December 10, 1965

A meeting of the Physical Plant Committee was held in the Fireside Room, McNeal Hall, St. Paul Campus on Friday, December 10, 1965, at 1:30 p.m.

Committee members present: Regent Skyberg presiding; Regents Hartl, Malkerson, and Rauenhorst.

Absent: Regents Hess and Hughes.

Others present: Messrs. Lunden, Wenberg, Garrison, Lund, and Tierney.

The Vice President, Business Administration, reviewed the problem of fire protection on the St. Paul Campus. He called attention to the fact that the campus was outside the City limits but that it had always been served by the St. Paul Fire Department.

The committee instructed the administrative officers to explore the possibility of working through the Village of Falcon Heights for fire protection on the St. Paul Campus but if this is not feasible to negotiate further with the City of St. Paul on the basis of some minimum annual charge and unit cost per call. It was understood that any agreement which resulted from such negotiations would be sent to the Committee for review and recommendation to the full Board for final approval.

The Vice President, Business Administration, presented a report on requests by certain communities where the Regents operate installations to pay special assessments chargeable against property owned by the Regents. He also reviewed the history of requests for funds from the Legislature to pay such assessments over the years together with the current statutes pertaining thereto.
