Commencement Speaker



Jeanne C. Sinkford, DDS, PhD

Dr. Jeanne Craig Sinkford is the Senior Scholar-in-Residence, Office of the Executive Director, American Dental Education Association. She is also Professor and Dean Emeritus at Howard University College of Dentistry where she served as the first woman dean of a dental school in the United States from 1975 to 1991.

Dr. Sinkford's distinguished career as an internationally renowned dental educator, administrator, researcher and clinician began after graduating first in her dental class at Howard University in 1958. She went on to earn her master of science and doctor of philosophy degrees from Northwestern University. Dr. Sinkford completed a pedodontic residency at Children's Hospital National Medical Center in 1975 and has received honorary doctorates from Georgetown University, University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey, University of Detroit Mercy, and Meharry Medical College.

She has served on the National Advisory Dental Research Council; Directors' Advisory Council, National Institutes of Health; Governing Board of the American Society for Geriatric Dentistry; Advisory Board, Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Program; Committee A, Council on Dental Education and Chair, Appeal Board Council of Dental Education, American Dental Association; Council on Dental Research, American Dental Association; Tuskegee Study Advisory Panel; Special Medical Advisory Group, Veterans Administration; Institute of Medicine, National Academy of Sciences and the NRC Governing Board, National Academy of Sciences. Dr. Sinkford also serves on advisory boards of Boston University, Howard University, West Virginia University, the Sullivan Alliance, the National Project Advisory Committee Department of Health and Human Services and the Advisory Committee on Research on Women's Health, National Institutes of Health.

Dr. Sinkford was the first woman selected as an Outstanding Leader in Dentistry by the International College of Dentists. She received the 2007 Trailblazer Award from the National Dental Association, was recognized with the distinguished 2009 Herbert W. Nickens Award for her contribution to promoting justice in medical education and health care, and her most recent recognition is the 2010 Pierre Fauchard Academy Gold Medal Award. Dr. Sinkford has been a member of the Institute of Medicine, National Academy of Sciences since 1975.

Century Club Professor of the Year

The *Century Club Professor of the Year* is the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry's highest honor and is awarded each year to a faculty member in recognition of outstanding contributions to the School of Dentistry in the areas of education, service and research.

Dr. Rajaram Gopalakrishnan is associate professor in the Division of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, Department of Diagnostic and Biological Sciences, and director of the Graduate Program in Oral Biology. He received his bachelor of dental surgery degree from the University of Madras, Chennai, India in 1991. Dr. Gopalakrishnan completed his residency in oral and maxillofacial pathology in 1995 and went on to earn a doctorate of philosophy degree in pathology in 1999, both at The Ohio State University College of Dentistry. He received his certification with the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology in 2002. That same year, Dr. Raj, as he is known at the School of Dentistry, joined the University of Minnesota as an assistant professor. He was subsequently promoted to associate professor in 2008.

Dr. Gopalakrishnan is an internationally recognized researcher and is highly regarded at the School of Dentistry by faculty, students and staff alike. He is known for his clinical and instructional expertise and for his approachable and engaging manner.



Dr. Rajaram Gopalakrishnan is leading today's processional with the University of Minnesota mace. Originally, maces were iron war clubs, powerful weapons of strength and authority. Today, the meaning is more peaceful; it is a staff carried before a dignitary as an insignia of dignity and authority.

The University of Minnesota's mace was commissioned in 1961 for the inauguration of O. Meredith Wilson as President and designed by Philip G. Morton, sculptor and associate professor of art. It is made of an aluminum staff and topped by a crystal ball which symbolizes the illuminating quality and the clarity of thinking that characterizes education. The crystal ball is topped by a star representing Minnesota, the North Star State.



The faculty and honored guests participating in the graduation ceremony are wearing gowns and hoods indicating their highest degree and caps with tassels.
