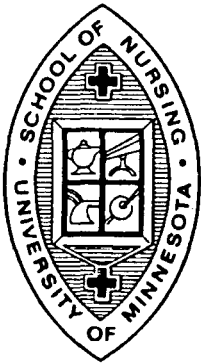

The antique lamp represents the metaphysical sciences; the telescope, the physical sciences; the plow, the industrial arts; and the artist's palette represents the fine arts. These are the four dimensions of a Baccalaureate education. Above and below are the crosses of St. George, which have stood for unselfish service for centuries. We are proud of this heritage.*
