**RESOLUTION TO CONDUCT NON-PUBLIC MEETING
OF THE LITIGATION REVIEW COMMITTEE**

A motion was made and seconded that the following resolution be approved:

WHEREAS, based on advice of the General Counsel, the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee has balanced the purposes served by the Open Meeting Law and by the attorney-client privilege, and determined that there is a need for absolute confidentiality to discuss litigation strategy in particular matters involving the University of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with Minnesota State Statute Section 13D.01, Subd. 3, and 13D.05, Subd. 3(b), a non-public meeting of the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee be held on May 17, 2004 at 3:00 p.m. in the William R. Peterson Conference Room, 600 McNamara Alumni Center, for the purpose of discussing attorney-client privileged matters including the following:

- Potential Claims by the University against BioRad;
- *Lindback v. Regions Hospital, et al.*;
- *In re Regents of the University of Minnesota v. Lorraine Larson*; and,
- *In re the Matter of Syvilla Turbis Revocable Trust.*

The committee voted unanimously to approve the resolution.
