**RESOLUTION TO CONDUCT NON-PUBLIC MEETING

WHEREAS, based on advice of the General Counsel, the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee has balanced the purposes served by the Open Meeting Law and by the attorney-client privilege, and determined that there is a need for absolute confidentiality to discuss litigation strategy in particular matters involving the University of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with Minnesota State Statute Section 13D.05, Subd. 3(b), a non-public meeting of the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee be held on Thursday, February 13, 2003 at 8:15 a.m. in the William R. Peterson Conference Room, 600 McNamara Alumni Center, for the purpose of discussing attorney-client privileged matters.

The committee voted unanimously to approve the resolution.

The public portion of the meeting adjourned at 8:16 a.m. and the non-public portion of the meeting adjourned at 8:19 a.m. The meeting recessed at 9:10 a.m. and reconvened at 5:00 p.m. The meeting adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
