BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE
MINUTES**

June 20, 1927

A meeting of the Buildings and Ground Committee of the Board of Regents was held in the Regents' Room on Monday, June 20, 1927, at two-thirty o'clock.

Present: Regent Partridge, chairman; Regents Boeckmann, Coffman, and Snyder.

Voted to recommend that preliminary plans be prepared for a hospital unit at a cost not exceeding \$150,000 to be erected from funds given by William Henry Eustis for the Minnesota Hospital and Home for Crippled Children and to be erected either on the west or east end of present Hospital as may appear to be most desirable in the interests of the University.

Voted to recommend that preliminary plans be prepared for the use of \$585,500, remaining in the allotment from the Comprehensive Building Plan Fund, for the Medical School expansion.

Voted to recommend that it is the sense of the Board of Regents that it is undesirable from the standpoint of University interests to widen University Avenue along the campus.

Voted to adjourn.
