## ***Reaching Out Mural***

---

The mural displayed in the Northrop Memorial Auditorium foyer was created at the founding of the College of Education and Human Development and designed by students from a Multicultural Voices Learning Community in the Department of Postsecondary Teaching and Learning. Titled *Reaching Out*, the painting represents community—the many communities that are served by the College, as well as the community of students who created the mural.

The learning community of first-year students was led by postsecondary teaching and learning associate professors Pat James, Patrick Bruch (writing studies), and assistant professor Rashné Jehangir. Using art, literature, and composition, they explored themes of identity, community, and empowerment.

On the left side of the mural are photographs of the students' own hands interspersed with questions they wrote about education. The hand photos reach toward each other and out toward larger hands on the right that contain students' paintings and photographs of their families and friends, which embody multicultural communities in the Twin Cities. The College of Education and Human Development mission statement frames the images and reminds us of the many forms of outreach practiced by faculty, staff, and students. At the request of Dean Darlyne Bailey, the mural has been hung permanently in Burton Hall, where the College administration is housed.

Dear Graduates,



## Biographical Information

---

### **Darlyne Bailey**

Darlyne Bailey is the founding dean of the new College of Education and Human Development. She also serves as assistant to the president and holds the Campbell Leadership Chair in Education and Human Development. Dean Bailey was the vice president for academic affairs and dean of Teachers College, Columbia University in New York City from 2002 to September 2006. Prior to that, she served as dean of the Mandel School of Applied Social Sciences at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio. Dean Bailey earned a master's degree in psychiatric social work from Columbia University and a doctorate in organizational behavior from Weatherhead School of Management at Case Western Reserve University.

### **Elizabeth (Libba) Pinchot**

Elizabeth (Libba) Pinchot is an educator and social entrepreneur who co-founded the Bainbridge Graduate Institute in Bainbridge Island, Washington, to help reinvent business education as a positive force for peace, equity, and a healthy planet. Pinchot is an executive coach, consultant, and co-author of the book *The Intelligent Organization*. As co-founder and president of Pinchot & Company, she has taught leadership development and "intrapreneurship" to senior executives in large organizations, including the U.S. Forest Service and New York Stock Exchange. Pinchot received a master's degree in education from the University of Oregon. She was founding director for the University of Oregon Day Care Center in Eugene, Oregon, taught child development at Lane Community College, and directed the LCC Laboratory School, a Head Start teacher-training program.

### **David Metzen**

David Metzen graduated from the University of Minnesota with a bachelor's degree in elementary education in 1964 and was captain of the University hockey team. He later earned a master's degree and a doctorate in educational administration from the University. After serving the South St. Paul Public Schools as an elementary school teacher, principal, and assistant superintendent, he became superintendent in 1982 until his retirement in 2000. Metzen is a leadership consultant and a director of American Bank and has served on the boards of several nonprofit organizations.

### **Tiffany Anne Wilson**

Tiffany Anne Wilson is an entrepreneur and a bona fide role model whose V.I.P. Hair & Nail Salon in downtown Minneapolis serves as a cornerstone of the community. The salon embodies Wilson's creative and caring spirit, which she shows by donating her hair skills and products to women in need. Between training for marathons and caring for her large family, she serves on the board of KMOJ, regularly volunteers in the social work office of the Minneapolis Public Schools, and mentors young people from St. Joseph's Home for Children. Wilson's love and guidance has given the children with whom she works a sense of enduring values and life skills. She is truly one of the Twin Cities' best-kept secrets.

This University of Minnesota award recognizes undergraduate students for outstanding community contributions. # Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Degree Candidates

---

Award designations are listed after the undergraduate candidates' names in the following pages.

Candidates for graduation with distinction and high distinction will wear gold medallions during the ceremony. These honors are based on the student's cumulative grade point average (GPA) at graduation and completion of 60 semester credits at the University of Minnesota.

**Distinction**—To graduate with distinction, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher at graduation.

**High Distinction**—To graduate with high distinction, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher at graduation.

**Honors**—To graduate with honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, or summa cum laude), the student must participate in a fully developed honors program in their college or program, and complete the honors specific requirements. Only University coursework is considered in determining GPA for honors, and the student must have completed 60 or more semester credits in the University. The minimum GPA required in upper-division courses for a degree cum laude is 3.50, magna cum laude is 3.66, summa cum laude is 3.75.
