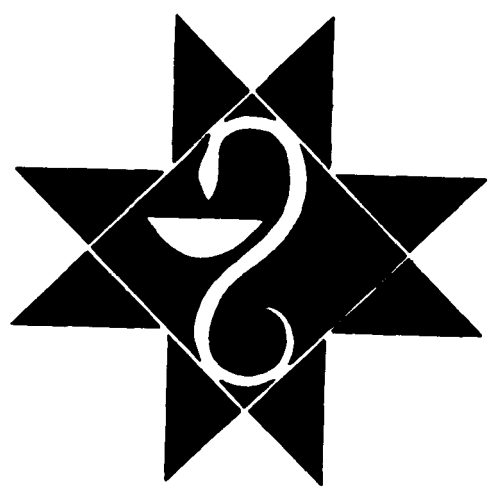

PROFESSIONAL OATH

I do solemnly pledge:

That I will abide by the Code of Ethics of the American Pharmaceutical Association in my relations with the public, the other health professions, and fellow pharmacists;

That I will obey all the laws governing the practice of pharmacy, and that I will encourage the enforcement of these laws against all persons, pledging to assist the proper authorities in correcting any unlawful or unethical conduct among members of my profession;

That I will do my best to develop and maintain professional stature by keeping abreast of developments in my own and related professions; and

That I will hold the citizen's health and welfare paramount in all considerations relative to the practice of my profession.
