

The second largest summer session enrollment in the history of the Duluth campus has been recorded this summer, UND officials said today.

A total of 1,349 students from more than a score of states and several foreign countries was reported for the two-term session, which ends Aug. 24. The record is the veteran-enrolled enrollment of 1,454 in 1949.

The high 1957 total was established despite a drop in second term enrollment both in comparison to the first 1957 term and the second 1956 term.

Second term enrollment this year is 523, compared to 526 for the first term and 560 a year ago, according to figures released today by True E. Pottingill, Minneapolis, University recorder.

The grand total second term enrollment for the Twin Cities and Duluth campuses is 6,119, compared to 5,936 a year ago.
