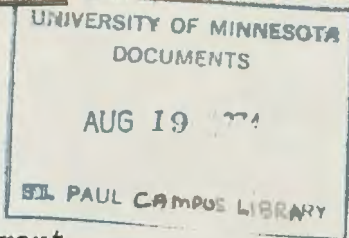

Fermented Pickles, Sauerkraut (0:25)

Genuine dill pickles, half dills, sweet gerkins and sauerkraut are fermented or brined pickle products.

The U. S. Department of Agriculture expects a record California plum crop--130-thousand tons. Plums are expected to be in abundant supply through August.

Potato Prices (0:30)

Don't expect the price of potatoes to drop very much. That's the word from Consumer Marketing Economist Mildred Walker of Kansas State University.

She expects a higher average yield per harvested acre this year, but processors will again be taking a good share of the crop. She says as more potatoes come to market in the frozen or dehydrated form, there is less difference in price between processed and fresh.
