ABOUT THE COACH: Gary Wilson came to Minnesota in 1986 after coaching the Wisconsin-LaCrosse women's track and field team to three NCAA Division III championships. He is a two-time NCAA Division III coach of the year and was named a Runners World all-star coach in 1984.

UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA 1987 INDOOR TRACK & FIELD OUTLOOK

Minnesota placed ninth in the Big Ten last year, scoring 12 points at the conference meet. One thing that hurt the Gophers was their lack of depth, and although second-year coach Gary Wilson has taken steps toward solving the depth problem, his efforts may not show up in the standings this year. "Our goal is to double the number of points we scored last year at Big Tens," Wilson said. The loss of All-American distance runner Jody Eder will be felt, but the Gophers have three athletes (Jo Arvesen, Lisa Johnson, and Beth Lindblad) returning who scored more points in all indoor meets than did Eder, and they return six of their top 11 point-scorers in all meets.

SPRINTS

The Gophers return three women who have accounted for top times in the Gopher record book -- senior Char Wetzel, who holds the second-best 100m time in Gopher history (12.42); junior Lisa Walton (4th at 100m); and sophomore Michelle Brown (6th at 100m). Newcomer Peg Warkel, a former state prep 200m runner-up, adds depth.

MIDDLE DISTANCES/DISTANCES

Traditionally a Minnesota strength, these events were made even stronger when Wilson, who is widely recognized as one of the top distance coaches in the nation, came to Minnesota. Junior Lisa Johnson is a top runner at 800m, posting a time of 2:10.76 at the 1985 Big Ten Outdoor Championships. Junior Patti Walsh and sophomore Eileen Donaghy are outstanding distance runners. Transfer Jackie Hubbard, sophomore Patty Burns and freshmen Cara Daniels, Marcy Denman, Cherste Johnson, Wendy Babcock and Tiffany Church provide plenty of depth.

HURDLES

Minnesota will be extremely young and inexperienced in the hurdles this indoor season. Top hurdlers, all freshmen with strong prep credentials, will be Krysta Thyreen, Kelly Sheats, and Lynn Frauendienst.

JUMPS

Senior Jo Arvesen is among the top jumpers in Minnesota history, and freshman Leslie Revier is rated third among prep triple jumpers by Track and Field News with a personal-best of 40-11. Robyn Hackbarth should be able to contribute immediately in the high jump.

THROWS

Sophomore Shirley Molitor placed fourth in the shot put in the Big Ten Outdoor Championships as a freshman, and could contend for the title this year if a nagging injury to her knee comes around. Joining Molitor in the shot is senior Leslie Smith, who has posted a personal-best of 45-8.

PENTATHLON

Senior Jo Arvesen will again anchor the squad in the pentathlon. Arvesen placed fourth in the Big Ten in the pentathlon last winter and fifth in the conference in the heptathlon last spring. She worked very hard during the off-season and she figures to have a very strong season. Junior Beth Lindblad also has performed well in this event.
