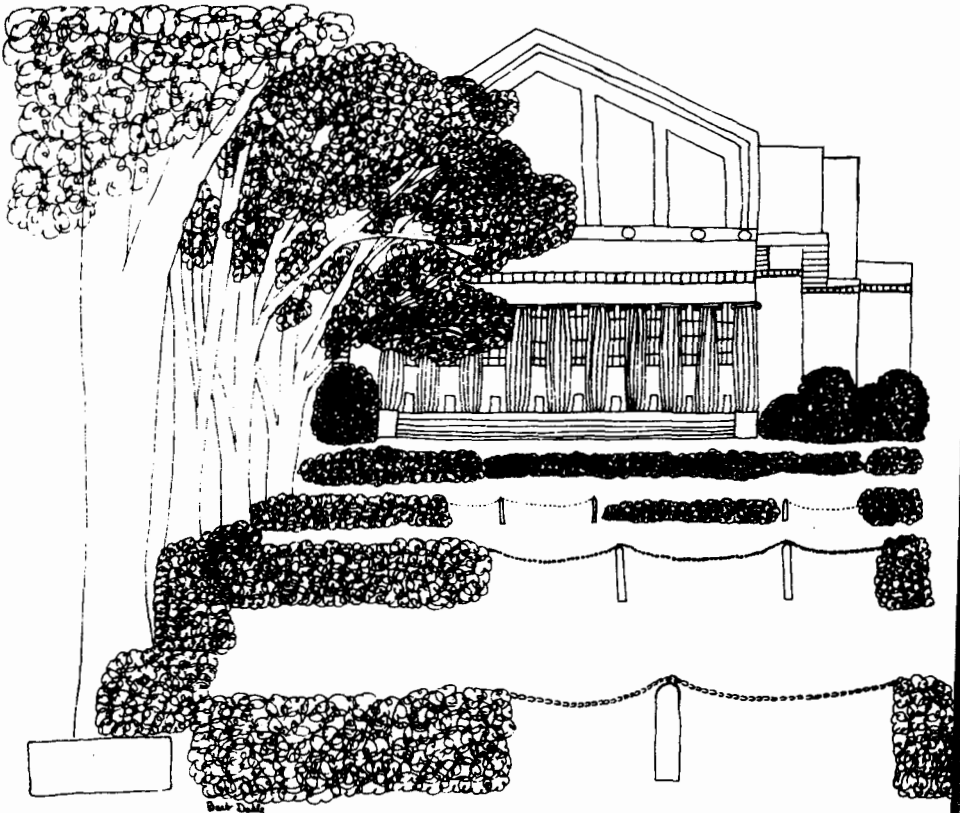

## SPECIALIZATION IN FOREIGN STUDIES

The Foreign Studies Program is an experimental all-University specialization program pursued in conjunction with students' baccalaureate programs. Its goal is to ensure that students will, in addition to possessing a substantial background in their chosen field of study, have a degree of awareness, understanding, and appreciation of their own culture and of at least one other culture. The program provides a formal, international and interdisciplinary curriculum option that integrates a sequence of selected courses and related foreign study experience.

Susan M. Culligan

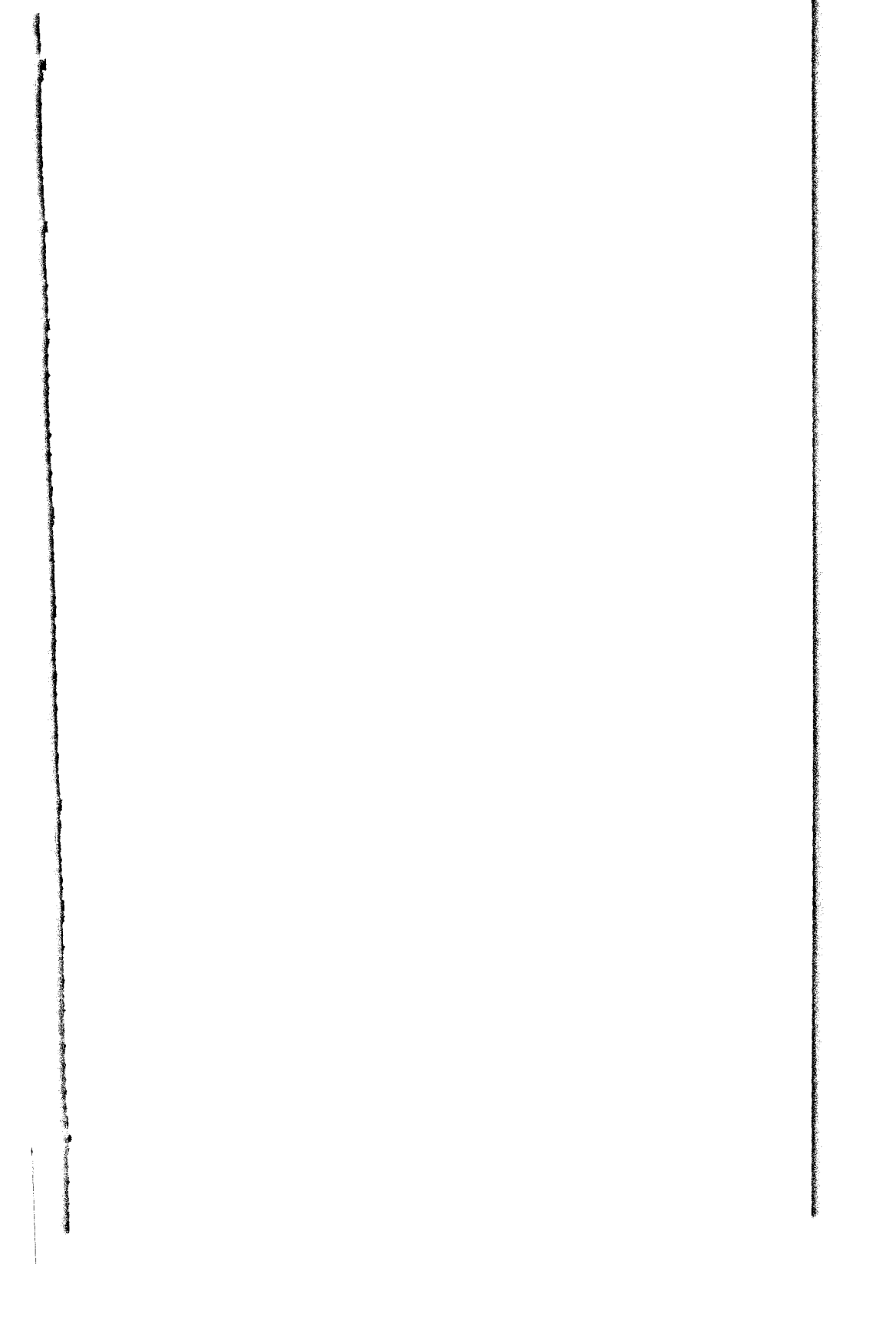
Completed a year of study at the American College in Paris, France, with related coursework in foreign language (French), intercultural communication and area studies (European geography, art history, and archeology).
