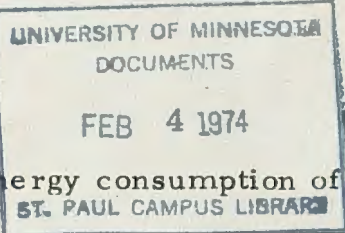

Choosing Fireplace Wood

University of Minnesota forester William Miles offers this advice to homeowners:

Choose the Minnesota woods for your fireplace that give off the most heat. Use a hardwood, particularly hickory, black locust, oak and sugar maple. Hickory is highly rated for heat, but it is not easily obtained.

Check the Yellow Pages of your phone book or classified advertisements in your local newspapers to find out where to buy fireplace wood.
