

DULUTH--Two UMD representatives have been appointed to the administrative committee of a new memorial program--the University of Minnesota Memorial Fund--to honor the memory of University staff and faculty members, their families and friends.

The UMD representatives on the governing body are Mrs. Ward Wells, president of the UMD Faculty Wives club, and Provost R. W. Darland. In Minneapolis, the Faculty Women's club has accepted the guiding responsibility in accomplishing the fund's objectives.

A special project of the Greater University Fund, the fund in the few months of its existence has grown beyond \$4,000, according to Robert P. Provost, GUF director.

"A Book of Honor," in which names of the memorialized persons and their University relationship will be inscribed, has been especially designed by Jane McCarthy, of the University of Minnesota Press.

The book currently is on display in the UMD Library.

Gifts made to the fund without specific designation may be used for such purposes as scholarships, fellowships or other student aids, library purchases, research, or improvement of educational facilities. Donors may, however, designate specific projects or programs in which they are interested.
