ROUTE 52: THE SMART RIDE

Route 52 is convenient and easy to use. Check the map to locate which route is best for you. Schedules for the regular school year, final exam periods, summer sessions and vacation periods, are available on Route 52 buses, and at campus information centers (for example, at the student unions). You can also call Transit Services at 625-9000, Medicine Lake Lines at 545-1025, or the MTC Transit Information Center at 827-7733 for more information.

If you don't live near a 52 route, you can still use the service. Park and ride lots are located along many of the 52 routes.

SUPERSAVER CONVENIENCE/CASH FARES

Route 52 also offers the convenience of MTC SuperSaver Monthly Passes and 10-Ride Punch Cards. By using SuperSaver fares, you will receive a substantial discount (\$.25 per one-way ride). The chart below compares the SuperSaver fares with cash fares.

With Route 52, you can also transfer to and from MTC routes, as well as other local transit lines. Just ask the driver for a transfer before you exit your bus.

MTC DIRECT BUS ROUTES TO THE UNIVERSITY

The Metropolitan Transit Commission (MTC) is committed to providing safe, convenient transportation to the students, faculty and staff of the University of Minnesota. MTC routes are designed to get you to and

from the University, as well as to after school jobs, child care, shopping and other exciting areas around the Twin Cities.

MTC bus schedules are available at Coffman Union, Blegen Hall, Anderson Hall, and at the Student Center on the St. Paul Campus.

For automated bus information call the MTC's 24-hour hotline, "Bus Line, 341-BUS". Or call the MTC Transit Information Center at 827-7733 and an information representative will help you. (Call 341-0140 TDD for the hearing impaired ONLY.)

CARPOOLING

Carpooling is another commuting alternative. For assistance, call U of M Transit Services at 625-9000 or Minnesota Rideshare at 349-RIDE and you will be sent a rideshare interest card to complete. Within two weeks after the interest card has been returned, you will receive a list of commuters whose residence, time and travel routes most closely match yours. And, as a carpooler, you will have preferential parking at one of the three daily-rate or staff contact University-parking.



GUARANTEED RIDE HOME

Also, as a registered carpooler, if you have to work late, missed your ride or have an emergency at home, you always have a guaranteed ride home. You will be reimbursed for up to three limited-amount taxi rides home per year.

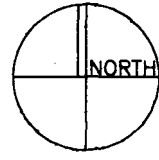
