Note: In addition to the above, The Mayo Clinic donates and furnishes free of charge to the University, the right to use such part of the facilities, housing, instruments, apparatus, clinical and other material of every kind and description as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work.

In many instances, the members of the staff render services to the Mayo Clinic and receive additional stipend therefrom.
