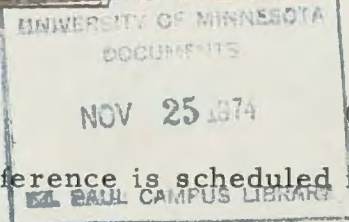

Winter Driving

Take time now to ready your car for winter driving. Check out the lights and make sure your tires have enough tread left to bite into snow. Have brakes adjusted and equalized for balanced braking on slippery roads.

Before you take a winter trip, listen for weather forecasts, road reports and storm warnings. Tell someone of your route and when to expect you. If stalled, tie a colored banner on your radio antenna.

A winter storm kit for your car is suggested in the pamphlet, "Winter Survival," available from county extension offices or the Bulletin Room, University of Minnesota, St. Paul 55108.
