#### OUTLOOK

The Gophers' gymnastics coach is all smiles these days.

Katalin Deli has good reason to be wearing a grin as the time nears to unveil her team for 1983. Three of the eight gymnasts on her roster were AIAW All-Americans last season and she considers the four freshmen on the team top recruits. Last year's squad was "the best ever" in Deli's nine years at Minnesota. The

Gophers were seventh at the AIAW Nationals in 1982, champions at the AIAW Region 6 tournament and fourth in the Big Ten. The latter is a bit misleading; Minnesota won four of five events at the Big Ten Tournament.

Robin Huebner will again lead the Gophers. The senior all-arounder from Minnetonka, Minn., had her finest hour in '82 - earning All-American honors in three events, capturing four championships at AIAW Regionals and two at the Big Ten Tournament, and breaking four different Minnesota school records.

Karie Ploof, a senior from Shakopee, Minn., turned her strength on the balance beam into Big Ten and AIAW Regional championships and a strong third place at AIAW Nationals. Ploof also displayed her prowess in the all-around, finishing tenth at the National tournament. Junior Judi Klein from Edina, Minn., also returns to lend her All-American talents in the vault to the Gopher powerhouse. Klein also won a Big Ten championship with her performance on the uneven parallel bars. One other veteran, senior Linda Schott from Eden Prairie, Minn., returns to lend her hand in the vault and a new routine on the beam.

With only eight team members, depth may be a worry for coach Deli. However, all eight of her gymnasts can perform the all-around, and her crop of freshmen is a fine one.

Newcomer Lianne Morland from Hastings, Minn., was second in Minnesota all-around competition a year ago and Wendy Dorsey, a freshman from Golden Valley, Minn., competed at the Senior Nationals last season. Julie Kot, a freshman from Burnsville, Minn., will also help the Gophers since her strongest event, the parallel bars, may be the event where Minnesota is thinnest. Freshman Dana Reay from Minneapolis was an all-city selection a year ago.

Deli's goals for the team are simple, but high. "We'd really like to win the Big Ten as a team," she said. "We've never done it but I think we have the potential to do it this year." And as for Nationals, Deli said "we're determined to work as hard as we can and wait and see what happens." Smiles all around.
