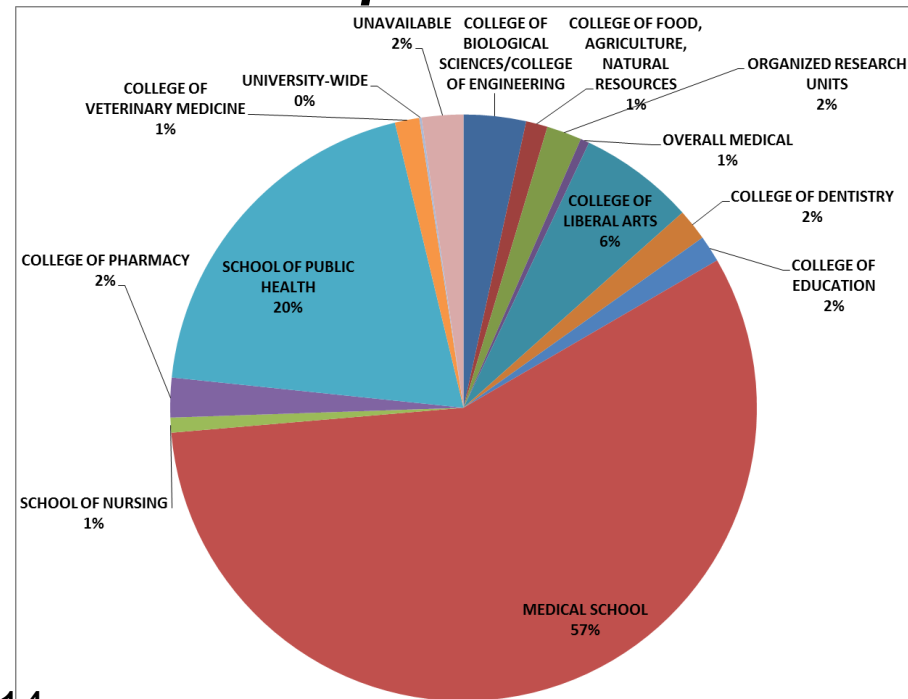
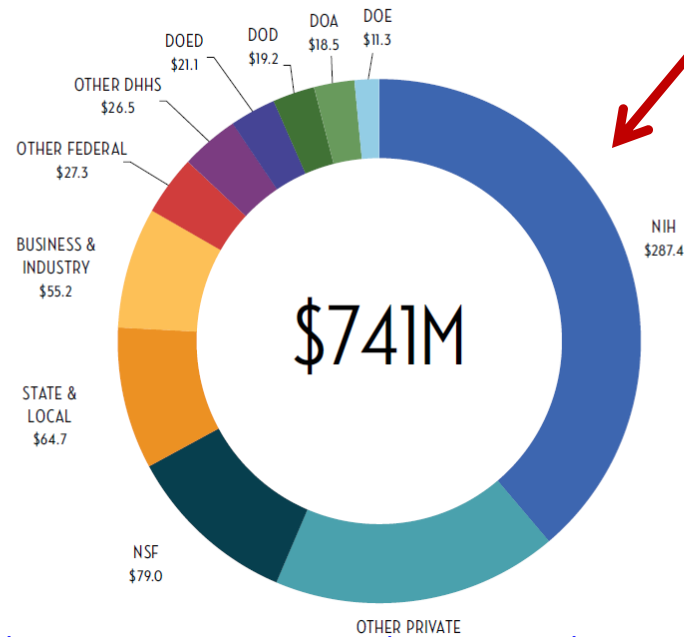

- **NOT-OD-13-042 (Feb 14, 2013)**
  - *For non-competing continuation grant awards with a start date of July 1, 2013 or beyond:*
    - **NIH will delay processing of an award if publications arising from it are not in compliance with the [NIH public access policy](#).**
    - **Investigators will need to use [My NCBI](#) to enter papers onto progress reports.**
- **Over 4,000 U of M articles out of compliance in Feb 2013.**

## West Bank Campus

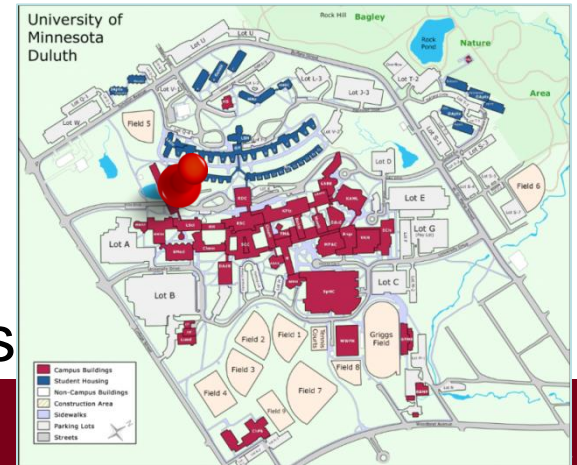

# *By The Numbers*

- *More than 85% of NIH Public Access Policy inquiries come from people referred by SPA, have taken a SPA-Library sponsored My NCBI class or were referred by someone who took a SPA-Library sponsored My NCBI class.*
- *Over \$20 million in grant funds with over 40 grants represented (2013-2015).*
- *Current total compliance rate at 88% (2008-2015).*
  - *Over 10,000 articles, nearly 9,000 in compliance.*
  - *3,817 articles produced since March 2013 – 3,391 compliant or in-process as of May 2015 (89%).*

# *Collaboration Benefits*

- Enhanced non-compliance troubleshooting abilities.
- Campus-wide, SPA-backed reach beyond the health sciences.
- Collaborative presentations that include insider grant office information.
- Effortlessly positioned for new NIH bio-sketch mandate (i.e. SciENcv).
- Access to publication data for citation analysis and research impact.
