For the information of the Board, the following letter of commendation addressed to the Regents from Mr. Gerald W. Bowers, Office of Naval Research, Resident Repre-

sentative in Minneapolis, was presented for their information and the record:

It has been my pleasure to have been active the past two weeks as the newly appointed Office of Naval Research Resident Representative with headquarters at 102 Johnston Hall on the University Campus. I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation and sincere thanks to the numerous members of your organization for their hospitable welcome and their genuine spirit of cooperation.

In addition to transactions with Mr. L. R. Lunden and members of his Business Office staff, I have had the opportunity of contacting during the course of Navy contract administration a number of Research Project Directors as well as Department Heads. Without exception, their attitude has been one that promises to be most conducive to harmonious operation and joint achievement in attainment of Navy basic research goals.

On October 11th it was my privilege, together with Mr. J. A. Williams of the ONR Chicago Branch Office, to be conducted by John Akerman through a tour of your Rosemount Laboratories. This survey was of special significance to me as I had experienced an active part in the dismantling and disposition of the original Rosemount Ordnance Plant during 1946 and 1947 as an employee of the War Assets Administration.

It was extremely gratifying to observe the effective utilization of this facility which of course had been greatly enhanced by the addition of equipment to the original surplus facility. There is no question that the foresight and efforts of Dr. Akerman in obtaining and rebuilding this installation to its present effectiveness has returned benefits to the government that are many times those that would have resulted from public sale of this property with its residual equipment. It was observed that research projects, testing and other services were being performed for several branches of the Military services.

In conclusion, I have been greatly impressed by the apparent harmonious relationship that existed between members of the University staff and personnel of the Office of Naval Research. I shall endeavor to continue this harmonious relationship and at the same time stay within the realm of efficient contract administration.

Again my thanks to your staff and I look forward with pleasure to meeting other members of your organization that are concerned with the various Navy research projects.
