A meeting of the Executive Committee was held in the President's office, Monday, July 6, 1914, at ten o'clock.

Present: Regent Snyder, presiding; Regents Nelson, Partridge, and Schulz.

The State Architect and Contractor in the erection of the Women's Gymnasium having expressed the opinion that the Women's Gymnasium was located too close to Shevlin Hall and the Library Building, and the question having been submitted to the Regents by correspondence, it was

Voted by the Executive Committee, after considering the communications from the Regents, and after an investigation of the buildings, to amend the location by moving the building back twenty feet.
