NOTE TO THE 4-H FAMILY

Each market animal must have positive identification (ear notch, tattoo or ear tag) at the time of the recording of beginning weight. Be sure to follow your county's rules as to eligibility of animals, number of animals that can be identified per 4-H member and acceptable identification. Market animals winning a trip to the state fair *must* carry the same identification all the way to the state fair. If the animal's ear tag is lost, contact your county extension agent. Market animals not properly identified at the beginning weigh period are not eligible for state fair competition. In addition, all breeding animals must be permanently identified sometime prior to sending in the entry for the state fair. See the reverse side for ear notch assistance and to determine if market livestock swine meet state fair beginning weight guidelines.
