team's best record at the championship tournament, as she went 3-0 at No. 3 singles and 1-0 at No. 3 doubles. Sophomore **SUSAN CULIK** (CHAPIN, SC) was 3-1 at No. 1 singles.

WAYNE POSTS GOPHERS' TOP WINNING PERCENTAGES --

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- University of Minnesota freshman tennis player **Kathy Wayne**, a 1992 graduate of Corona del sol High School and resident of Tempe, Ariz., led Minnesota in both singles and doubles winning percentage this past season.

Wayne had a .647 (11-6 record) singles winning percentage and a .765 (13-4 record) doubles winning percentage. She played at both Nos. 5 and 6 singles and at Nos. 2 and 3 doubles.

Slowed by a knee injury that kept her from playing in the Gophers' fall tournaments, Wayne started fast during the winter season, winning her first seven singles matches and nine of her first 10. In doubles, she won eight of her first 10 matches.

Wayne and teammate Shanna Johnson were paired in doubles late in the season and responded by winning three matches in a row to close the season, with the last of those victories coming in the opening round of the Big Ten championship tournament.

As a team, for the second year in a row Minnesota finished in seventh place at the Big Ten Conference tournament. The Gophers beat Michigan State 5-2 in the final match of the tournament after losing to Michigan (5-2) and Indiana (5-0) in earlier tournament matches. The Gophers opened the tournament by beating Ohio State 5-2.

Minnesota finished the season with a 12-13 overall record, with five of the losses coming to teams ranked among the nation's top 25. The Gophers were 5-9 in the Big Ten.

The season highlights included a six-match winning streak and serving as host for the Federated Insurance Court Classic Jan. 29-31 at the Hiway 100 Racquet, Swim and Health Club in the Twin Cities.

Fifth-ranked UCLA, seventh-ranked Georgia and 22nd-ranked Notre Dame joined the host Gophers as tournament participants. The Gophers lost 9-0 to Georgia and 7-2 to both UCLA and Notre Dame, but the tournament gave Minnesota valuable experience playing high-caliber competition.

Prior to coming to Minnesota, Wayne held sectional and national rankings for five consecutive years, although she did not play high school tennis. Her best year was 1990, when she finished No. 1 in singles and No. 2 in doubles in the Southwest Tennis Association and Phoenix District.

She was ranked 56th nationally in singles and fifth in doubles in 1990.

Wayne, a pre-business major in the University's College of Liberal Arts, is the daughter of Kurt and Joyce Wayne.

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- University of Minnesota sophomore **Shanna Johnson**, a 1991 graduate of Bloomington Jefferson High School, was 3-0 at No. 3 singles and 1-0 at No. 2 doubles at the Big Ten championship tournament April 30-May 2, capping off a torrid finish to her season.

Johnson won 16 of her final 19 singles matches and during the stretch had a 12-match singles winning streak enroute to a 16-9 overall singles record.
