- All-University student governance conference, possibly held at a coordinate campus
- Travel to the coordinate campuses to attend student association meetings; Crookston, Monday, 8pm; Duluth, Monday, 5 pm; Morris, Monday, 6 pm, GAPSA, Third Wednesday, 6 pm; MSA, Tuesdays, 3:30 pm
- Improving transfer student process for students within University system
- Encouraging students who do not get accepted to the Twin Cities to apply to the coordinate campuses
- Working with FCC regarding their positions on each of the Strategic Planning task forces or requesting seats for students, civil service, and academic professionals

4. APPROVAL OF SSCC MEMBERS APPOINTED TO SCC

Rick Orr and Nicolas Allyn were elected as the two Twin Cities undergraduate representatives from SSCC to SCC.
